### WINNING STREAK ENDS WITH 10-8 DEFEAT

Jacksonville saw its seven-game winning streak come to a close on Saturday with a 10-8 loss in 10 innings to Gwinnett. After the Stripers scored in the first, the Jumbo Shrimp plated three in the bottom of the first to grab the lead. Gwinnett rallied with two in the sixth to retake the advantage, but Jacksonville scored three more runs in the bottom of the sixth to go out in front. After eventually building an 8-5 margin in the ninth, Gwinnett rallied to tie the score before plating two more in the 10th inning to win the ballgame.

#### DON'T CRY. SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED

Jacksonville's seven-game winning streak - their longest in the month of April since a seven-game run from April 12-18, 2009, and matching their best from the entirety of the 2021 season - came to an end Saturday with a 10-8 defeat to Gwinnett. Nonetheless, over the past eight games, Jacksonville has outscored their opponents by a whopping 59-24 margin, compiling a 86-45 advantage in hits and 12-3 margin in home runs. Since this 7-1 stretch began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for fifth out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in both runs and hits, and a tie for fifth fewest in MiLB during this span, with Jacksonville's 2.19 team ERA also placing fifth.

### **CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE**

Charles Leblanc went 2-for-5 with two RBIs on Saturday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has now registered multiple hits in six of his 13 games this year, and on the season, ranks fourth in the International League in batting average (.375), OBP (.456) and OPS (1.144). He also places sixth in slugging percentage (.688) and tied for 10th in RBIs (13).

### **SELF-STARTERS**

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last seven games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded just 10 runs, six earned, in 33.1 innings for a 1.62 ERA. During this seven-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 19 strikeouts against 27 hits and 13 walks.

#### TO THE MAX

Right-hander **Max Meyer** makes the start in Sunday's series finale against Gwinnett, and the University of Minnesota product is hoping to continue an outstanding beginning to his season. Among the 89 pitchers in the International League with at least 10.0 innings pitched this season, Meyer owns the circuit's highest swinging-strike rate (20.3 percent), helping him strike out 37.7 percent of opposing hitters thus far, a figure that ranks fourth in the league, and post a 32.1 K-BB%, which ranks second. When opponents do put the ball in play, Meyer has registered the IL's ninthhighest ground ball rate (64.3 percent) and 10th-lowest fly ball rate (18.8 percent). Consequently, Meyer is the league-leader in FIP (1.61) while placing second in xFIP (2.25) and 10th in ERA (1.23).

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 22 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

### LEWIN AND <del>CLARK</del> BURDICK

Both **Lewin Díaz** and **Peyton Burdick** have gotten off to a strong starts. Díaz is 16-for-60, slashing .267/.375/.467/.842 with three doubles, three home runs, 15 RBIs and 12 runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' reigning Minor League Player of the Year, is 12-for-47, slashing .255/.417/.511/.928 with a double, triple, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 17 runs scored. Thus, of the 105 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks second in the IL - the pair have accounted for 44 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs), a ratio of 41.9 percent.

### SHRIMP SPECK

**Lorenzo Quintana** ranks seventh in the IL in average (.346) and slugging (.673) and 10th in OPS (1.048).

## ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-Meyer is currently ranked among the top 50 prospects in baseball by Baseball Prospectus (No. 24) and MLB.com (No. 35).

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

### 2022 SEASON

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

### **2021 SEASON**

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in innings pitched (101.0).

-Among the 200 pitchers who recorded at least 50.0 innings in Double-A at the time of Meyer's promotion, he ranked 12th in ERA (2.41) and 30th in FIP (3.34) while posting the level's 14th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent) and 26th-lowest fly ball rate (28.3 percent).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
