LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox bounced back on Thursday night with a 2-0 shutout win over Akron. Trace Bright, Dylan Heid, Houston Roth and Ryan Watson combined for Bowie's third shutout win of the season. Bright struck out five over 4.1 innings, Heid and Roth each pitched 1.2 innings and Watson collected a four out save in the victory. Offensively, Jud Fabian and Dylan Beavers drove in the only runs of the game on a sac fly and a double, respectively.

REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond. Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- IF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Fries (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Doug Nikhazy makes his fourth start of the season and the 29th of his career with Akron. This is the southpaw's third season with the RubberDucks after debuting with Akron at the end of the 2022 season. Nikhazy has yet to allow an earned run through 11 innings pitched this year. His most recent start on May 5 vs Richmond lasted just one inning and eight pitches as the game entered a rain delay and therefore, he did not continue after. The Burlington, NC native has thrown at least 102 innings and struck out exactly 128 batters in back-to-back seasons. The Guardians 2nd round pick in 2021 was drafted out of Ole Miss and was college teammates with Anthony Servideo and Houston Roth.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After 4.2 innings of shutout ball and six strikeouts from Baysox relievers last night, Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (138.0) and strikeouts (176). 15 of the 16 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Opposing hitters are batting just .205 against the Baysox bullpen, which is good for the fifth-lowest average in all of Double-A.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 0-for-4 on Wednesday, 1B **TT Bowens** had his nine-game hit and on-base streak come to an end. During the hit streak, Bowens batted .387 (12-for-31) with a .474 OBP and a 1.055 OPS. The nine-game hit streak is the longest by a Baysox player so far this season. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is fourth in the Eastern League in batting average (.329), is tied for second in RBI (22), is third in slugging percentage (.570) and fourth in OPS (.970).

SERVIN' IT UP

Although IF **Anthony Servideo's** six-game hit streak came to an end last night after going 0-for-2, he's still on a seven-game on-base streak after drawing a walk. Servideo leads the team in the month of May with a .421 (8-for-19) batting average, two homers, two doubles and seven RBI. The 25-year-old collected an RBI in four consecutive games from May 3 - May 8. His longest hit streak last year was seven consecutive games from June 23 - July 1.

BRANDON ON THE BUMP

RHP **Brandon Young** makes his fourth start of the season and the 13th of his Double-A career. The 25-year-old pitched last week against Erie but lasted just 2.1 innings, gave up one run on three hits with three strikeouts on 45 pitches in his shortest start of the year. Young has struggled at home as he has gone only 3.1 innings with a 5.40 ERA. He has been effective against left-handed hitters, however, as lefties are batting just .217 against him. This is Young's third career start against the RubberDucks. Last time he faced them, he punched out a Double-A high seven batters and gave up just one run over 4.2 innings on Aug. 30, 2023 at Canal Park.

HOME SWEET HOME

Thursday was Bowie's 12th win at home this season, the most by any team in the Eastern League so far. The Baysox are one of just four teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 12 games at home and have won eight of their last 11 here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (111), first in home runs (25), and first in OPS (.826). Bowie clinched its third consecutive home series win after taking three of five against Erie last week.



Made first start of season on 4/9 @ HFD and struck out 7 over 4.1 IP, matching his Double-A strikeout high.

2023: Activated off the 60-day injured list by Bowie on 8/15 and finished the season making six starts for the Baysox in his first Double-A action since 4/22/22. 2022: Started three games for Bowie, not allowing more than one run in any contest, before he was transferred to the injured list for the remainder of the season in late April and underwent Tommy John Surgery.

2021: Split time between Delmarva and Aberdeen, combining for the sixth-most strikeouts in the Orioles' system.

Personal: Signed by the Orioles following the shortened 2020 draft out of Louisiana-Lafayette. Pitched two seasons for the Ragin' Cajuns following two seasons with Howard Community College. Owns a flip phone and does not have any social media.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
