RIDERS BOOM FOR 12-2 THURSDAY WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored a season-high 12 runs on 13 hits over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals, winning 12-2 at Riders Field on Thursday night. **Dio Arias** recorded his first career multi-home run game, while **Justin Foscue** knocked the team's first grand slam of the season and finished the night with five RBIs. Frisco sent 12 batters to the plate in the third to score seven and added five more runs in the seventh to finish their scoring. Northwest Arkansas scored both runs on solo home runs, finishing with two hits and hitless after the fourth inning. Frisco bounced back with their largest winning margin of the season after having their seven-game win streak ended a night ago. Nick Starr (1-0) inherited the bases loaded in the top of the sixth inning and ended the Naturals threat with his first of a two-strikeout night. After a scoreless inning from **Chase Lee**, Riders pitcher **Sean Chandler** made his Double-A debut with a clean ninth inning, striking out two batters. **Dustin Harris** extended his hit streak to nine games with a 1-for-4 outing, knocking in a run on a single in the third. **Ezequiel Duran** increased his league-best doubles tally to nine and came into score on both. Jonathan Ornelas led the Riders with three hits, tying a season best. Four different Riders finished with a multi-hit night.

On Thursday, Justin Foscue blasted his first professional grand slam as part of a seven-run third inning. It was his first grand slam since February 27th, 2019 for Mississippi State in a 12-0 win over Southeastern Louisianna.

DURAN, DURAN; DOUBLE TROUBLE:

The Rangers No. 4 prospect **Ezequiel Duran** has been on fire to start the season with Frisco. In his first 11 games of the season, Duran has reached in every contest while also leading all of Minor League Baseball with nine doubles. Over those 11 games, Duran is hitting .289 (13-for-45)/.347/.489 with those nine doubles, four RBIs, 10 runs scored and three stolen bases.

After starting the season 0-for-8, Dustin Harris is now on an nine-game hitting streak. Harris is hitting .371 (13-for-35)/.395/.486/.881 over his streak with a double, a home run and eight RBIs. The No. 6 prospect in the Rangers system was the Tom Grieve Ranger Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, hitting .327/.401/.542 with 20 home runs and 25 steals between Low-A Down East and High-A

KEEP YOU FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

Through 12 games, the RoughRiders have won eight of their 10 victories by three runs or fewer. So, through those 10 wins the Riders have collected eight saves, the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Though Frisco is 10-2, their run differential is just +22, which is best in the Texas League.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last 10 games, the RoughRiders have banged out at least 10 hits in six contests. Their 93 hits in the last 10 games are more than 55 teams (45.8 percent) in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .278/.352/.382 to start the season, a batting average good for third in the Texas League and seventh in Minor League Baseball.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 962 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP Jack Leiter was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com. In his second start of the season, he went four innings, allowing just one run on one hit again, striking out four against San Antonio.

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF Ezequiel **Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. INF **Justin Foscue**, who joined the club after sustaining an injury during spring training, is the No. 5 prospect. OF Dustin Harris is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. LHP **Cody Bradford** is the No. 20 prospect. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).



ABOUT CODY

- -Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-5A MVP Pitcher award.
- -Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

Fastball (4-seam, 2-seam)

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

Curveball

- -At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.
- -After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.
- -Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

2022 SEASON

- -Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.
- -Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

2021 SEASON

- -The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.
- -Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).
- -Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.
- -On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Ashville in a win.
- -Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.
- -Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.
- -Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.

2020 SEASON

-Struck out 25 batters over 16.1 innings in the Fall Developmental League, tying him for the most in the Rangers system with Zak Kent.
