**LAST TIME DUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 5-2, on Thursday night at Delta Dental Stadium. RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out a career-high 12 batters over six innings and **Matt Rudick** hit a goahead two-run homer in the top of the ninth to lead the Ponies to victory.

JOANDERFUL: Mets No. 28 prospect RHP Joander Suárez is slated to start tonight for Binghamton. He will make his second start against New Hampshire this season. Suárez made his season debut against the Fisher Cats at home on April 5 and tossed five scoreless innings with six strikeouts, while allowing two hits and two walks. The 24-year-old is coming off his longest start of the season of 5.2 innings against New Hampshire on Friday, but he allowed five runs on five hits with five strikeouts and three walks.

**STUART NOT SD LITTLE:** Mets No. 18 prospect RHP **Tyler Stuart** was masterful in his start against New Hampshire last night. Stuart struck out a career-high 12 batters over six innings of work, while allowing one run on four hits and a walk. After allowing a lead off hit in the first inning, Stuart struck out the next six batters in a row. He struck out at least two batters in four of his six innings of work. Stuart's six innings is the longest start for a Rumble Ponies pitcher this season. In three career starts against New Hampshire, Stuart is 2-0 with 23 strikeouts over 19 innings of one-run ball.

**GUTS GLORY RAM:** Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramírez** recorded his team-leading sixth multi-hit game and third three-hit game of the season last night. Ramírez went 3-for-4 with two doubles, an RBI, a run scored, a walk and two stolen bases. The 21-year-old is hitting .361 over his first 16 Double-A games. He has six multi-hit games, seven extra base hits, including a homer, five doubles, a triple, six walks, nine RBIs, and is 9-for-12 in stolen bases in 16 games. Here are Ramírez's current Eastern League ranks: 2nd in AVG (.361), 2nd in hits (22), 2nd in stolen bases (9), T-8th in OPS (.937), and 10th in SLG (.525). He is currently riding a three-game hitting streak, hitting .545 (6-for-11) in that span.

**RUDY:** Mets outfield prospect **Matt Rudick** slugged his first home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the ninth inning last night against New Hampshire. Rudick recorded his third multi-RBI game of the season. The 25-year-old hit nine home runs in 67 games last season, after hitting a combined four home runs in 111 games over his first two professional seasons.

**THOMAS THE TANK:** Mets No. 30 prospect **Rhylan Thomas** is off to a scorching hot start to the season, hitting .327 with a .410 on-base percentage and 17 hits over his first 14 games. Here are Thomas' current Eastern League ranks: 7th in AVG (.327) and T-9th in hits (17). He had the night off last night, but is 1-for-5 with two RBIs, two walks, and a stolen base over his first two games of the series. Thomas is currently riding a seven-game on-base streak.

**BIG BMAC:** Mets outfield prospect **Brandon McIlwain** reached base two more times on Thursday night, with two walks. McIlwain extended his on-base streak to six games. In two games in this series, the 25-year-old is 2-for-6 with a multi-hit game, double, two walks, and a run scored. Over his 6-game on-base streak, McIlwain is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with two doubles, three walks, and an RBI.



-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

### PITCHING COACH

-AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.
