**GOOD TIMES ARE ROLLING:** After winning four straight games to grab sole possession of first place in the 2nd half in the North Division, the FredNats will aim to tie their season-long win streak tonight with their fifth straight against the Delmarva Shorebirds. Fredericksburg is 9-1 this year against Delmarva, outscoring the Shorebirds 62-26 this season. Tonight, RHP Travis Sykora makes the 10th start of his professional career and the first against Delmarva. Sykora has allowed just three runs in his last three starts. He faces Delmarva righty Nestor German, who has led the resurgence of Shorebird pitching the last month of the season.

**SO VERY CLOSE**: The FredNats were one strike away from the first 9-inning no-hitter in franchise history last night, but Aron Estrada's single with two outs in the 9th against Samuel Vasquez ended the no-hit bid and ended the shutout in a 6-1 FredNat win. Dannel Diaz pitched four perfect innings in a spot start, Johan Otanez walked two but did not allow a hit in two scoreless innings, and Mason Denaburg pitched two perfect innings in the 7th and 8th. Elijah Green had a two-out, bases clearing triple in the 2nd.

STARTING PITCHING SUCCESS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last three series. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 87 2/3 innings and allowed just 17 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.75. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In 32 innings last series against Salem, the starters allowed just five earned runs for an ERA of 1.41, and had 33 strikeouts against just seven walks, and last night, Dannel Diaz pitched four perfect innings in his start.

THIRTY THREE AND OH: The FredNats remain perfect when leading after seven innings this season, with last night's win getting them to 33-0 when leading after seven this year, and also a perfect 35-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

**OH SUSANA**: After another fantastic start Thursday night, Jarlin Susana is one of the hottest pitchers in all of Minor League Baseball. He pitched five innings of one-run ball (run was unearned), didn't walk anyone, and tied his career-high with nine strikeouts, a mark that he's reached now three times in his last five starts. In that time frame, he's pitched 25 innings, allowed three total runs (two earned) for an ERA of 0.72, and has 41 strikeouts against just eight walks. That 0.72 ERA is second in MiLB among qualified pitchers in that time frame.

**OH SYKORA**: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. He's pitched five complete innings in each of his last three starts, and has allowed just three runs in that time frame with 24 strikeouts and only six walks in June.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 31-5 this season when scoring first, including 27 out of the last 28 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, but did score first in each of the four wins last week in Salem.

**RBI KING**: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 53 after his 5th home run on Saturday. This year, Pimentel is hitting .337 with runners in scoring position, and is 12-for-32 (.375) with runners in scoring position and two outs. He's also 5-for-11 with three doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI with the bases loaded this season, being at his very best with the stakes high.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats'leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 183-154 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Travis Sykora is making his 10th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Delmarva Shorebirds. Sykora hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in a start this year.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

**QUICK CLIMBER:** Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sykora fired five complete innings for the third straight week, and gave up two earned runs on four hits, while fanning seven Red Sox and walking just one man.
