NOTES AND NUGGETS				
JAC ATTACK				
Last week, Royals top prospect Jac Caglianone was promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... last week at Salt Lake, "Cags" went 9-for-26 with 5 homers and 10 RBI over his first 6 Triple-A games.				
Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.				
Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 53 RBI, is tied for the lead with 14 homers, 3rd with 108 total bases and tied 6th with 58 hits.				
Going 0-for-5 yesterday, Cags snapped a 19-game hitting streak yesterday, a stretch where he hit .350 (28-for-75) with a 1.141 OPS from May 3 to 25, tied for the 3rd-longest hitting streak in the Minors this year ... he had reached base in 26 games, from April 25 to May 25, with a .356 average (37-for-104) and 1.097 OPS.				
Cags is responsible for 5 of Omaha's 7 hardest-hit balls this season, including the hardest-hit ball of the year by a Chasers hitter, a home run on Wednesday at 113.6MPH ... his average exit velo is 2nd in Omaha's offense, at 93.6MPH.				
Caglianone hit two home runs in Sunday's win over the Bees, his second two-homer game of the season ... he hit home runs in the last 4 games of the series against Salt Lake ... his first home run Sunday flew 459 feet, Omaha's longest of the season and the team's second-longest of the Statcast Era (since 2023).				

FROM OMAHA TO THE SHOW				
6 Omaha alumni have debuted in the Major Leagues this season, with the two most recent being members of the Storm Chasers' 2024 International League Championship team ... a third in poised for his MLB debut soon.				
Infielder Ryan Fitzgerald (2024) made his MLB debut with the Minnesota Twins on May 16, 2025 @ Milwaukee ... he appeared in 2 big league games and went 0-for-3 and scored a run ... the 340th former Omaha player to reach the big leagues, Fitzzy was optioned to St. Paul last week and is with the Saints this week.				
Outfielder John Rave (2022-25) made his MLB debut with the Kansas City Royals yesterday afternoon, starting in right field and hitting 6th in the Royals' lineup ... he went 0-for-2 at the plate, but laid down a sacrifice bunt and drew a walk in the game against the Reds ... Rave is the 341st Triple-A Omaha player to reach the big leagues and currently leads the Minors in runs scored (46).				
Today, the Royals selected the contract of pitcher Andrew Hoffmann (2023-25), whose first appearance with Kansas City will be his Major League debut.				

BAM BAM CAM				
Shortstop Cam Devanney is one of the hottest hitters in baseball right now, with 7 home runs and 22 RBI in his last 15 games both are tied for the most of all hitters in Minor League baseball since May 10.				
Devanney homered in the first 4 games of last week's series vs. Salt Lake ... he leads the Storm Chasers with 11 homers this year, tied 2nd in the International League, tied 5th at the Triple-A level and tied 7th in the Minors.				
Going back to the start of the 2024 season, Devanney has driven in 115 runs for Omaha, tied for the most of any International League player in that span, 4th-most of any Triple-A player and 9th-most among all Minor League players.				
Outside of ranking high on the leaderboards in home runs, Devanney's 38 RBI are tied 8th in the Minors, tied 5th in Triple-A and tied 3rd in the league ... he is 2nd in the IL in slugging percentage (.609) and 4th in OPS (.985).				
His 3 grand slams this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, all coming in the month of May ... he is 4-for-6 when batting with the bases loaded and his 13 total bases and 15 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded both lead Triple-A.				

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO				
While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.				
Omaha has successfully stolen 79 bases this year, and only been caught 11 times ... 79 steals rank 4th in the International League and among Triple-A teams.				
79-for-90 in steal attempts is a 87.8% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 92.3%; 36-for-39).				

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS				
The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 502 strikeouts this season ... that is 2nd in the league and 3rd at the Triple-A level.				
Over 436.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.35 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.				
With 502 strikeouts through 50 games, an average of 10.04 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,495 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

TODAY'S START

- Williams is making his **Triple-A debut** today ... this is his **9th start of the year** ... he opened the year with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and made 8 starts before being promoted to Triple-A yesterday, May 27.
- Playing his 3rd professional season this year, his 3rd in the Royals organization ... was originally drafted by the Padres, but traded to Kansas City during his first professional season, at the 2023 Trade Deadline.
- Among Royals Minor League pitchers in 2025, is tied 2nd in innings pitched (45.1), tied 2nd in wins (4), tied 8th in strikeouts (41), tied 9th in starts (8) ... among 15 qualified arms in the system, ranks 5th in WHIP (1.21), 9th in opponents' average (.259) and 10th in ERA (4.76) ... his 5 quality starts are 2nd in the organization, trailing only High-A Quad Cities' Hunter Pattenso (6).

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, MAY 22 vs. ARKANSAS (SEA)

Took his 2nd straight loss, but threw his team-leading 5th quality start for the Nationals ... allowed runs in each of the first three innings, with a solo homer in the 1st and an RBI double in the 2nd before a pair of unearned runs scored in the 3rd inning ... threw a scoreless 4th inning, then allowed another solo homer in the 5th ... ended his day with a scoreless 6th inning ... tied a career-high facing 27 batters, on only 85 pitches.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned the win in his Double-A debut, pitching the 4th game of the season for the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (AA), on April 8 vs. Frisco (TEX) ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings, to continue the scoreless streak he ended the 2024 regular season on.
- Ranks tied 4th in the Texas League in wins (4), tied 5th in innings pitched (45.1).
- Threw at least 5.0 innings in 7 of 8 starts with Northwest Arkansas, with at least 6.0 innings in 5 of 8 starts, and a pair of 7.0-inning starts.
- Made three straight quality starts between April 25 and May 9, including back-to-back 7.0-inning starts April 25 vs. Tulsa (LAD) and May 2 vs. Springfield (STL) ... were the first two 7-inning starts of his career.
- Through his first 6 starts, worked to a 2.45 ERA (10 ER in 36.2 IP) ... struggled in his 7th start and could not make it out of the 3rd inning, charged with a career-high 11 runs and 10 hits, with a season-high 3 walks ...

CAREER NOTES

2024

- Was rated by MLB Pipeline and *Baseball America* as the Royals' No. 29 Prospect.
- Spent the entire season in High-A and appeared in 22 games (21 starts) for the Quad Cities River Bandits and worked a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) with 92 strikeouts (8.1 K/9).
- Thrived at home, with a 2.06 ERA (13 ER in 56.2 IP) over 12 appearances at Modern Woodman Park ... struggled on the road, to the tune of a 5.67 ERA (29 ER in 46.0 IP).
- Made 2 quality starts, the 2nd and 3rd of his professional career.
- 7 of 21 starts were scoreless, including his final 3 of the regular season ... ended the regular season on a 12.0-inning scoreless streak, with 2 hits and 2 walks in that stretch, striking out 9 ... did not appear in a postseason game for Quad Cities.
- Thrived in the month of August, going 3-0 across 5 starts ... pitched to a 1.16 ERA (3 ER in 23.1 IP), while opponents hit .156 for the month ... his WHIP in August was 0.73 (5 BB + 12 K in 23.1 IP).

- Returned to the mound late in 2023 spring training and made his professional debut in Low-A with the Lake Elsinore in May ... made 12 starts in the California League before the trade that sent him to the Royals.
- Was acquired by Kansas City on August 1 with RHP Jesús Ríos for RHP Scott Barlow ... at the time, was rated by MLB Pipeline as the Padres' No. 10 Prospect.
- After the trade, reported to Single-A and made 5 starts for the Columbia Fireflies before the end of the year, recording 23 strikeouts in 24.0 innings ... threw 5.0 scoreless frames and earned the win in his Royals organization debut, on August 8, 2023 vs. Charleston (TB).

- 🏆 Selected in the 3rd round of the 2022 Draft by San Diego but did not pitch due to injury.

- ✦ Attended Duke University (N.C.) where he pitched just one full season (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and injury derailing his 2022 season.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.
