Looking Back

Reading fell 14-5 to Richmond last night. The R-Phils tied it at five in the sixth, but seven unanswered runs from Richmond in the seventh put the game out of reach. Oliver Dunn had two doubles for the second time this season and also matched a season-high with three hits. Ethan Wilson also doubled and tripled and Cody Roberts hit a home run in the loss. Mick Abel went five innings in a no decision.

Pitching Struggles

The 14 runs allowed to Richmond last night matched a season-high in runs allowed for Reading pitching. Additionally, the seven runs in the seventh inning for Richmond tied a season-high in runs allowed in an inning. Reading pitching did strike out Shane Matheny five times, which was the most by an opposing player against Reading this season.

Wednesday night marked the first time Reading has been shutout this season, which took until game 69. Entering Wednesday night, the R-Phils were one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and just one-of-eight across Minor League Baseball who have yet to be shutout. Reading has also not scored a run in a season-high 11 innings in a row offensively. It was the first time Reading was shutout since Sept. 11, 2022.

Hey Now You're an All Star

Tonight's starter Mick Abel was selected to the All Star Future's Game on Monday night. Abel is one-of-two Phillies' prospects to be selected, with the other being Justin Crawford of Clearwater. Abel will return just three-hours from home for the game in Seattle.

Last night's attendance of 7,420 was the highest mark in all of double-A for Thursday. Reading has surpassed 200,000 fans on the season and is currently on pace for 383,806 fans this season, which would surpass last year's mark by over 15,000 fans.

Around the Organization

The Phillies swept the Cubs with a 3-1 win last night and return home to being a series with the Nationals tonight. Lehigh Valley beat Rochester 12-3 as TJ Zeuch went seven-strong innings. Jersey Shore fell 4-1 to Brooklyn as Nick Ward had two hits. Clearwater beat Bradenton 5-1 as Sam Aldegheri went five innings and did not allow an earned run.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 30, 2009: At Reading, Kevin Mahar's 2-out solo home run to left field sends the R-Phils home a winner for the 17th time in June. Altoona had built an early 5-0 advantage and still led 5-4 in the 9th, but Quintin Berry's RBI triple scored Jeremy Slayden to send the game into extras.

Richmond Roundup

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Richmond, with the first being a sweep for Richmond at The Diamond. Richmond enters this week after going 33-36 in the first half and finishing fourth in the Southwest Division. Last week, Richmond took five-of-six against Harrisburg, including four-straight to close the series. Next week, Richmond takes on Bowie at home.

Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Landen Roupp gets the start for Richmond tonight. It is his tenth start of 2023 and he has a 1.95 ERA and no decisions. Across 27.2 innings, Roupp has allowed 22 hits, issued seven walks and has 35 strikeouts. He went four innings last Saturday against Harrisburg, allowing one run on five hits and four strikeouts. Roupp began the season on the Development List after spending 2022 between San Jose, Eugene and Richmond. He was a 12th-round pick by the Giants in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
