TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs at Hadlock Field. Altoona dropped four-of-six

LAST TIME OUT: Portland earned a series win with a 10-4 win over the Curve on Saturday night.

SOME KNOCKS: Altoona's 66 hits during their week-long series with Richmond from July 30 - August 4 were tied for the most by an Eastern League club (.322 batting average). Altoona has recorded at least 8 hits in 8-of-11 games since July 30 during which they've recorded a 5-6 record. Altoona's .301 batting average in their last 11 games is 2nd among all Double-A teams.

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 32 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .434 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 3rd in BA (.314), 2nd in OBP (.421), T-4th in 3B (3) and T-5th in SB (17).

THIS IS NOT A CIMULATION: First baseman Nick Cimillo has reached base safely in 12 straight games (July 30 - Present) during which he's batting: .357/.460/.500/.960 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 8 BB and 1-1 SB. Cimillo ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers in HR (19), RBI (56) and 1st in OPS (.999) among players who have taken 150 MiLB PA's this year.

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS ARE JULY'S CARB OF THE MONTH: After leading all Double-A pitchers in ERA (0.70) and strikeouts (32), right-hander Thomas Harrington was named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Month. Harrington, who has since been promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on August 4, is the first Curve player to earn a monthly honor since Barrett Barnes in 2016.

SLAMMIN' SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani earned a hit in 8 straight games including 7 straight two-hit games from July 31 - August 9. During the streak, he batted: .455/.486/.636/1.122 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 RBI, 3-3 SB.

GENERATION Z: Since July 23 (16 games) Tsung-Che Cheng has recorded a .412 on-base percentage. 10 times in his last 16 games, Cheng has reached base safely in a game twice. <u>Cheng swatted Altoona's third Grand Slam of the season on Wednesday, August 7 at Portland.</u>

NO STRESS FOR TRES: July has been the hottest month of the season for Tres Gonzalez. In 17 games during the calendar month, he batted .357/.429/.393 with 2 2B and 8 RBI. From July 23 - August 1 he put together a season-long seven-game hit streak which included three two-hit games and a three-hit game. After recording six multi-hit games in the first three months of the season, Gonzalez had seven multi-hit games in July.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 13 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.88 ERA (25 ER / 78.0 IP) with 65 strikeouts. Chen ranks 8th in the Eastern League in ERA (2.92), 4th in strikeouts (63), 7th in batting average against (.227) and first in innings pitched (74.0) since the beginning of June.

THE SEA PUPPERS: Chad Epperson leads the Sea Dogs for his third season as Manager, he previously served as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Portland has many of the Red Šox top prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 1 INF Marcelo Mayer (IL), No. 2 OF Roman Anthony, No. 3 C Kyle Teel, No. 5 RHP Wikelman Gonzalez, No. 19 INF Blaze Jordan, No. 25 RHP Hunter Dobbins. Former Sea Dog Nick Yorke was acquired by the Pirates in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester at the trade deadline last week.

THE FIRST OUT OF BED: Wikelman Gonzalez, who tossed a scoreless inning in relief on Tuesday night, takes the ball this afternoon for Portland. Altoona tagged Gonzalez with the loss on May 29 at PNG Field, earning four walks and five runs in 4.0 innings. Gonzalez was added to the Red Sox 40-man roster this past off-season to protect him from the Rule V draft, he works with a lively fastball, curveball, slider and change-up. Gonzalez was the Red Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2023 and projects to have 3 plus offerings in his fastball, change-up and curveball in his arsenal when he matures.
