## **JACKSONVILLE LOSE EARLY LEAD IN 17-6 LOSS**

Despite taking a 4-0 lead after the top of the first, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp surrendered 12 runs in two innings, falling 17-6 to the Memphis Redbirds Thursday night at AutoZone Park. The Jumbo Shrimp took the early lead in the first with four runs off Memphis starter Gordon Graceffo. The Redbirds tied the game at five in the bottom of the second and scored 12 runs between the third and fourth innings to take a commanding 17-5 lead. Jacksonivlle's last run of the night came in the top of the fifth. Memphis' 17 runs is the second time this series the Jumbo Shrimp surrendered 17 runs and third time in '23.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 46 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 73-for-196 at the plate, slashing .372/.424/.474/.898 with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 30 RBIs and 38 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.354) and seventh in OBP (.426). Among the 304 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks second in swingingstrike rate (3.8 percent).

## **AUSTIN POWERS**

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

## FOUR SCORE AND 16 SERIES AGO

Aftrer their loss to Gwinnett Sunday, which split the series, Jacksonville is still without a series win at 121 Financial Ballpark since winning 3-of-5 against Nashville (April 18-23). The Jumbo Shrimp have only won two series since May (May 2-7 at Memphis & July 4-9 at Charlotte), During that five-game set, Jacksonville was outscored 23-17 and outdueled on the mound. The Sounds tallied a 2.68 ERA in 43.2 IP while the Jumbo Shrimp posted a 3.72 ERA in 46.0 IP.

#### MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 37 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 51-for-148, hitting .345/.398/.466/.864 with 10 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 14 RBIs and 28 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 14 multi-hit games in his last 23 games, batting 39-for-104 (.375/.420/.500/.920) with seven doubles, two homers, 10 RBIs and 20 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 233 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (44.5 percent). His 29.8 percent line drive rate is 11th.

#### **ODDS & ENDS**

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 24 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 10-14, with all but three of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 14 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 77 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -45 against their other second-half opponents (DUR, WOR, NAS, GWN & MEM).

## SYSTEM OVERLOAD

Last night's 17-6 loss to Memphis was the third time this season the Jumbo Shrimp allowed 17 runs in a game. Since July 18, Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents (Nashville, Gwinnett and Memphis), 115-77. Despite owning a top 10 batting average in that span (.275, 9th), the pitching staff has posted the league's worst ERA over this 15-game stretch (7.28) while also issuing the most walks in the IL (95). In 2022 the club allowed 13 runs on two different occassions.

## SHRIMP BITES

Chi Chi González's eight innings on Wednesday was the longest outing for a Jacksonville pitcher since Matthew Kent tossed eight innings of relief on September 8, 2022 vs. IOW...Jake Mangum's 11-game hitting streak (7/21-present) is the second-longest this season (Burdick, 16 games).

## ABOUT DANIEL

-Castano was included by the St. Louis Cardinals along with right-handers Sandy Alcantara, and Zac Gallen and outfielder Magneuris Sierra on December 14, 2017 in a trade with the Miami Marlins for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-Castano was originally selected by St. Louis in the 19th round of the 2016 draft out of Baylor.

-A product of Lake Travis High School, one of Castano's teammates in high school was Baker Mayfield, formerly the quarterback of the Cleveland Browns. Castano threw a no-hitter in the District 4A playoff series against Crockett in 2013.

-Castano starred at Baylor University, earning All-Big 12 Honorable Mention in 2015, as well as a spot on the 2014 Big 12 All-Freshman Team. That 2015 season saw Castano post a 3.48 ERA, the 25th-lowest in school history. He tied for first on the team in strikeouts (45) and wins (four), while finishing second in innings pitched (77.1).

## 2023 SEASON

-Placed on the 7-day IL on April 17 and missed 63 games before being reinstated on June 28.

## 2022 SEASON

-Castano began the season with Miami but was optioned to Jacksonville on April 28.

## 2021 SEASON

-In his final start of 2021, Castano no-hit Gwinnett for 7.0 innings before yielding a leadoff single to Chadwick Tromp in the eighth. He ultimately ceded two hits in 8.0 shutout frames.

-Castano made four starts with the Marlins before being optioned on May 9 to Jacksonville.

## 2020 SEASON

-Castano made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 8, 2020 at the New York Mets' Citi Field in Queens.

-After posting a 4.11 ERA in his first four starts (15.1 IP, 16 H, 8 BB, 8 K), Castano went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA over his final three outings, including two starts (14.1 IP, 14 H, 3 BB, 4 K).

## 2019 SEASON

-Castano began the season with High-A Jupiter before earning a promotion on May 28 to Jacksonville.

-The left-hander worked a minimum of 6.0 innings in each of his six starts from July 15 through August 16. During that span, Castano went 5-0 with a 1.73 ERA in 41.2 innings. He whiffed 40 against three walks and 26 hits against.

-Castano matched Jacksonville's Marlins era record (2009-present) by whiffing a career-high 13 batters in a career-best 9.0 innings on August 8 against Mississippi. The outing marked Jacksonville's first nine-inning complete game since Justin Nicolino's gem on July 29, 2014 at Montgomery.

-Including his stints with Jacksonville and Beloit in 2021, Walters posted a 2-3 record with a 4.06 ERA. Walters tossed 58 innings, giving up 46 hits.
-Son of Kent and Beth Walters, has one brother, Garrett. His father Kent played baseball at Mississippi State and brother played baseball at the University of Louisiana at Monroe and was a manager on the Alabama baseball team.

-Walters attended Thompson High School and earned 2013 All-State, All-Metro and All-County honors and was a finalist for the Alabama Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year.
