WINNING STREAK HITS FIVE WITH 8-3 VICTORY

The Jumbo Shrimp scored four runs in the second inning on Tuesday to vault to an 8-3 victory over the Bulls. After Durham plated two in the first, Javier Sanoja laced a three-run triple and Xavier Edwards notched an RBI single in the second. In the third, a Will Banfield sacrifice fly and Tristan Gray home run made it 6-2. An error plated another Jacksonville run in the seventh and Griffin Conine cracked an RBI single in the eighth. A late Durham run in the ninth set the final tally at 8-3. Kyle Tyler ceded just two runs in 5.0 innings to earn the win.

HIGH FIVE!

After dropping the first two games of their set at Gwinnett, the Jumbo Shrimp rallied to win the last four games to claim the series - the club's first series victory since taking four of six from April 23-28 at Memphis. They then won the series opener over Durham for the fifth consecutive victory. This run marks the club's first five-game winning streak since an eight-game roll from August 4-12, 2023. The Jumbo Shrimp have not made an error during this current five-game run.

THE GREAT AWAKENING?

The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out on May 22, marking their 17th loss in 20 games. During that 20-game stretch, Jacksonville ranked 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Over the last five games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated 41 runs - more than half of what they had compiled in the previous 20 games and the most in Triple-A - on 58 hits (1st) with 29 walks (T-2nd). As a team over these last five games, Jacksonville is 58-for-181 (.320/.414/.492/.906) with seven homers and only 36 strikeouts.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 33 of Jacksonville's 52 games (63.6 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 15 of the club's last 21 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 15 of its last 18 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 15-18 (.455) in these affairs.

STARTING THE FIRE

After not having a pitcher toss 8.0 innings since **Chi Chi González** went 8.0 innings on August 2, 2023 at Memphis, the Jumbo Shrimp have seen consecutive starters fire 8.0 innings. This marks the first time since 2019 that the club has had two starters pitch at least 8.0 innings in a start in a season (**Daniel Castano** and **Cody Poteet**). It's also the first time that Jacksonville has had starters go at least 8.0 innings in consecutive games since **Jose Alvarez** tossed 8.0 innings in a 1-0 loss at Mobile on August 2, 2012 and **Graham Taylor** followed that up with 8.0 frames the next day in a 2-0 victory over Montgomery. Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded two runs or fewer in four consecutive games (24.0 IP, 17 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 8 BB, 12 K, 1.88 ERA).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 games, notching nine multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 29-for-77 (.377/.449/.545/.994) with six doubles, two triples, one home run, 16 RBIs, 11 walks and 11 runs scored. Among the 191 IL hitters with at least 100 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (52.3 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 19 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 17-for-hislast-59, slashing .288/.403/.627/1.030 with five doubles, five home runs, 16 RBIs, 12 walks and 12 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 11 of those 19 games.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has posted double-digit hits in three straight games and four of the last five games. The lone exception was a nine-hit effort on Friday at Gwinnett... Jonah Bride ranks second in the IL in OBP (.459), third in OPS (1.056), tied for third in walks (38), sixth in SLG (.597), tied for 10th in extra-base hits (22) and tied for 11th in home runs (10).

ABOUT VALENTE

-Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.

-Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

2024 SEASON

-Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.

-At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

2023 SEASON

-In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).

-As a starter with Asheville, Bellozo posted an 0-3 record and 7.34 ERA in 13 starts (57.2 IP, 65 H, 19 BB, 53 K, .284 BAA). Comparatively, as a reliever, he was 3-0 with a 4.38 ERA in nine appearances (37.0 IP, 41 H, 7 BB, 41 K, .273 BAA).
