TODAY'S GAMES: The Space Cowboys conclude their six-game series with the Oklahoma City Dodgers, needing a victory to secure a series split... Sugar Land has just 7 home games remaining in the 2023 season including Sunday and 13 total games.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: Oklahoma City scored a run in the top of the third on a sacrifice fly and tacked on another in the top of the fourth when David Dahl hit a solo home run... RHP Misael Tamarez threw 4.2 innings of scoreless relief to keep Sugar Land within striking distance... The Space Cowboys scored in the eighth when they loaded the bases on a walk to Bligh Madris and back-to-back singles by Pedro Leon and Shay Whitcomb... Dixon Machado hit into a double play that scored a run, but that was all the offense for Sugar Land in a 2-1 loss.

ROSTER MOVES: 9/9 - RHP Brandon Bielak activated from the Temp. Inactive List... C Luke Berryhill placed on the IL, retro to 9/8... 9/5 - RHP Matt Ruppenthal reinstated from the Dev. List... RHP Brandon Bielak placed on the Temporary Inactive List... INF Rylan Bannon clears waivers, outrighted to Sugar Land... LHP Parker Mushinski recalled by Houston... 9/3 - LHP Bennett Sousa claimed off waivers and optioned to Sugar Land... INF Rylan Bannon designated for assignment... 9/1 - RHP Joel Kuhnel recalled by Houston.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

PROSPECTING: With the re-ranking of MLB Pipeline's Prospects, Sugar Land now has seven of the Astros' Top 30 prospects on their roster, including RHP Spencer Arrighetti (#3), OF Joey Loperfido (#6), LHP Colton Gordon (#7), RHP Rhett Kouba (#9), OF Pedro Leon (#13), INF Shay Whitcomb (#25) & RHP Misael Tamarez (#30).

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 5-13-2 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 3-7-1 overall at Constellation Field in 2023.

WHIT-BOMB: With his solo shot in the sixth inning on Wednesday night, Shay Whitcomb is now tied with Luken Baker, Bobby Dalbec & Abimelec Ortiz for the second most home runs in Minor League Baseball, launching 33 total homers between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (21)... Whitcomb trails only Hunter Goodman (34) in home runs on the Minor League leaderboard, and Goodwin is now with the Colorado Rockies in the National League.

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs (33), RBI (94), Total Bases (241) & Hits (124), T-1st in Extra-Base Hits (51) & 4th in Runs Scored (74).

Whitcomb has hit safely in six-straight games, going 10-for-24 (.417) with a double, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 4 runs scored... The infielder has homered in three of his last six games and has put together multi-hit efforts in four of the last six starts.

MACHO-MACHO-MACHADO: Dixon Machado extended his on-base streak to 15 games on Saturday night, walking twice... During Machado's 15-game on-base streak, he's slashing .295/.467/.500/.967 (13-for-44) with 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 7 runs scored and 14 walks... The infielder has hit safely in 8 of his last 13 games including five multi-hit efforts... The San Cristobal, VZ native has registered multi-RBI games in four of his last nine starts, plating 12 total batters in that span.

LOWDOWN ON LOPERFIDO: OF Joey Loperfido was promoted to Sugar Land on 8/15 and made his Triple-A debut that night, going 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored... At the time of his promotion, Loperfido was tied for the Texas League lead in OPS (.940), 2nd in Slg % (.548), T-5th in Home Runs (19), 6th in Avg (.296) & OBP (.392), 8th in extra-base hits (40) & total bases (172).

Loperfido has reached safely in 11 of his last 14 games with 3 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, 8 walks and a pair of hit by pitches... The 24-year-old is T-1st in the Astros' organization in Doubles (26) & Extra-Base Hits (51), 2nd in Total Bases (215) & Hits (117), T-2nd in Home Runs (22), 3rd in Avg (.281), Walks (62), SLG (.516), & OPS (.894), 4th in RBI (68) & OBP (.378), 5th in Runs Scored (71) & Stolen Bases (25).

RECORD KEEPING: On Wednesday night, RHP Joe Record had his eight outing scoreless streak snapped in his appearance versus the Dodgers... His eight straight scoreless outings streak was the second longest streak for a Space Cowboys reliever this season behind Record's own 13 straight scoreless outings that he made from May 10 through June 11 earlier this season.

Since returning from the IL on 8/1, Record has made 15 appearances, including 12 scoreless outings... The righty is now T-2nd most appearances in the PCL, pitching in 46 games despite missing nearly the entire month of July.

PALMS SWEATY, SPENCER ARRIGHETTI: In 5 home starts since the start of August, RHP Spencer Arrighetti has surrendered just three earned run across 26.1 innings... In 8 overall starts at Constellation Field, the righty is 2-1 with a 2.04 ERA, allowing 9 earned runs in 39.2 innings while striking out 34.

SEEING 20-20: Both Pedro Leon (22 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido (26 2B, 22 HR) have posted seasons in which they have at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 15 bases (Leon -17; Loperfido -25)... They are two of just 18 players in Minor League Baseball with at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 15 stolen bases, and Loperfido is one of just 12 players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases.

RIDE THE BIKE!: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Corey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Corey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched in relief on Tuesday night... Entered in the seventh holding a 6-0 lead... Threw three perfect innings, striking out three... Hurlled 38 pitches, 26 strikes, to pick up his first save of the season and polish off the Space Cowboys first shutout of 2023.

STARTING IN A BIG SPOT: Made his first Major League start on July 2 at Texas... Threw 4.0 innings and gave up just one run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts... Did not receive a decision as Houston came back to top the Rangers 5-3 in Arlington.

DEBUT SZN: Was recalled by Houston on June 18 and made his Major League debut on June 19, throwing 3.0 innings against the Mets at Minute Maid Park.

IL STINTS: Activated from the IL on 8/17... Placed on the IL on 8/4... Was activated from the IL on 5/30... Was placed on the IL on May 4 with a right elbow strain.

NO HITS (OR RUNS) FOR YOU!: From the 8th inning on April 2 to the seventh inning on April 15, Dubin went 7.1 innings without allow a hit and 8.2 innings without allowing a run.

HONORS: Named the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for September 5 through 11 in 2022... Was recognized as the Carlina League Pitcher of the Week on September 2, 2019 and also recognized as the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on April 21, 2019.

RANKKKKKINGS: Led Triple-A in 2022 with a 12.34 strikeouts per 9.0 ratio, the best among pitchers that threw at least 55.0 innings.

TAXI!: Was on the taxi squad and traveled with the Astros during the 2020 postseason in which the Astros reached the ALCS.

GETTING ON THE ROSTER: On November 19, 2021, Dubin was added to the Astros 40-man roster.

TO THE STROS: Selected in the 13th round of the 2018 draft by the Astros out of Georgetown (KY).

LONG AND WINDING ROAD: Started collegiate career at Jamestown Community College in the fall of 2013 as a backup shortstop... Took a year-long break from baseball in 2014... Returned to baseball in 2015 at Erie Community College... Transferred to D-1 University of Buffalo for 2016 and 2017... After Buffalo's baseball program dissolved, transferred to Georgetown College in 2018... Set the school record with 128 strikeouts while going 9-1 with a 2.09 ERA... Was named a NAIA First Team All-American, third player in Georgetown College history to earn the honor.
