Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the third of a six-game series against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. After splitting the first two games of the series, Lansing trails West Michigan by five games for the East Division lead with seven games remaining in the first half.

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Whitecaps 3. A sequence of events spelled doom for the Whitecaps in a two-run Nuts rally in the bottom of the 9th: Micah Ashman struck out Rodney Green, Jr., but the pitch went wild to allow Green to reach; CJ Rodriguez attempted a sacrifice but was hit by the pitch; Casey Yamauchi bunted back to Ashman, who threw it away into center field, allowing Green to score the tying run. And, lastly, after West Michigan intentionally loaded the bases, first baseman Luke Gold grabbed a bouncer from Jared Dickey and threw to second base rather than to the plate, allowing Rodriguez to score the game-winning run.

Second in MiLB! Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam is batting .357 entering play, 2nd in Minor League Baseball to only San Jose's Carlos Gutierrez (.35749 to .35678), whom Schofield-Sam leads in OPS (.973 to .914) and trailing only Aaron Judge and former Lugnut Jacob Wilson among Major Leaguers.

Best in Class: On the subject of Schofield-Sam, the native Canadian went 3-for-4 yesterday with two singles, a two-run double and an intentional walk, and now leads the Midwest Leauge in total bases (108) and base hits (71), ranks 2nd in OPS (.973) and (slugging (.543) and is 3rd in runs scored (41).

3-2-1... Contact: The Nuts are the most difficult team to strike out in Minor League Baseball, whiffing 6.97 times per game (411 strikeouts in 59 games). The Erie SeaWolves, one stop above West Michigan on the Tigers' organizational ladder, are in second at 7.34 strikeouts per game (433 in 59 games).

Two For the Price of One: The Lugnuts turned four double plays yesterday, one in each of the third, fourth, fifth and sixth innings, and now have 63 for the season, most in the Midwest League, one behind Hillsboro for the High-A lead, and six behind Round Rock for the MiLB lead. Jake Garland (10 double plays), who coaxed the four straight double plays last night, is two behind the Minor League leader... his own teammate, Nathan Dettmer, who induced seven double plays in eight games with Stockton and five double plays in four starts for Lansing.

Mark it Down: Closer Mark Adamiak trails the Hartford Yard Goats' Welinton Herrera for the Minor League save lead, 11-10. (Herrera notched 10 saves with Spokane before moving up to Hartford). Adamiak trails only teammate Blaze Pontes for the most appearances in the Midwest League, 21-20.

Welcome to Lansing: 6-foot-8 left-hander Jack Mahoney made his Athletics organizational debut and affiliated MiLB debut yesterday, entering in relief in the eighth inning and striking out the first five Whitecaps he faced. Mahoney is the 967th player in the history of the Lansing Lugnuts and the 37th used this year (including the 20th different pitcher). The native of Appleton, Wisc., had his contract purchased from the independent Atlantic League's Staten Island FerryHawks on Monday.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.259), 2nd in base hits (505), 2nd in doubles (114), 3rd in on-base percentage (.358), 3rd in total bases (754) and 3rd in OPS (.745).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (27), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (21), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (204) and 3rd in saves (16).

Last Time Out: On June 6 at Dayton, Echavarria fired five scoreless innings at Dayton on 71 pitches, 46 strikes... scattered four hits and one walk, striking out three... received two runs in the 1st and three runs in the 4th from the offense, exiting with a 5-0 lead... the Nuts went on to win, 5-1, giving Ech his second career pro victory.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball - the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
