## GAME NOTES

**DERBY DAY:** With the 152nd Kentucky Derby taking place at Churchill Downs in Louisville this evening, the below notes are **Bubbling Over** with the names of 25 previous Kentucky Derby winning horses. Each season, the Bats are on the road on the day of the Kentucky Derby as the sports world turns its attention to Louisville for the "Run for the Roses." Since 1982, Louisville is 18-28 all-time on Derby Day (all road games). The Bats have played five Derby Day doubleheaders in franchise history, getting swept at Omaha in 1996 and at Charlotte in 2006, while splitting twin bills at Buffalo (1990, 2009) and Iowa (1997). Louisville did not play on Derby Day in 1993 due to a rainout and did not play in 2020 or 2021 due to the pandemic. Today's matchup marks the fourth Derby Day game between Louisville and **Omaha**, with Louisville still searching for its first win (0-3) after a doubleheader sweep in 1996 and an 11-9 loss in 2023.

**RUNNING OUT OF THE GATE:** While stealing in some situations could result in a **Citation**, the Bats did not **Regret** the decision to take a **Genuine Risk** and on Omaha catcher Luca Tresh on Saturday night, stealing a season-high six bases in the 9-5 win. The six steals came from a pair each by Michael Chavis and former Chattanooga **Lookout** Hector Rodriguez, as well as one steal each from Noelvi Marte and Garrett Hampson. In this series at Werner Park, the Bats have proved to be **Agile** on the bases, stealing 16 in 17 attempts. The 16 stolen bases this week are already the most by Louisville in a single series this season, and there are still two games to go this weekend.

**SCOOT SAVES THE DAY:** On Saturday, Louisville turned to Sam Benschoter to preserve a 9-5 lead with two outs in the ninth inning and the tying run on deck. He dispatched John Rave with a strikeout to end the ballgame, earn his first save of the season, and silence the **Chant** from the Werner Park crowd, who were hoping to see a ninth-inning comeback. **Charismatic** Bats Manager Pat Kelly hasn't needed to **Determine** an everyday closer to this point, as the Bats bullpen has proven to be a **Super Saver** in 2026, with seven different relievers recording a save through the team's first 31 games. The **Swaps** in late inning situations have been critical to Louisville's hot start to the 2026 season.

**MARTE ON THE MOVE:** Noelvi Marte was just named International League Player of the Week (4/20-26) after an **Unbridled** offensive series at Iowa, where he batted .429 (14-25) with two home runs, seven runs scored, and six stolen bases in five games last week. Since being optioned to Louisville on 4/13, Marte has been able to **Strike the Gold** at the plate, with a .393 (22-56) average while ranking among the league leaders in several offensive categories in that span including batting average (3rd, .393), stolen bases (T-1st, 8) hits (1st, 22), runs (T-5th, 14), and total bases (T-5th, 34). He also stole a base in six straight games from 4/21-28, becoming the first Bats player to do so since Zack Cozart, who swiped a bag in seven straight games from 5/18-5/24/2010. Since 2005, Cozart's streak is the longest by any Louisville player. Marte's stolen bases streak came to an end in Wednesday's win, as he went 0-4 at the plate.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Bats have begun their road schedule on a high note this season, going 11-5 in their first 16 road games to **Justify** their place near the top of the International League standings, with an **Authentic** approach on the road, keeping opposing ballparks **Real Quiet**. The Bats began their 2026 road slate by taking four of six at Indianapolis from 4/7-4/12. It also marked Louisville's first road series win of the season, a feat which the 2025 Bats did not accomplish until taking four of six at Gwinnett from 8/12-17, their 11th road series of the season. This year's Bats followed it up by winning four of six against the I-Cubs last week at Principal Park, their second straight road series win to start the season. Last year, the Bats were only able to win the one road series for the entire season. Louisville has continued the strong start with three wins in four games this week in Omaha as they will look for a third straight road series win tonight. This strong trend is a change from recent years, where the road has not been kind to the Bats. They went 30-46 away from Louisville Slugger Field last season and a league-worst 28-48 on the road in 2024.

**BIG BASHING BATS:** The Bats have flipped the script with an offensive **Assault** in 2026, as their early success has **Affirmed** their place among the International League's best after a middle-of-the-pack finish last season. Through 31 games, Louisville leads the IL in batting average (.289), slugging (.483), runs (190), hits (312), and triples (10), while ranking second in RBI (175) and on-base percentage (.379). The Bats also rank third in doubles (61) and are tied for third in home runs (43). Louisville is averaging 6.1 runs and 10.1 hits per game, a significant jump from 5.1 runs and 8.5 hits per game over the course of the 2025 season. The Bats have been **Shut Out** only twice through the first 31 games this year.

**AND THEY'RE OFF:** Louisville's attack has often been a **Cavalcade** around the bases in the first inning, leading the International League with 33 runs in the first inning while hitting a league-best .317 in the opening frame through 31 games. The Bats put their noses to the **Grindstone** in the first, collected a league-high 39 hits, including 18 extra-base hits (12 doubles and six home runs), and have driven in 31 runs in the first inning, also tops in the IL. The 33 first-inning runs scored by the Bats are the most in MiLB. Louisville has reached base at a league-best .401 clip and is the only team batting over .300 in the opening frame. The Bats added to their totals with three more runs in the first inning of Saturday's 9-5 win.

**BATS FLYING HIGH:** Louisville's hot start to the 2026 season has put them in rare territory in the history of the club. The Bats' 18 wins before the calendar turned to May are the most in franchise history, **Decidedly** more than the previous high of 16 pre-May victories, reached in 2011 (16-7), 2008 (16-11), and 2000 (16-6). However, those earlier Louisville teams did not have to begin the **Bold Venture** of a season with March baseball, giving this year's club even more to **Ponder** as the wins piled up in March and April.

PLAYER NOTES

**Tonight's Start:** 28-year-old LHP Nick Lodolo makes a rehab start for the Louisville Bats tonight. It's Lodolo's third appearance of the season after he began the season on the 15-day Injured List with a left index finger blister.

**Vs. Omaha:** Lodolo faces off against the Storm Chasers for the first time in his career, despite nine career games with the Bats from 2021-24.

**Last Time Out/Win:** Lodolo made a rehab start with High-A Dayton on 4/28, throwing for 5.0 innings and allowing two hits with seven strikeouts. The Dragons ended up shutting out South Bend, 3-0.

**Bats Career:** Lodolo spent the majority of his time with the Bats in 2021 and 2022, making three appearances in each season. He also made select appearances with Louisville in 2023 and 2024. Overall, he has an 0-3 record with a 4.61 ERA with the Bats.

**2026 Season:** Outside of his win at Dayton, Lodolo made one other rehab assignment with Single-A Daytona on 4/2, where he threw 2.2 innings and fanned four batters. Lodolo also played in five games in Spring Training, earning a 1-2 record with a 7.24 ERA.

**2026 Transactions:** On 3/25, placed on the 15-day Injured List with a left index finger blister. On 4/1, sent on a rehab assignment to Daytona. On 4/26, began a rehab assignment to Dayton. Transferred to Louisville today to make another rehab start.

**2025 Season:** Lodolo spent the entire season with Cincinnati, making 28 starts and a single bullpen appearance late in the season. He threw for a 9-8 record in the regular season with a 3.33 ERA. Lodolo's best stretch came from 7/10-7/23, where in three starts pitched 22.0 innings and allowed just two runs. On 7/23, he pitched a complete game shutout at Washington, allowing just four hits with eight strikeouts in 104 pitches. He made one appearance with the Reds in the Wild Card, tossing 1.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen against the Dodgers on 10/1.
