NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 5-2, on Thursday night at Delta Dental Stadium. RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out a career-high 12 batters over six innings and **Matt Rudick** hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the top of the ninth to lead the Ponies to victory.

JOANDERFUL: Mets No. 28 prospect RHP **Joander Suárez** is slated to start tonight for Binghamton. He will make his second start against New Hampshire this season. Suárez made his season debut against the Fisher Cats at home on April 5 and tossed five scoreless innings with six strikeouts, while allowing two hits and two walks. The 24-year-old is coming off his longest start of the season of 5.2 innings against New Hampshire on Friday, but he allowed five runs on five hits with five strikeouts and three walks.

STUART NOT SO LITTLE: Mets No. 18 prospect RHP **Tyler Stuart** was masterful in his start against New Hampshire last night. Stuart struck out a career-high 12 batters over six innings of work, while allowing one run on four hits and a walk. After allowing a lead off hit in the first inning, Stuart struck out the next six batters in a row. He struck out at least two batters in four of his six innings of work. Stuart's six innings is the longest start for a Rumble Ponies pitcher this season. In three career starts against New Hampshire, Stuart is 2-0 with 23 strikeouts over 19 innings of one-run ball.

GUTS GLORY RAM: Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramírez** recorded his team-leading sixth multi-hit game and third three-hit game of the season last night. Ramírez went 3-for-4 with two doubles, an RBI, a run scored, a walk and two stolen bases. The 21-year-old is hitting .361 over his first 16 Double-A games. He has six multi-hit games, seven extra base hits, including a homer, five doubles, a triple, six walks, nine RBIs, and is 9-for-12 in stolen bases in 16 games. Here are Ramírez's current Eastern League ranks: 2nd in AVG (.361), 2nd in hits (22), 2nd in stolen bases (9), T-8th in OPS (.937), and 10th in SLG (.525). He is currently riding a three-game hitting streak, hitting .545 (6-for-11) in that span.

RUDY: Mets outfield prospect **Matt Rudick** slugged his first home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the ninth inning last night against New Hampshire. Rudick recorded his third multi-RBI game of the season. The 25-year-old hit nine home runs in 67 games last season, after hitting a combined four home runs in 111 games over his first two professional seasons.

THOMAS THE TANK: Mets No. 30 prospect **Rhylan Thomas** is off to a scorching hot start to the season, hitting .327 with a .410 on-base percentage and 17 hits over his first 14 games. Here are Thomas' current Eastern League ranks: 7th in AVG (.327) and T-9th in hits (17). He had the night off last night, but is 1-for-5 with two RBIs, two walks, and a stolen base over his first two games of the series. Thomas is currently riding a seven-game on-base streak.

BIG BMAC: Mets outfield prospect **Brandon McIlwain** reached base two more times on Thursday night, with two walks. McIlwain extended his on-base streak to six games. In two games in this series, the 25-year-old is 2-for-6 with a multi-hit game, double, two walks, and a run scored. Over his 6-game on-base streak, McIlwain is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with two doubles, three walks, and an RBI.

LAST START: Suárez allowed five runs on five hits and three walks over a season-high 5.2 innings with five strikeouts on Friday against Reading at home.

2024 SEASON: Began the season with Double-A Binghamton...Tossed five scoreless innings with six strikeouts in season debut against New Hampshire.

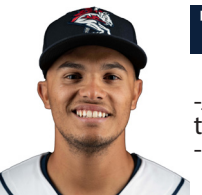
