FRISCO DOWNS SAN ANTONIO IN OPENER:

The Frisco RoughRiders recorded five doubles and started out the second half with a wire-to-wire, 4-2 victory over the San Antonio Missions on Wednesday at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. **Seth Nordlin**'s fourth start of the year for Frisco was his best one so far. He went five innings without a walk, giving up three hits and one run. Efrain Contreras (4-5) also allowed one earned run in five innings but was charged with the loss with an unearned run also scoring in the first inning. **Grant Wolfram** earned the save in the ninth inning, allowing one run but preserving the lead. **Thomas Saggese** extended his hit streak to 15 games — the longest active streak in all of Double-A — with an RBI double to center field in the ninth inning. The RoughRiders' bullpen held off the Missions to keep the lead intact, starting with two hitless innings from Danny Duffy and one more from Noah Bremer. Luisangel Acuña started the scoring in the top of the first inning for Frisco. He reached on an error, advanced to second on **Evan Carter**'s walk, and swiped third for his league-leading 31st stolen base of the year. He scored on a wild pitch. Carter scored on **Trevor Hauver**'s RBI double. **Nick Tanielu** doubled to start a two-out rally in the eighth inning, scoring on **Josh Hatcher**'s double with two strikes. Frisco added another insurance run in the top of the ninth with Saggese's double that scored Carter from first to make it 4-1. Hauver and Carter both tallied three hits with a walk. Hauver tied his career high with his three hits, while Carter scored two of Frisco's four runs on the night. Jax Biggers added a double.

CONSISTENCY NEEDED:

With Juan Mejia's start Saturday for the RoughRiders, he became the 10th different starting pitcher in June for Frisco, which is the most in the league this month. Over their last 13 games, the Riders starting staff has just two games of at least five innings with a 7.69 ERA (39ER/45.2IP). In June, Frisco has a starters ERA of 6.70 (66ER/88.2IP) over 23 games. The good news is the bullpen has been strong in June, owning a 3.97 ERA in June.

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .257, though Frisco is fourth with 276 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 12 games (6-6 record), Frisco is hitting .272 (31-for-114) in those situations

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a 15-game hitting streak (longest-active streak in the Texas League), Saggese is hitting .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. Since June 10th, he is fourth in all of MiLB in batting average (.443) and tied for first in hits (27). Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .311 batting average, 10 homers, 54 RBIs, 47 runs scored and .874 OPS. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, leading the Texas League with a .591 average (13-for-22) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.609 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .438 (21-for-48) on the initial offering while his 21 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 31 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 100 bases in 118 attempts (85 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .295 (78-for-265)/.356/.436/.792 through the first 61 games. Over his last 57 games, he is batting .305/.369/.455/.824. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (110).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 341 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is tied for second in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock last Tuesday.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning completegame, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
