The Home Stretch... The Bowling Green Hot Rods continue their penultimate home series Tuesday night against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. Bowling Green has won 10 of its 11 series at Bowling Green Ballpark in the 2026 South Atlantic League season. The Hot Rods lead the South Atlantic League with a 72.2 home win% .

Life in the Fast Lane... The Hot Rods logged their 260th stolen base of the season on Tuesday. The 2026 Hot Rods are just three swipes away from breaking the single-season stolen base record, set by the 2024 Hot Rods team with 262.

Catcher's Royalty... Nathan Flewelling belted his 21st home run of the season Tuesday night. Flewelling tied 2018 Hot Rods player Ronaldo Hernandez for the most single-season home runs by a catcher in franchise history. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 4 prospect has now homered in each of Bowling Green's last five series dating back to July 30.

Squashing the Bugs... Flewelling's home run made it 32 Hot Rods home runs in 13 games against the Grasshoppers this season. First baseman Ryan McCoy leads Bowling Green with a 1.310 OPS, five home runs and ten extra base hits against Greensboro, including an RBI triple on Tuesday.

Setting the (Ay)bar High... Nicandro Aybar has now reached base in all 16 games as a Hot Rods player following a promotion from the Charleston RiverDogs on July 19. The 21-year-old has torched Greensboro in particular, hitting 12-for-23 (.522 AVG) with six RBI in six games.

On-Base King... Outfielder Noah Myers extended his on-base streak to 18 games with a base hit in Tuesday's series opener. Myers boasted a team-high .524 OBP against the Frederick Keys in last week's road series at Nymeo Field.

Rolling with Russell... RHP Jonathan Russell is slated for his first start at Bowling Green Ballpark on Wednesday night. The Cuban-born pitcher has excelled in Kentucky, posting a 2-0 record and a 2.87 ERA in home games this season.
