RIDERS OUTPOWER HOOKS TO END JUNE:

The Frisco RoughRiders produced eight runs on 13 hits to defeat Corpus Christi at Riders Field Thursday night, 8-3. Led by third baseman **Jax Biggers**' 3-for-3 night, four different Riders finished with multiple hits in the win. Six different Frisco pitchers struck out a combined 11 batters and only gave up three walks. Following a two-inning start from **Tai Tiedemann**, Frisco's bullpen gave up only one earned run on two hits and ten strikeouts. Reliever **Grant Anderson** (5-0) punched out two batters in his scoreless inning, while southpaw **Grant Wolfram** struck out four in two innings of relief. Corpus Christi Jimmy Endersby (2-4) relieved starter Cody Deason for three innings, giving up five runs on eight hits and a pair of walks. Despite the win, the RoughRiders trailed early in Thursday's game, 2-0, as the Hooks got a pair of solo home runs off Tiedemann in the first two innings. **Justin Foscue** helped kickstart the comeback in the bottom of the second with a leadoff double, his third double since June 23rd. With two outs, Biggers began his big night with an RBI single to plate Foscue and trim the Hooks' lead to 2-1. The Riders began the bottom of the third with another leadoff double, this time from left fielder **Dustin Harris**. **Jonathan Ornelas** and **J.P. Martinez** singled consecutively to bring Harris around and tie Thursday's game, 2-2. **Blaine Crim** became the first out of the inning with a sacrifice fly to center field, scoring Martinez and giving Frisco a 3-2 lead. After Corpus Christi tied the game at 3-3 in the top of the fourth, the RoughRiders ran away with Thursday's game with four runs in the bottom of the fifth. Martinez tripled to lead off the attack and was promptly brought in by another sacrifice fly from Crim, giving the Riders the 4-3 lead. Following a Foscue walk and a single from designated hitter **David Garcia**, Biggers doubled to bring Foscue around on a ground ball that deflected off second base and escaped into the outfield. Catcher Matt Whatley singled to score both Garcia and Biggers and cap the four-run frame, giving Frisco a 7-3 advantage. Whatley's single stretches his hitting streak to nine games, a span that dates back to June 12th. Since then, Whatley's tallied 12 hits in 35 at bats (.343) as his season batting average has jumped .054 points since the streak began. Right fielder **Sandro Fabian** led off the inning with a single and advanced to third on another hit from Biggers. Whatley and the Riders offense finished their night with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh to score Fabian and stretch their lead over Corpus Christi, 8-3. Reliever **Marc Church** made his Double-A debut with the Riders Thursday night in a scoreless eighth inning. Fellow right-hander **Fer Ozuna** dealt with the Hooks in the ninth in one-two-three fashion behind a pair of strikeouts.

VS. THE HOOKS:

In the last series the Riders played against Corpus Christi, a series split, there were 22 combined homers in the six games. Over the nine games so far head-to-head, they have combined to hit 24 home runs. **Dustin Harris** has led the way with five homers for the Riders while also driving in 11 runs over his seven games. **David Garcia** also belted two homers himself. The Riders averaged six runs per game over the six games with a .892 team OPS before scoring just two runs over the first two games in this series.

DUSTIN BUSTER:

Dustin Harris is starting to take the same form offensively that he had in April with the RoughRiders. After hitting .292 in April with two home runs, Harris hit just .225 in May, but clubbed seven long balls. In June so far, the Florida native is hitting .272/.372/.853 with four home runs and, overall this season, he is second in the Texas League with 50 RBIs over his 61 games. He is currently on pace for 116 games and 95 RBIs, which would slot him third on the single-season RBI list for the Riders behind **Chad Tracy** (107, 2009) and **Nate Gold** (103, 2006).

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonathan Ornelas** has been on fire at the plate all season long, but recently, he has been even better. For just the second time all season, Ornelas has been held hitless in back-to-back games, going 0-for-8 to start the series against Corpus Christi. Even with that, over his last 16 games, Ornelas is hitting .338 (23-for-68)/.361/.485 with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBIs and six runs. This season, he leads the Riders with 29 multi-hit games and 13 games with three or more hits. Ornelas is the second-leading active hitter in the Texas League with a .330 batting average while he is first in hits (89). He is tied for third in hits in MiLB.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 25 games, Strahm is hitting .369 (31-for-84)/.465/.524 with four doubles, three home runs, 15 walks, 17 runs and seven RBIs. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .261 and his OPS from .528 to .758. The Eugene, Oregon native is riding an 18-game on-base streak, in which he is hitting .343/.429/.537 with 10 walks. In his last 31 games, he is batting .330/.427/.453/.880. Among those with at least 190 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is sixth in walk rate (15.9 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-21 when scoring three runs or fewer and 19-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 72 games, Frisco has hit 94 long balls (1.3 per game) which is the second-most in the Texas League and 16th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 180 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (topping 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). Out of their 72 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 48 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 24 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 11-13. **Trey Hair** and **Dustin Harris** have the team lead with 13, tied for seventh in the league.

ABOUT OWEN

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school offers at QB).

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 16 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MiLB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player candidate if he went to South Carolina.

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvula (40, 1199).

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinings strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From *The Athletic*: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a vry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.

2018-2019 SEASONS

-Did not see action in the 2018 season after being drafted as part of Rangers "de-load program".

-Missed the entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.
