WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg split both halves of their doubleheader against Richmond (SF) yesterday, winning game one 6-2 before falling 7-6 in the back half of the twin bill...RF **NICK MITCHELL** went 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI in game one.

CHECK MATE: After an hour rain delay Wednesday night, the Rochester White Hots used a 10-run eighth inning to defeat the Charlotte Knights 13-1...Rochester manager **MATT LECROY** earned his 1,000th Minor League win in the blowout...DH **RILEY ADAMS** and LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** both had multi-hit games, with the former smashing a grand slam while driving in six RBI...the Red Wings look to string wins together this afternoon, sending LHP **CARSON PALMQUIST** to the mound against Charlotte RHP Shane Smith.

CARSON CITY: Southpaw **CARSON PALMQUIST** is set to make his third start as a Red Wing, and eighth at the Triple-A level in 2026 in game three this afternoon...he turned in 1.0 inning of work in the series opener Tuesday night, needing 15 pitches to retire all three batters he faced with a pair of strikeouts...the Fort Myers native has turned in a scoreless appearance in four of his last five outings with the Red Wings dating back to game one of a doubleheader on 6/11 vs. WOR, allowing just two hits in 7.0 innings over that stretch...across six appearances (1 GS) at ESL Ballpark this season, Palmquist boasts a 2.25 ERA (2 ER/8.0 IP) with a 0.75 WHIP and .125 BAA...

Palmquist is holding opponents to a .135 BAA since joining the Red Wings on 5/31, 10th-best in the International League (min. 10.0 IP).

OUR FEARLESS LECROY: Last night's win marked the 1,000th career managerial victory for Red Wings skipper **MATT LECROY**...386 of those wins have come with the Red Wings, sixth-most in franchise history behind Albert Buckenberger (451) in fifth...this marks the South Carolina native's 15th season as manager, all in the Nationals organization, and sixth with the Red Wings...LeCroy is the fourth Red Wings manager in franchise history, and first since Joe Altobelli (1971-76) to lead the team for at least six consecutive seasons.

GOING YARD SALE: Heading into the bottom of the eighth inning up 3-1 last night, the Red Wings offense exploded for eight hits and scored 10 times to take a 13-1 lead into the ninth...it marked the second time in 2026 (11 on 6/20 vs. TOL) and fourth time since 2004 that Rochester crossed the plate double digit times in a single frame...both LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** and DH **RILEY ADAMS** went deep in the inning, extending the Red Wings streak of games with at least two homers to seven for the first time since 2019...should they launch two more tonight, it would be the first time they have done so in eight-straight since at least 2004...Rochester has also scored at least six runs in seven-straight games for the second time this season (5/19-27)...

Since 8/5, the Red Wings lead all professional teams (MLB & MiLB) with 21 home runs and 64 RBI.

LIFE OF R(ILEY): DH **RILEY ADAMS** drove in a career-high six RBI and extended his on-base streak to 15 games (since 7/26) in last night's runaway win, going 4-for-5 with a grand slam, a double, two singles and three runs scored...four hits also ties a career-high in a single game (7x), and is the first time he's done so since 6/5/2024 at WOR...he is the first Red Wing to drive in six runs since James Wood on 5/11/2024 at SWB, and the first to do so at ESL Ballpark since Cody Wilson exactly one year earlier, on 5/11/2023 vs. WOR...it also marked Adams' fourth career grand slam, and first since 4/25/2019 with Dunedin (TOR)...over his last 26 games dating back to game one of a doubleheader at WOR on 7/8, Adams leads the team in SLG (.613, 7th in IL), XBH (14, T-5th in IL), and OPS (1.040, T-8th in IL) while carrying a .333 batting average (31-for-93) with a .427 OBP, six homers, eight doubles and 23 RBI...

The Red Wings have now hit six grand slams in 2026, tied for the most in a single season since 2014 (8).

TREY THA TRUTH: LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** put in a 3-for-5 night at the plate last night, highlighted by a solo-shot to lead off the bottom of the eighth inning, while also notching an RBI single later that same inning...the former Tennessee Volunteer also scored three runs of his own and now carries a nine game hitting streak since 8/2, tied for the third-longest active streak in the International League...Lipscomb is slashing .364/.378/.682 with six XBH (4 HR, 2 2B), 13 RBI and 13 runs scored over the course of the streak...over his last 47 games since 6/12, the 26-year-old leads the IL with 66 hits, ranks second with 40 RBI, fourth among qualified hitters with a .355 batting average, fifth with a .602 SLG, T-5th with 12 homers, and eighth with a .997 OPS...

Lipscomb now has 467 total bases as a Red Wing, most in the Nationals era (since 2021) and second-most since 2015 behind Kennys Vargas (477).

A CROWN FOR A KING: SS **SEAVER KING** turned in his fourth-straight multi-hit performance last night, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles, an RBI and a pair of runs scored while adding his sixth Triple-A stolen base...since coming off the Injured List on 7/30, the 23-year-old ranks eighth in batting average (.350) among International League hitters (min. 35 AB) and second on the team behind **TREY LIPSCOMB** (.351), while ranking fifth in OBP (.458) during that span.

GLASS(ER) HALF FULL: 3B **PHILLIP GLASSER** extended his on-base streak to 19 games with a trio of walks last night, going 0-for-2 with an RBI and a pair of runs scored...he is now one game shy of joining Andrew Pinckney as the only two Red Wings to reach safely in 20-straight games this season...Glasser is reaching base at a .449 clip and leads the International League with 20 total walks since the streak began on 7/22, while scoring 15 runs (T-6th in IL)...since making his Triple-A debut with the Red Wings on 9/9/2025, the Canton, Ohio native ranks fifth in the IL with a .309 batting average, and eighth with a .396 OBP.

ED, EDD N EDDY: RHP **EDDY YEAN** came on in relief in the eighth inning last night, and turned in a scoreless inning while allowing a hit and a walk...he has now turned in a scoreless outing in 15 of his last 16 appearances (1 GS) between Rochester and Washington dating back to 7/2 vs. LHV, including nine-straight clean appearances with the Red Wings...he boasts a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP) with a 0.55 WHIP and .104 BAA across both levels since 7/2, while logging 18 strikeouts to just four walks...he leads all Triple-A & MLB pitchers (min. 15.0 IP) in BAA over that stretch, ranks second in WHIP, and 12th in ERA...

Yean leads all International League pitchers and ranks second in Triple-A with 46 total appearances this season, just one spot ahead of RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** (44).

Entering his fifth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he was acquired from Colorado in exchange for cash considerations on 5/25/2026...originally selected by Colorado in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft, out of the University of Miami where he played with Red Wings teammate Yohandy Morales...named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on 7/7/2024 with Double-A Hartford...named an MiLB.com Organization All-Star, and Northwest League Post-Season All-Star with Spokane in 2023.

- Recalled by Washington on 6/24, allowing one run on two hits with three strikeouts over 3.1 innings against Philadelphia before being optioned back to Triple-A Rochester on 6/25...recalled once again on 6/29, and optioned on 8/9.
- Began the season with Triple-A Albuquerque...made 12 appearances (5 GS) with a 7.20 ERA (30 ER/25.0 IP), while striking out 24 and walking 19...traded to Washington on 5/25 and assigned to Triple-A Rochester.
- Made his Rochester debut on 5/31 vs. SYR, went one inning, allowing one run on a hit, while striking out one.
- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Albuquerque and made his Major League debut at Arizona on 5/16/2025 ... allowed five runs on six hits with one walk and no strikeouts in four innings of an 8-0 Rockies loss ... one of three starters in franchise history without a strikeout in their Major League debut, joining Ryan Feltner (2021) and Curt Leskanic (1993).
- Became the 12th left-handed starter to debut in franchise history, the first since Kyle Freeland on April 7, 2017...fourth left-handed starter across the Majors to make their debut in 2025.
- Became the third pitcher in franchise history to allow four or fewer hits in a franchise-best five straight games in a single season, joining Peter Lambert (July 1-Aug. 7, 2023) and Drew Pomeranz (Sept. 9-Oct. 1, 2012).
- Struck out a season-high eight batters during his start on 6/1/25 at Citi Field...retired the first 10 batters he faced before allowing three runs in the fourth inning and one in the fifth...retired the first six batters he faced through the first two innings of the game, striking out five...first Rockies starter to do so since Germán Márquez on Oct. 2, 2022 at Dodger Stadium (5 SO).
- Made 26 appearances (10 starts) for Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-5 with a 4.64 ERA (77.2 IP, 40 ER), 42 walks and 94 strikeouts...as a starter, went 3-3 with a 3.71 ERA (53.1 IP, 22 ER), 27 walks and 64 strikeouts.
- Ranked among Rockies Minor League pitchers in: K/9 (10.89, 2nd), K% (27.8, 2nd), K-BB% (15.4, 8th) and strikeouts (94, 8th) (min. 70 IP)...finished among Isotopes starters in: strikeouts (1st), wins (4, T-3rd), innings pitched (77.2, 5th) and games started (10, T-7th).
