### FRES-NOTES

**GRIZZLIES SINK THE PORTS:** The Fresno Grizzlies (23-28, 61-55) forced the Stockton Ports (16-35, 42-73) off the plank 11-5 Thursday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies improved to 80-31 all-time versus the Ports with a 19-8 record this year. The 19 victories against Stockton are now tied for the second-most wins against an opponent in Grizzlies' single-season history (19 in 2022 vs. San Jose; 19 in 2021 vs. Visalia). Thanks to Modesto's 7-6 win against San Jose, the Grizzlies now sit six games back of the Giants in the California League North Division second half standings with 15 contests left to play (with six against one another). The Grizzlies offense scored 11 runs on 11 hits, five walks, one hit by pitch and three Ports' errors. Fresno had four multi-run innings, which included two runs in both the first and seventh frames, three runs in the fifth and four runs in the second. Four Grizzlies batters collected two or more RBI, two or more hits and two or more runs in the offensive salvo. Fresno also yielded six extra-base hits among their 11 total on the night. In his debut, Blake Wright blasted two doubles and a single, recording three RBI. Brad Cumbest also crushed two doubles, driving in two runs and scoring twice. Aidan Longwell finished off the double paloosa, by notching Cumbest in the seventh. Caleb Hobson smashed a two-run homer to left-center field, his fourth clout of the 2024 campaign. Hobson ended his evening with three runs, two stolen bases and a walk. He continues to climb the single-season stolen base leaderboard (37), now sitting in fifth place all-time. Not to be outdone, Braylen Wimmer swiped two bags, each of which leading to two runs scored on the night. He also walked twice. Tevin Tucker raced home twice after playing here yesterday and Kelvin Hidalgo picked up his first two Fresno RBI. Fresno starter Ismael Luciano (3-0) enjoyed the run support, seizing the win after a season-high six innings of work. Luciano was charged for two runs, on two hits and a pair of walks, while striking out five. Yanziel Correa and Jake Madden secured the last three frames. Stockton righty Steven Echavarria (0-5) agonized the setback, allowing six runs over the first two innings. Alejandro Manzano punched out eight, but surrendered five runs in four-plus innings. Bryan Restituyo whiffed three in his five total outs.

**STOCK-PILING SOME STATS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the last of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 80-31 all-time (19-8 this year) against the Ports with a 43-11 all-time record (13-5 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. The 19 victories against the Ports are now tied for the second-most wins against an opponent in Grizzlies' single-season history (19 in 2022 vs. San Jose and 19 in 2021 vs. Visalia). In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

**MENA TOES THE RUBBER:** Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Mena, who will make his fourth Grizzlies start. Mena made 13 appearances (six starts) with the ACL Rockies this season. He went 2-4 with one hold and two saves, logging a 4.89 ERA. In 46 innings, Mena struck out 58. The 20-year-old signed with the Rockies in 2021 as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic.

**EXPRESS LANE, FIVE RUNS OR LESS:** Since July 1 (41 games), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored five runs or less.

**TRANSACTION-HEAVY MONTH:** Since July 30, the Grizzlies have had 28 transactions. Prior to that date, the Grizzlies had 27 total transactions for the season. Among those 28 transactions, half of them have been players added to the Grizzlies' active roster. Six of those other moves have been promotions to upper-levels, three have been Rockies' releases, three have been injury list placements and two have involved MLB rehab players.

**THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS HAVE ARRIVED:** The Grizzlies have added six 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-round OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 4th-round INF Blake Wright (Clemson), 6th-round LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-round RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU), 13th-round LHP Justin Loer (LSU) and 19th-round RHP Nathan Blasick (New Orleans).

**WELCOME KELVIN HIDALGO:** The Rockies have added 19-year-old Kelvin Hidalgo to the Grizzlies roster. In 2023, Hidalgo was named the Dominican Summer League MVP and is currently in his first season stateside. He is most likely the Grizzlies' 2025 starting shortstop.

**CONGRATULATIONS TO ANDY PEREZ:** The Rockies have announced that INF Andy Perez has been promoted to High-A Spokane. Perez, who has been a mainstay in Fresno for two years, has been one of the most reliable players in recent Grizzlies' memory. Being the youngest player for two years, Perez has shown immense development, beating most of his offensive statistics in his second season. In two years, Perez appeared in 228 games, batting .268/.302/.374/.676 with 10 homers, 14 triples, 38 doubles, 117 RBI, 127 runs, 41 walks and 36 stolen bases. He also finished with a Fresno career .951 fielding percentage, which was between second base (1,000), shortstop (.959) and third base (.913). Perez finished tied for seventh all-time in Grizzlies career triples (14) and reached the Top-10 in Single-Season triples twice (7, 2023 & 2024). Congratulations to Andy Perez!

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot (41 games), he has reached base 72 times in 193 plate appearances (37% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 41 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 36 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-33 (.273) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-41, 41% of the time he reaches base in his first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 20 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (37/43 in stolen bases on the season).

**RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson continues to climb the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books with 37 stolen bases (Picked up his 35th on August 20, 6th inning vs. Stockton). He currently sits fifth all-time with those 37 stolen bases. Up next for Hobson is Dante Powell (1998), who had 41 stolen bases that year.

**TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES:** Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch former teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.

**2024 (pro):** Enters 4th professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...In his first 3 seasons, has impressed mightily...Over 28 games (13 starts), has logged an 11-3 record with 1 save and a 3.67 ERA...In 95.2 innings, has allowed just 2 homers and struck out 95...Every season, has allowed 11 or less walks, while his 28 career walks is less than strikeouts in any given season.

**2023 (pro):** Spent 2nd straight season stateside with the ACL Rockies, making 6 starts...Went 3-1 with a 5.26 ERA over 25.2 innings...Had a 4/1 K/BB ratio (28/7) and did not allow a homer...Made 3 starts where he tossed 5 innings and allowed 1 run or less...Gave up 9 runs in final start of year and had another outing where he allowed 4 runs.
