### FREEMAN'S HOME RUN LEADS RIDERS OVER HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks 3-2 on Tuesday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (1-0, 45-25) started the scoring in the bottom of the second inning when **Keyber Rodriguez** drove home **Abimelec Ortiz** with a two-out single against Corpus Christi (0-1, 26-44) starter Joey Mancini. The Hooks tied the game at 1-1 when Jacob Melton crossed the plate on an RBI single by Collin Price in the top of fourth. **Kellen Strahm** put the Riders back ahead with another two-out RBI, singling to center to plate Rodriguez. Corpus Christi evened the score at 2-2 when Melton scored on a balk by **Josh Stephan**. Stephan finished his start going 6.0 innings, surrendering two runs on five hits and a walk while fanning five. **Steven Jennings** (5-0) delivered 2.0 hitless, scoreless frames while issuing two walks and striking out two. In the bottom of the eighth inning **Cody Freeman** launched his eighth homer of the year against Walker Brockhouse (0-1), giving the Riders a 3-2 advantage. **Tyler Owens** slammed the door, picking up two punchouts on his way to his third save of the season. Offensively, Rodriguez notched the only multi-hit performance. The second baseman notched two doubles and a single to mark his fourth three-hit game of the year.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING

Yesterday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on last Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### **BROKEN BATS:**

In their series against the RockHounds, the RoughRiders struggled offensively. Their 15 total runs across their last seven games are last in the league while they have slashed .202/.274/.303/.577 with three home runs. Frisco hit seven home runs in their last home series against Amarillo. Frisco lost three of the six games last week by one run while losing five of six. It was their first time losing five of six in a series this season and their first time losing five games in a series since 5/9-13/2023 vs. Wichita (lost all five in a rain-shortened series). In that series, the Riders were outscored 54-29 in five games, while the Riders were outscored 19-12.

### **DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (39) while also tying for the best fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 67 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco have allowed the second-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (46), throwing out 28 percent of total base runners against them.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.92 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs on Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last five series, spanning 26 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.63 ERA (17ER/93.2IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his eight outings, throwing 16.1 innings.

### FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 17 games, the Riders have allowed just 33 earned runs over 148.0 IP (2.01 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.52 through the first 21 games. Having won 21 of their last 28 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.35) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (9) and tied for first in wins (20) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Palm Beach) has a 2.94 ERA. In those last 28 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just seven times and four times in the last 16 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses last week marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

### HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 33 games, batting .333 (37-for-111)/.449/.468/.917 with six doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks, 12 strikeouts and 21 runs. In his last 17 games, he is hitting .350 (21-for-60)/.473/.567/1.040. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

### RISP-ECT THIS

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 35 games, they are 22-13, but are hitting .240 (66-for-275) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .269 with RISP.

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whifted 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning completegame, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over  $20.2\,\mathrm{IP}$  (1.31 ERA).

-Tossed first QS of the year on 6/19 at MID, allowing two-run single on final pitch of the outing before the batter was backpicked at first to end the inning.

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

### **2022 SEASON**

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### **2019 SEASON**

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
