**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds begin a six-game road trip against the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) on Tuesday night at First Horizon Park in Nashville. Right-handed pitcher Michael McGreevy is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Logan Henderson for Nashville.

**ABOUT SUNDAY AFTERNOON:** The Memphis Redbirds concluded a six-game homestand with a 3-2 loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers (Triple-A, Kansas City Royals) on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Second baseman Cesar Prieto led the Memphis offense in the loss. The left-handed hitter went 3-for-4 with a double, an RBI and a run scored. Catcher Gavin Collins went 1-for-3 with an RBI. Starting pitcher Zack Thompson (3-6) allowed three runs on five hits, walked three and struck out four in 5.0 innings. Connor Thomas and Andre Granillo each provided 2.0 scoreless innings in relief. Thomas struck out three of the six batters he faced while Granillo struck out five of seven batters.

**AMAZING AUGUST:** The Memphis Redbirds offense dominated opposing pitching as a team. As a group, the team slashed .279/.353/.469/.822, all high marks on the season for a single month. Memphis mashed 39 home runs as a team and drove in 141 RBIs. In 22 games played, Nick Dunn batted .347 with 10 RBIs. Matt Koperniak slashed .307/.398/.523/.921 with three home runs and 16 RBIs. In total, eight Redbirds posted a batting average in August. Of the 39 home runs, Mike Antico crushed a seven home runs, tied most on the team with Thomas Saggese.

**HAPPY 25th, AZP:** To commemorate the 25th anniversary season of Redbirds baseball at AutoZone Park, the Redbirds will host a plethora of promotions and theme nights to celebrate. Since the opening of the downtown ballpark in 2000, many credit the stadium with the revitalization of downtown Memphis. The support of the Redbirds at AutoZone Park caught the attention of Michael Heisley, who then brought the Grizzlies to the city. “(AutoZone Park) was a catalyst for a lot of the things that downtown is today,” Memphis Redbirds President and General Manager Craig Unger said. “So, I think even to this day today, you still see development going on around here. The Commonwealth building a few years ago, you know, Stewart and the group there that, that did that building talked about AutoZone Park. This entire block around Madison is still the catalyst for growth there. Sports is that catalyst.”

**BASEBALL AMERICA OUTLOOK:** The St. Louis Cardinals entered the 2024 season with the No. 20 Minor League system in all of baseball according to BaseballAmerica. St. Louis began the campaign with five players ranked in the Top-100 (No. 39 Masyn Winn, MLB, No. 75 Tekoah Roby, AA, No. 83 Victor Scott II, MLB, No. 84 Tink Hence, AA, No. 85 Thomas Saggese, AAA). BaseballAmerica’s preview on the Cardinals system states “Jordan Walker’s successful graduation to the majors has dropped the Cardinals’ farm system back, though exciting up-the-middle hitters like Masyn Winn and Victor Scott II are ready to follow Walker to St. Louis. Getting the most out of arms like Tekoah Roby and Tink Hence is going to be crucial. The Cardinals pulled off the neat trick of adding two Top 100 Prospects when they dealt Jordan Montgomery to the Rangers for Roby and Thomas Saggese in July.”

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his sixth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

### COACHING CAREER

- 274 - 293 managerial record entering 2024 season
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

### PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 43, is beginning his 12th season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

- As of 2023, Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero’s tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his second season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.

**TODAY'S START:** Michael McGreevy makes his 27th start of the season on Tuesday night in game one of the series against the Nashville Sounds.

**LAST TIME OUT:** McGreevy tossed a complete game in game two of a doubleheader last Thursday night against Omaha. The right-handed pitcher allowed one run on two hits in the first inning, then went on to retire the next 20 batters consecutively to end the game. The complete game was McGreevy's league-leading third of the season.

**COMPLETE CONTROL:** Rated as having the "Best Control" in the organization for the second consecutive season (2022-2023)... Ranked among the Cardinals organizational leaders in strikeouts (117, 8th), strikeouts/walk ratio (3.90, 9th) and walks/9IP (1.9, 2nd)... Walked one batter or fewer in 18 starts and none in 10 outings... at UC Santa Barbara, ranked second among NCAA pitchers in walks/9IP (0.97) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) in 2021...

**2022 RISE:** Began the 2022 season with High-A Peoria... went 3-1 with a 2.58 ERA in eight starts with the Chiefs... Promoted to Springfield on May 24th along with Gordon Graceffo and Masyn Winn... Led Cardinals minor leaguers in starts (28)... Pitched 6.0 innings or more in 12 starts (eight quality starts), topping out at a season-high 6.2 innings of two-hit ball on April 15 against the Great Lakes Loons (83 pitches)
