SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their eighth straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 7-0, in Erie. It capped the first six-game sweep in Flying Squirrels history. Hao-Yu Lee hit an RBI single in the third, the only run allowed by **Matt Frisbee** in his four-inning start. In the fifth, Lee hit a solo homer to extend the lead to 2-0. Erie scored five runs in the sixth to push the lead to 7-0. Gage Workman brought in a run with a sac fly, Trei Cruz hit an RBI single and Lee clubbed a three-run homer. **Nick Garcia** finished the game for the Flying Squirrels out of the bullpen and threw two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, in the opener of a six-game series. This week marks the only series between the two team this season. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-1 against the Fightin Phils, their best record against Reading in franchise history. Richmond swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season and won five-of-six at Reading in June and July.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped 12-of-13 dating back to April 28, including 11-of-12 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. The lone win in that stretch came May 3 in a shutout at Akron. In the previous series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The current losing streak is the longest for the Flying Squirrels since they lost eight straight games from July 30-August 7, 2024.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS are in fifth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. They won five-of-six in last week's series in Reading against Hartford, outscoring the Yard Goats 34-23 for the series. Reading's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including OF Gabriel Rincones (No. 10), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 16), RHP Christian McGowan (No. 17), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20) and RHP Tommy McCollum (No. 29). There are six Reading players on MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list, including Rincones (No. 10), De La Cruz (No. 13), McGowan (No. 16), Ricketts (No. 21), INF Robert Moore (No. 26), INF Jose Rodriguez (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his eighth start of 2024 and the fifth appearance of his career against Reading. He last pitched on Wednesday at Reading and allowed two runs (one earned) over five innings with a Double-A career-best eight strikeouts. He was moved to starting on Wednesday after his outing the previous Sunday at Akron was shortened to one inning after a 90-minute rain delay. Murphy is currently ranked tied for first in the Eastern League in games started (7) and 10th in WHIP (1.14). In his career, Murphy is 2-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP) against Reading in four outings (three starts). Murphy spent all of last season with the Flying Squirrels, going 2-9 with a 4.36 ERA in 29 outings. His 27 starts were tied for the most in the Eastern League. Murphy struck out 107 batters last year, sixth-most in the Giants organization. He had a 5.21 ERA (28 ER/48.1 IP) in his first 14 outings through June 22, but over his next 14 outings from June 28-September 10, he posted a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts. Murphy made his Double-A debut in June of 2022, one of two starts with Richmond that year before he was shut down with an injury. In his first professional season in 2021, he pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene and struck out 164 batters, which was the third-most in the minors for the year. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College in New York, which was then an NCAA DII program. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander Noah Skirrow makes his sixth start of the season. He last pitched last Tuesday against the Yard Goats and worked five innings, his longest outing of the year so far, and allowed one unearned run for his first win of the season. Through his first four starts of the year prior to last week's outing, Skirrow went 0-2 with a 11.81 ERA (14 ER/10.2 IP). He is in his third overall season with Reading. He reached Double-A in his first professional season in 2021 for seven appearances (three starts) and returned for most of 2022 before a late-season promotion to Triple-A Lehigh Valley. He spent all of last season in Triple-A, going 8-4 with a 5.84 ERA in his 22 games (14 starts). Skirrow was signed by the Phillies as a non-drafted free agent in 2020 out of Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va. Skirrow also pitched for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

AWESOME APRIL: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,453).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last 16 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .090 (8-for-89) with runners in scoring position, averaging 1.81 runs per game (29 total runs). On the last road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond hit .058 (4-for-69) with runners in scoring position and averaged 1.7 runs per game (20 total runs). In the series in Erie, the Flying Squirrels went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night, 0-for-3 on Wednesday, scoring their only run in that game on an error, 0-for-6 on Thursday, 0-for-6 in Friday's shutout loss, 0-for-9 on Saturday and did not have a runner in scoring position on Sunday. In the last seven games since May 5, Richmond is 0-for-33 with runners in scoring position.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 15 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top 10 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (2nd - 1.10 ERA - 2 ER/16.1 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (7th - 1.76 ERA - 3 ER/15.1 IP), **Nick Garcia** (9th - 1.76 ERA - 3 ER/15 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (9th - 2.08 ERA - 5 ER/21.2 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (21.2).

HOWELL HEATING UP: **Carter Howell** is leading all Richmond hitters this season with a .258 batting average and a .359 OBP. In his last eight games since May 3, Howell is batting .296 (8-for-27) with two doubles, two RBIs, five walks and a .406 on-base percentage. His seven doubles this season are tied for fourth-most in the Giants organization.

WE DON'T WANNA TALK ABOUT IT: The Flying Squirrels' current eight-game losing streak is their longest since they lost eight straight games from July 30-August 7, 2014. It is tied for the third-longest losing streak in team history. They've had two losing streaks hit double-digits in franchise history. From May 7-20, 2016, the Flying Squirrels lost 14 straight games. Richmond lost 15 consecutive games from April 14-May 3, 2015, which was tied by Altoona earlier this month for the longest Eastern League losing streak in the "digitized era," dating back to 2005.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Carson Ragsdale** is fourth in strikeouts (37) and tied for first in games started (7). **Ryan Murphy** is tied for first in games started (7) and 10th in WHIP (1.14). **John Michael Bertrand** is fourth in innings pitched (36.1). His 17.69 K/9 was second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 5 IP).

MOVIN' UP: On Tuesday, **Reggie Crawford** and **Hunter Bishop** were promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. In his nine outings with Richmond, Crawford struck out 19 batters over 9.2 innings of work and posted a 4.66 ERA. Bishop played 26 games for the Flying Squirrels. He ranked second on the team in batting average (.242), tied for second in homers (2), second in OBP (.314), second in SLG (.358), second in OPS (.672), tied for second in doubles (5). He also led the team in total bases (34) and stolen bases (5) and ranked tied for first in hits (23).

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

IN OTHER WORDS...

Andy Thomas on the recent losing slide:

"If we get wrapped up in the losing streak and playing like we're not used to, it'll sink our ship. So the way we get out of this is to just keep going, keep doing our work, get out on the field and hopefully scratch more than they do. We've been pretty poor offensively as a unit. Some guys have been bright spots, but as a collective unit, we just haven't been good in general. Pitchers have been doing a pretty decent job. They've been picking us up. The offense hasn't helped at all. But that having been said, it's a sink or swim mode. We can either let this define our season or we can use this moment to push forward. I'll tell you this, the losing streak has made this team really close."
