**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Akron RubberDucks, 8-4, to pick up their third straight win. **Frankie Tostado** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI triple. **Brayan Rocchio** tied the game in the third with a sac fly. Richmond reclaimed the lead, 2-1, with an RBI double by **Franklin Labour**. **Labour** tied the game, 2-2, in the fourth with a sac fly by **Chris Roller**. In the sixth, **Brandon Martorano** moved the Flying Squirrels ahead with an RBI groundout and **Simon Whiteman** followed with a two-run double to open a 5-2 lead. In the seventh, **Diego Rincones** added a run with a sac fly and **Labour** hit a two-run double, extending the lead to 8-2. The RubberDucks scored two runs in the seventh. **Labour** finished the game with two doubles and three RBIs. Richmond scored six runs with two outs in the game. **Kai-Wei Teng** allowed two runs in five innings for his second win. The game dropped Akron out of first place behind Erie, which holds a half-game lead in the Southwest Division.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third and fourth of a six-game series looking to gain ground in the standings against the division leading Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the second between the two teams this season. From May 3-8, the Flying Squirrels won the first three games against the RubberDucks in a series at The Diamond and dropped the final three for a split. After this week, the two teams will meet for one more six-game series, which will be August 23-28 at Canal Park.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won three straight games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they lost four-of-six in a series at home against Hartford, their first series loss at home this year and second straight set dropped. The Flying Squirrels dropped out of first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division on May 22. Thursday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels back to third place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 516 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 205 walks issued.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have lost three straight after going 16-4 from May 6-28. Prior to losing their last three, the RubberDucks had not lost consecutive games since dropping three straight against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond from May 3-5. Thursday's loss dropped Akron out of first place in the Eastern League Southwest Division behind Erie by a half-game. The RubberDucks are the defending Double-A Northeast champions after picking up their sixth league title since 2003 last year. This year's Akron roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including RHP Daniel Espino (1 - on IL), OF George Valera (2), INF Brayan Rocchio (4), LHP Logan Allen (8), INF Jose Tena (9), RHP Tanner Burns (11 - on IL), C Bo Naylor (15), RHP Xzavion Curry (22) and RHP Ethan Hankins (24 - on IL).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** takes the mound for his second Double-A start in Game 1. In his Double-A debut against the Yard Goats on Friday in Richmond, Harrison allowed two runs over 5.2 innings. With his debut, he became the youngest pitcher in Flying Squirrels history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 2 prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

In Game 2, right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his 10th start of the season and second against the RubberDucks. Last time out, he worked five walks, tying a season high, and allowed two runs in 3.2 innings in a loss against Hartford on Saturday at The Diamond. He last faced Akron on May 4 in Richmond and allowed two runs over six innings with seven strikeouts. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. **For more on Brickhouse, see page three.**

**FOR AKRON:** Left-hander Logan Allen makes his 10th start of the season and his second against Richmond. In his last start, Allen pitched four innings and allowed four runs in a loss against New Hampshire last Friday. He also pitched against Richmond at The Diamond on May 3 and struck out seven, allowing one run over five innings. Allen began the season going 2-1 with a 1.95 ERA (7 ER/32.1 IP) in his first seven starts. Over his last three starts since May 15, Allen is 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (15 ER/15.0 IP), including allowing a season-high seven runs on May 15 against Erie. Allen was selected by Cleveland in the second round (56th overall) in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Florida International University. Allen is rated by MLB.com as Cleveland's No. 8 prospect. Entering his start today, Allen is third in the Eastern League with 65 strikeouts tied for seventh with 47.1 innings pitched.

In Game 2, right-hander Xzavion Curry makes his 10th appearance of the season and his ninth start. He picked up a win on Saturday against New Hampshire after allowing four runs (three earned) over 6.2 innings. He pitched at The Diamond against the Flying Squirrels on May 4 and allowed one run over five innings with eight strikeouts. Curry was selected in the seventh round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Georgia Tech. Curry is ranked seventh in the EL in BAA (.210) and eighth in WHIP (1.07).

**LOPSIDED:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -19 runs. In their last 14 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 6.4 runs. Of those 14 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on May 22 at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last 14 losses.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,040) and total attendance (144,959). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 61 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (67). **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 12 homers on the season, with 10 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs.

**BRETT'S BASHING:** **Brett Auerbach** homered in back-to-back games on Sunday and Tuesday. He went deep in the Flying Squirrels' 22-7 win on Sunday over Hartford, one of a franchise-record seven homers in the game for the team. He hit a two-run homer on Tuesday at Akron to tie the game in a 3-2 win. Auerbach has picked up at least one RBI in seven-of-his-last-11 games since May 19, totaling 10 RBIs.

**MARTY PARTY:** Over his last 17 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .323 (20-for-62) with five homers, three doubles, two triples and 14 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. He added a solo homer in last Sunday's series finale at Altoona. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in Thursday's 8-4 win over the 'Ducks.

**TOASTY:** **Frankie Tostado** is batting .346 (45-for-130) with seven homers, seven doubles, a triple and 22 RBIs over his last 33 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 36 of his 43 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.327), ninth in SLG (.524), ninth in OPS (.894), tied for second in hits (55) and fourth in total bases (88).

**ROBUST:** With two homers on Sunday, **Sean Roby** held his spot in third in the league with 12 home runs this season. He also set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. He has hit 10 homers at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with **Adam Duvall** (2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking three in his last five games since May 26.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.327), ninth in SLG (.524), ninth in OPS (.894), tied for second in hits (55) and fourth in total bases (88). **Sean Roby** is third in home runs (12). **Shane Matheny** ranked 10th in batting average (.302), fifth in OBP (.413), eighth in SLG (.538) and fifth in OPS (.951). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for fifth (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fourth in saves (5).

**WHERE THE DUCKS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Will Brennan is ranked seventh in batting average (.311), first in RBIs (39), 10th in OPS (.886), tied for seventh in doubles (12), Bo Naylor is fourth in OBP (.417) and fourth in walks (32). Jose Tena is fifth in hits (52), tied for seventh in triples (3) and tied for eighth in runs scored (30). George Valera is seventh in walks (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (32). Nic Enright is second in saves (8).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
