Highlights

Columbus used four multi-run innings to double up the Bisons, with **Travis Bazzana** doubling twice (4RBI) and **CJ Kayfus** doubling once (4RBI). **Juan Benjamin** clocked his first longball of the season, while also picking up his first 2RBI.

Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound in game one, followed by LHP **Logan Allen** in game two. Buffalo will counter with LHP **Josh Fleming** and RHP **CJ Van Eyk**. Columbus is 1-6 (.143) versus left handers this year. Fleming has faced Columbus twice in his career (5.2IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 1BB, 3K) and Van Eyk has pitched against Columbus thrice (15.0IP, 9H, 3R, 3ER, 6BB, 12K).

vs. the Bisons

Since 5/23/09, the Clippers are 42-67 (.385) against the Bisons, despite being outscored by only 34 runs (497-531). Among those 109G, the Clippers are 20-22 (.476) in games decided by at least four runs and 22-45 (.328) in games decided by three or fewer. In Buffalo, the Clippers have been victorious in 12 of the last 18G, winning both series played since the expansion of the International League.

Bizarro Weekend

The Clippers won their first Friday game of the season last week (6-21 on Friday since starting last year 5-0) and followed up with their first Saturday loss the next night (29-10 on Saturday since starting the 2024 season 2-12). They ended last week with a win on Sunday, as they are now 9-24 on Sundays since September '24. Since winning in Buffalo on 6/15/25, Columbus is 1-7 in Sunday road games.

Left Behind

Today will mark the eighth time this year that Columbus will face off against a southpaw starter (33G last year) and the lineup is slashing .223/.333/.314 (13th, 11th and 18th in the IL; last season: .228/.307/.390, 20th, 20th and 14th). **George Valera** is the only Clipper to have taken a lefty deep this year (188AB), as Columbus is tied with Jacksonville for fewest (33HR off righties, tied with Iowa for 1st).

Under the Radar

Petey Halpin extended his hit streak to 11G on Friday (.300, 15x50, since 4/12), tying his career best (4/30-5/14/24), while reaching base in his 13th straight (.344OBP since 4/10). He also established a career high with 4SB on Friday (sixth multi-SB game), tying a franchise record (sixth time, last: **Oscar Mercado** on 4/17/19 at Louisville). Halpin's 103 runs since his Triple-A debut (3/28/25) lead the IL.

Discerning Eye

Travis Bazzana earned a pair of walks Friday night (8BB in 21PA this series, 8BB in 73PA of 15G prior), boosting his walk rate to 18% (24% last year). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/12/25, Bazzana has walked more than anyone else in the IL (49; 2nd best OBP, .424). Over his last 12G, he has reached base in all (.552OBP), while hitting .409 (18x44) with 11XBH (.750SLG; leads IL with 11 doubles).

Still Dominating

Stuart Fairchild was hitless on Wednesday, but he is still 10x25 (.400) with 4XBH (.640SLG) over his last 6G (hitless in 16AB of 5G prior, 4/8-4/14, following a 14x33, .424, start to the season; 5XBH and .727SLG in first 9G). His strikeout rate is down over the last week (13%; at 23% through first 14G), but so is the walk rate (7%; at 16% in first 14G). Fairchild also has 3SB in his last 6G (1SB in first 14G),

Buffalo Blues

Kody Huff is 0x15 this week, following a close to the Iowa series that saw him go 5x13 with 4XBH (2HR) and 7RBI in the last 3G. He has managed to draw a pair of walks against the Bisons (0BB in previous 7G, 31PA), but he hasn't scored any runs (4G, longest scoring drought this year). As a team, the Clippers have 29BB this series (29BB in 6G vs. Iowa; 22BB in first 2G at Worcester, 12BB in last 4G).

I'm Not the Capatin Now

Maick Collado is joining Columbus from Lake County today, having hit .147/.205/.294 with 1HR (5RBI) in 10G for the Captains. Today will mark his 329th career game, but first above Advanced-A (188G in Lake County since 2024). Collado will bat before **Juan Benjamin**, who also maxed out with Lake County prior to this year (88G in '25; **Kevin Rivas** played 50 of 157G at Lake County prior to Friday).

Bad Dream

Wednesday's multi-error game was the seventh of the year for the defense (all since 4/3; .968 fielding percentage in the last 19G, worst in the IL), as they now have 21E through 25G. Last year, the Clippers made multiple mistakes in only 14G total and it took until game #46 for them to reach 21E. Columbus pitchers (6E) and catchers (5E), have paired to form the worst defensive battery in the IL (.959).

This Date in Clipper History

4/26/2006

Kris Wilson (7.0IP), **Scott Erickson** (1.0IP) and **Jose Veras** (1.0IP), combined to shutout Louisville in a 3-0 Clipper win at Cooper Stadium. **Kevin Reese's** solo HR in the 1st was the offensive highlight of the game. Wilson, an all-around good guy, was slated to be the Clipper representative in the Triple-A All-Star Game at Toledo that season, but was unable to attend due to a promotion to New York.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,417 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 31-34 (.477) in pitch reviews, with batters going 19-24 (.442) and pitchers/catchers going 12-10 (.545). They have run out of challenges in 14G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-35 when playing past regulation (.588, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 85G to require extra play, 68 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.975), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 14G this season (8-6, .571), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 399-418 (.488), 369-372 with Columbus (.498).

Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 84.3 (along with **Trenton Denholm**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 490G ago)

2026 Spring Training:
