GAME INFORMATION

CHEF GORDON: RHP R.J. Gordon, the Mets' No. 25 prospect, is slated to make his seventh Double-A start tonight. Gordon is 4-0 with a 3.29 ERA in Double-A. Gordon was named the Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Week, after he took a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his last start and finished with seven strikeouts and two hits allowed over 7.0 scoreless innings in the win at Portland on Wednesday. Gordon is Binghamton's only pitcher to spin 7.0 innings in multiple starts this season, and the 23-year-old has done it three times in his first six starts at the Double-A level. WINNING: The Rumble Ponies are 78-40 overall and are 38 games above .500. Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.661) in Double-A and the 3rd-best in Minor League Baseball, behind Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.706) and Pittsburgh's High-A Greensboro (.689). Binghamton is on-pace for 89 wins, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013). Binghamton won the Northeast Division First-Half title, and clinched a spot in the postseason with a 45-22 (.672) record.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Portland Sea Dogs 12-10 in a wild back-andforth series finale at Delta Dental Park at Hadlock Field. The two teams split the series. 1B Jacob Reimer hit a game-tying solo home run and two batters later C Kevin Parada hit a go-ahead solo home run in the 8th inning. CF A.J. Ewing had three hits, three runs, and three stolen bases. 2B D'Andre Smith and Reimer each had three hits and three runs batted in.

REIMER REASON: INF Jacob Reimer, the Mets' No. 6 prospect (MLB Pipeline), hit a game-tying solo home run in the 8th inning and went 3-for-5 with HR, 3 RBI, 2 R, 3B on Sunday at Portland. In five games at Portland last series, Reimer went 8-for-17 (.471 AVG) with a 1.630 OPS, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 4 R, & 5 XBH. Over his last 10 games, Reimer is hitting .500 (18-for-36) with a .571 OBP, .972 SLG, 1.544 OPS, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 9 R, & 8 XBH. The 21-year-old has risen his AVG from .200 to .267 and OPS from .662 to .857 at the Double-A level over that span. He was named to the MiLB Prospect Team of the Week last week. Reimer is ranked as MLB Pipeline's No. 3 third baseman prospect in baseball. EWING IT ALL: OF A.J. Ewing, the Mets' No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline), has reached base safely in 11 of his first 12 Double-A games, with 19 H, 3 RBI, 9 R, and 7 SB. Ewing has recorded five-straight multi-hit games and has seven multi-hit games in 12 games at the Double-A level. Over his last five games, Ewing is 12-for-23 (.522 AVG) with a .542 OBP, 1.281 OPS, 2 RBI, 5 R, 5 2B, & 4 SB. The 21-year-old has 65 stolen bases in 108 games across three levels, which ranks T-4th in Minor League Baseball. The 2023 fourth-round pick is hitting .314 with an .845 OPS across Single-A St. Lucie, High-A Brooklyn, and Double-A Binghamton this year.

PARADA PARTY: C Kevin Parada hit a go-ahead solo home run in the 8th inning on Sunday at Portland, which marked his 10th home run of the season and second 8th-inning go-ahead homer (August 9 @ Somerset). He is riding a 6-game hit streak, a 12-game on-base streak and has reached base in 14 of his 15 games in August (17-for-52, .327 AVG, .417 OBP, .955 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 6 R, 5 2B, 7 XBH, 7 BB). He recorded his first 3-hit game on May 16 and since then has produced a .305 AVG (4th in AA), .531 SLG (3rd in AA), .906 OPS (5th in AA), 9 HR, 41 RBI over a 61-game span. Parada ranks among the Eastern League in that span: OPS (2nd), SLG (2nd), AVG (3rd), 19 2B (T-5th), .376 OBP (7th), RBI (T-7th), 29 XBH (T-8th). In 8 games against Somerset this season, Parada has produced a .423 AVG, .545 OBP, 1.353 OPS, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 7 R, & 7 BB.

MDRABITO MAGIC: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets' No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is 1 of only 5 players in Minor League Baseball with 50+ RBI, 40+ stolen bases, and 25+ doubles this season. The 22-year-old ranks T-3rd in Double-A with 41 stolen bases. He has 20 hits in his first 21 games, since being activated off the 7-day injured list on July 29. The 22-year-old has career highs in HR (6), RBI (50), and 2B (25) this season. Morabito ranks among the Eastern League: SB (T-2nd), 2B (T-5th), 104 H (6th), 57 R (8th), .281 AVG (8th).

SUPER SUERO: C/1B/LF Chris Suero, the Mets' No. 15 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a 22-game on base streak, which marks the longest for any Binghamton hitter this season. Suero is tied for the 2nd-longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League, behind Reading's Keaton Anthony (25). The 21-year-old has 21 H, 6 XBH, 14 RBI, 14 R, and 15 BB over his first 25 games at Double-A.

LAST START: Gordon earned the win (4-0) and spun 7.0 shutout innings with seven strikeouts and just two hits and two walks allowed...He spun a career-high-tying 7.0 innings and took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, before giving up a single with one out to Allan Castro...Faced the minimum over the first 5.0 innings and retired 14-straight after issuing a leadoff walk in the first inning. (Named Mets MiLB Pitcher of the Week).

2025 SEASON: Named Mets MiLB Pitcher of the Week after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings and taking a no-hitter in to the 7th inning in a win at Portland on August 20...Dominated in Double-A debut against Altoona on July 10 (W, 7 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K)...Promoted to Double-A Binghamton on July 7... Ranked among the South Atlantic League with 3.06 ERA (7th), 76 SO (T-9th), and .233 BAA (10th) at the time of his promotion...Made 15 appearances and 11 starts and went 5-2 with a 3.06 ERA and 76 strikeouts-to-31 walks in 67.2 innings.. Began first season of professional baseball with High-A Brooklyn. LAST SEASON: Returned to the mound for his final season at Oregon, after missing all of 2023 due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery... As a redshirt junior in 2024 at Oregon, he wen t7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable for the Ducks...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, the Santa Barbara Regional, and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in starts (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87)...Gordon was initially recruited to Eugene as a two-way player.

BACKGROUND: Originally drafted by the New York Mets in the 13th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Oregon...Spent four seasons (three active, missed 2023 with internal brace surgery) at Oregon and tied for 10th in program history with 28 career starts (51 APP, 28 GS, 14-9, 5.22 ERA, 155 SO, 182.2 IP)...2024 All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention...Grew up in Santa Clarita, California and finished his high school career at West Ranch High School...Began his high school career at Notre Dame HS and was a freshman when RHP Hunter Greene (Cincinnati Reds) was a senior...Father Jason played professional

golf on the PGA Tour, the Canadian PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour.



HOMETOWN: St. Amant, La. -Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16). -In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A.
