## **GAME INFORMATION**

WINNING: The Rumble Ponies are 69-33 overall this season and are a season-best 36 games above .500. Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.676) in Double-A and the 3rd-best winning percentage in Minor League Baseball, behind Pittsburgh's High-A Greensboro (.709) and Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.680). Binghamton is on-pace for 91 wins, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013). Binghamton won the Northeast Division First-Half title, and went 45-22 (.672). LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Somerset Patriots, 6-1, on Wednesday night at TD Bank Ballpark. 1B Ryan Clifford hit two solo home runs, which marked his third multi-home run game this season. LF Carson Benge hit a three-run double in the fifth inning and CF Nick Morabito followed with an RBI double. RHP Trey McLoughlin struck out three batters and earned the win in his return from the injured list and in his first appearance since May 16.

BENGE BINGE: OF Carson Benge, the Mets' No. 4 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 68 prospect, was named the Eastern League Player of the Month for July, in his first full month at the Double-A level. Benge slashed .397/.482/.726/1.208 with 7 HR, 17 RBI, and he walked as many times as he struck out (11). Benge led Double-A in AVG, OBP, SLG, OPS, and runs (22) and ranked second in the EL in HR and RBI in the month, while recording nine multi-hit games and hitting safely in 16 of 18 games played in July. Benge hit a three-run double on Wednesday and over his last eight games since, July 27, Benge is 14-for-35 (.400 AVG) with 5 HR, 11 RBI, 11 R. Since making his Double-A debut on June 24, Benge ranks among the level: 1.070 OPS (1st), .633 SLG (1st), 8 HR (T-2nd), .349 AVG (3rd), .437 OBP (4th), 27 R (T-4th). Among 404 MiLB hitters with 350+ plate appearances this season, Benge ranks 3rd in OPS (.953), 4th in OBP (.423) and 7th in AVG (.317) across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton.

BULLT CLIFFORD TOUGH: 1B/OF Ryan Clifford, the Mets' No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline), crushed two solo HR on Wednesday, which marked his third multi-HR game of the season (leads team) and seventh of his professional career. Clifford is tied for the 5th-most HR (23) in MiLB and only four players in the minors have hit more homers (NYY's Spencer Jones leads MiLB with 29 HR). Clifford leads Double-A in home runs and ranks 2nd with 72 RBI. The 22-year-old also ranks among Double-A: 177TB (1st), 503 SLG (2nd), 42 XBH (2nd), 61 BB (T-3rd), 866 OPS (4th). In 34 games in the second half (since June 24), Clifford is hitting .264 with a .943 OPS, 11 HR, and 32 RBI. He ranks among MiLB in HR (T-2nd) and RBI (T-6th) in that span.

THE JETT: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets' No. 1 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 38 overall prospect, recorded

his 23rd multi-hit game on Wednesday. Williams is the only player in Minor League Baseball with 10+ home runs (10), 25+ doubles (29), and 25+ stolen bases (29) this season. Williams has reached base in 21 of his last 24 games with 4 HR and 12 RBI in that span. He is riding a 3-game hit streak (4-for-10, .400 AVG, 1 RBI, 2 R, 1 2B, 2 BB). The 21-year-old leads Double-A with 44 XBH and 29 2B and also ranks among the level: 67 R (T-1st), .873 OPS (2nd), 59 BB (T-6th), .389 OBP (8th), .484 SLG (8th). Williams ranks top 5 in the Eastern League in OPS (1st), XBH (1st), 2B (1st), R (T-1st), OBP (2nd), BB (3rd), H (T-4th), SB (5th), SLG (5th). BIG NICK ENERGY: 3B/1B Nick Lorusso is riding a 10-game hit streak (14-for-34, .412 AVG, .488 OBP, 1.194 OPS, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 8 R, 4 2B, 6 BB, 4 K). He is the third Rumble Ponies hitter this season to hold a 10-game hit streak. Lorusso has recorded at least one hit in 14 of his last 15 G with 16 RBIs in that span. Since July 13, the 24-year-old his hitting .385 with a 1.171 OPS, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 12 R, 5 2B, 9 XBH, and more walks (8) than strikeouts (7) in his last 14 games, with 5 multi-hit games and 6 multi-RBI games in that span. Lorusso ranks among Double-A in OPS (2nd), AVG (3rd), .712 SLG (3rd), .459 OBP (4th), RBI (T-4th) in that span. SUPER SUPERS: C/1B/LF Chris Suero, the Mets' No. 15 prospect (MLB Pipeline) hit an RBI double on Tuesday and is riding a 3-game hit streak (4-for-9, .444 AVG, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 2 R, 2 2B, 3 XBH) and a 9-game on-base streak (9-for-30, .300 AVG, 1.075 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 8 R, 3 2B, 5 XBH), The 21-year-old has 10 H, 5 XBH, 9 RBI, 8 R, and 8 BB over his first 12 games at the Double-A level. Suero grew up in the Bronx and attended All Hallows High School, before moving to the Dominican Republic to pursue baseball at 15-years-old.

LAST START: Gordon tossed a career-high-tying seven innings and allowed just one run (solo home run) on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts against Harrisburg on Friday night at Mirabito Stadium...Gordon recorded seven innings for the second time in three Double-A starts and is the only Binghamton pitcher to record two 7+ inning outings this season.

HOMETOWN: St. Amant, La. -Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16). -In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
