#### FOUR-RUN NASHVILLE FIFTH SINKS JACKSONVILLE

Both Peyton Burdick and Norel González socked two-run home runs on Saturday, but the Sounds scored four in the fifth to rally by the Jumbo Shrimp 8-5. After Nashville scored in the top of the first, Burdick's blast was part of a three-run second. The Sounds scored one in the fourth before their four-run fifth to grab the advantage. González's two-run homer in the seventh drew the Jumbo Shrimp within one, but two Nashville runs scored on wild pitches in the eighth to get the game's final margin at 8-5. Jacksonville mustered just one at-bat with runners in scoring position all evening, and the Shrimp left only two runners on.

#### SOUNDS OF MUSIC

Heading into their series with Nashville, Jacksonville was hitting a robust .277/.356/.466/.822 as a team, figures that ranked first, second, first and first, respectively, in the league. However, against the Sounds' pitching staff, which features an ERA that leads Triple-A and ranks in the top five of Minor League Baseball, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been quieter. During this series, Jacksonville is collectively batting .217/.304/.385/.689. The Jumbo Shrimp have scored 22 runs over the series' first five games, with the resulting 4.4 per game average a touch lower than their 6.0 mark entering the series.

#### RELIEF NEEDED

Late innings have become a sudden issue for the Jumbo Shrimp of late. In the seventh inning-on over five games from April 26-30, Jacksonville yielded just three runs, all earned, on 10 hits (6.9 H/9) in 13.0 frames for a 2.08 ERA. During that span, the club collectively fanned nine batters (6.2 K/9) against just two walks (1.4 BB/9). However, over the last 12 games, in the seventh inning-on, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 31 runs, 29 earned, on 40 hits (10.7 H/9) in 33.2 frames for an 7.75 ERA. The club's hurlers have issued 17 walks (4.5 BB/9) against 38 strikeouts (10.2 K/9) during this run. Positively, the Jumbo Shrimp have managed a 7-5 record during this 12-game stretch.

#### A SONG OF ICE AND FIRE

Despite giving up eight runs on Saturday against the Sounds, the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff struck out 17 hitters, matching the most in a nine-inning international League game in 2022. The figure also matched the most in any game for a Jacksonville staff since August 9, 2019, when the Jumbo Shrimp whiffed 19 Mississippi Braves. That affair with the M-Braves is the only instance since 2016 that a Jacksonville club has recorded more than 17 punchouts in a game.

#### **ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS**

Jacksonville boasts a 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, but the club has struggled at home, posting just a 8-9 mark. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .234/.327/.385, with the club's .712 OPS ranking 17th at the Triple-A level. Just 18 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 49 home runs have come at home.

#### **CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE**

Charles Leblanc finally saw his league-high-matching 18-game on-base streak come to an end on Saturday. During those 18 contests, Leblanc was 26-for-70, hitting .371/.429/.571/1.000 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs and 11 runs scored. On the year, the Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 28 of his 31 games, with multiple trips on in 17 of those contests. Leblanc ranks third in the International League in both batting average (.359) and OPS (1.036), fourth in hits (42), tied for fourth in RBIs (27), fifth in on-base percentage (.429), sixth in slugging (.607) and tied for 11th in extra-base hits (15).

#### **BLEDAY OF THE DEAD**

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a measly batting line of .159/.321/.286/.607. However, over the last 14 games, Bleday is 15-for-49 with three doubles and four home runs, slashing .306/.443/.612/1.055. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 12 of those last 14 contests. Among the 129 qualified hitters in the IL, Bleday has posted the circuit's highest fly ball rate (57.9 percent), seventh-lowest ground ball rate (28.9 percent) and seventh-lowest line drive rate (13.2 percent).

#### SHRIMP BITES

Posting an 8-7 record in games decided by no more than three runs in 2022, Jacksonville is off the pace of their 50-27 mark over the 2021 season... Catcher/DH **Lorenzo Quintana** has been mashing over his last 19 game (.329/.400/.658/1.058). His line was at .267/.281/.400/.681 in the season's first seven games... Not insignificant, the Shrimp could earn a series split against a great Nashville team with a win on Sunday.

#### **ABOUT MATTHEW**

-It took Kent until his third season at Texas A&M University to move into the Aggies' starting rotation. He totaled six starts out of 45 total appearances between his freshman and sophomore years in 2013-14. In 2015, the left-hander started 14 games out of his 19 appearances, going 9-1 with a 2.76 ERA (98.0 IP, 103 H, 12 BB, 84 K). That performance helped convince the Boston Red Sox to select Kent in the 13th round of the 2015 draft.

-After six seasons in the Red Sox organization, Kent elected free agency on November 7, 2021. Less than a month later, on December 3, 2021, he inked a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

#### 2022 SEASON

#### 2021 SEASON

-Kent started just three games out of 27 appearances in 2021. In his previous four campaigns, he started all but eight of his 112 outings.

-The southpaw held left-handed hitters to a .161 average and .450 OPS in 56 at-bats. However, over 178 at-bats, righties batted .315 with an .823 OPS against him.

-Kent struggled pitching with runners on base. With Double-A Portland and the bases empty, opponents recorded a ..256 average and 674 OPS in 133 at-bats. In comparison, with runners on, opposing hitters hit .307 with a .809 OPS in 101 at-bats.

#### 2019 SEASON

-Kent still had platoon splits in 2019, but far less pronounced than he would experience in 2021. In Double-A, opposing right-handed hitters posted a .755 OPS against him in 294 atbats compared to a .629 OPS for left-handed batters in 187 at-bats.

#### 2018 SEASON

-Over 170 at-bats while Kent pitched for Double-A Portland, left-handed hitters collected a .650 OPS. In comparison, right-handed batters registered a .723 mark in 387 at-bats.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-An outstanding hitter in addition to his pitching prowess at Midway High School in Waco, Texas, Kent went 10-1 with a 0.63 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched as a senior while also batting .421 with 24 extra-base hits. In the district playoffs, he tossed three consecutive no-hitters.
