Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Justin Campbell** to the mound tonight (49 pitches last start), followed by RHP **Rorik Maltrud** (fifth relief appearance, all on starter's rest). The Cubs will counter with LHP **Jordan Wicks**. Columbus is 16-21 (.432) versus left handers this year. Wicks has pitched against the Clippers six times in his career, going 1-2 with a 3.12ERA (17.1IP, 14H, 6R, 6ER, 9BB, 22K).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 21-19 opposing the I-Cubs (36-26 in the last 62G). Individually, **Milan Tolentino** has hit the Cubs at a .343 clip (35x102) with 10HR and 26RBI in his career (29G). **Cooper Ingle** has batted .300 (12x40) with 3HR and 10RBI in 12G, while **Kahlil Watson** has 3HR and 11RBI in 15G, while **Kody Huff** owns 17RBI in 21G.

Start with a Bang

Over the last 30G, the Clippers have plated 220 runs (most in the IL, 7.3 per), with 150 (68%) tallied in the first four innings of the game, including 52 in the 1st. Opponents have only 71 in the first four innings of the last 30G, but are outscoring the Clippers 104-70 thereafter. The Clippers have not been scoreless through the first four innings since 7/26 at St. Paul (no runs through 3rd three times in last 30G).

Out Front

Each of the last 12G (7-5) have seen the Clippers grab a multi-run lead, good for the longest stretch in the IL this season. Last night saw them face a 2-run deficit, as they garnered their IL-best 31st win when allowing the first run of the game and IL-best 41st comeback win. Columbus has won 61 straight games when leading after the 7th (last loss: 8/22/25) and 75 straight when leading after the 8th (8/7/25).

Back to the Launch Pad

Columbus leads all of pro baseball in homers hit since 7/28 (66, accounting for 49% of runs: 108 of 220) and have allowed the 7th most (53, 2nd in IL; accounts for 46%: 81 of 175). Huntington Park has been breached 77 times in the last 18G, but only three times in 2G this week (all for the Clippers; Columbus has not held an opponent to 0HR over 3G at home since doing so vs. Toledo from 6/3-6/5/25).

700 Club

The lineup drew 3BB last night (8.2 per game in prior 5G), as Columbus enters tonight with an IL-high 694BB (+57 on 2nd place; Iowa leads with 668BB issued). The Clippers are pacing for 778BB (in 147G), a total that would obliterate the club record set in 1983 (741 in 140G). Since 2023, 11 teams in the IL have reached at least 700BB, including nine in 2023 (zero seasons of 700BB from 1985-2022).

Big Time Production

Kyle Manzardo has hit safely in each of 15G since 8/15 (.350, 21x60, 2HR), while collecting 20RBI (RBI in 12G of streak). In his career with Columbus, Manzardo has played only 126G (555PA), but he has still managed 68XBH (.557SLG), including 30HR, against just 56 singles. Additionally, he has scored 98 times with 90RBI, while keeping his strikeout rate under 20% (105K, 19%; 85BB, 15%).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (17, +6), RBI (41, +8) and SLG (.843, +107) and, aside from going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul (7/21-7/26), is hitting .342/.424/.684 since 6/18 (20HR, 55RBI). Though Velazquez has not homered in the last 4G (11AB), he has drawn 7BB in 19PA (7BB in prior 18G, 80PA) and has 11RBI in his last 9G (1HR in 32AB, had 16HR and 30RBI in previous 20G, 76AB).

Power and Speed

Milan Tolentino got to the doorstep of 20HR on Tuesday, while also embiggening his steal total to 17, as he attempts to secure the second 20-20 season in franchise history. He scored the first such season last year and, since the start of 2025, he is tied for 1st in the IL with 40HR (t-25th with 37SB). After poking a grand slam on 8/18, he went 3x37 in his next 10G (8/19-8/29; 5x10, 2HR in 3G since).

Turner It Up

Tyresse Turner will make his Triple-A debut tonight, becoming the 67th player to appear for Columbus (28th position player). Columbus has seen only 155 roster moves this season, compared to 215 through 9/3 last year (ended with 221). Turner played sparingly with Akron since 8/7 (7G), but hit .320 (8x25) with 4BB in that time (.414OBP, 14.2% walk rate this year; Columbus averaging 13.5% as a team).

This Date in Clipper History

9/3/1987

Columbus hammered Rochester 15-3 in game two of the Governors' Cup semis. The Clipper offense pounded out 23 hits (four doubles), with **Roberto Kelly** collecting six of them and **Pete Dalena** five. Columbus swept Rochester, outscoring them 34-9, before sweeping the Tidewater Tides in the Championship (all 1-run games). The win was the franchise's fourth of 11 Governors' Cups.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,494 to 1,442).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 183-145 (.558) in pitch reviews, with batters going 92-87 (.514) and pitchers/catchers going 91-58 (.611). They have run out of challenges in 48G and have not challenged in 8G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 848, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 156 through 131G (on pace for 175SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 44CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 183 runs while crafting a .882OPS (over 60 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 120 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +63 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 302-187 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,995RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.44 through 131G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 205HR (would be 2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 8th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 70G this season (41-29, .586), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (15, three off the lead) while playing in the 13th most games decided in the last at bat (28, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 102G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 49-53 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's seventh year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 457-466 (.495), 427-420 with Columbus (.504).

Worth the Wait:

Campbell made his professional debut on 4/2 vs. West Michigan, 1,355 days after being taken in the supplemental 1st round of the 2022 draft. His career was delayed by surgeries on his right elbow in both May of 2023 and April of 2024 (also had surgery on right wrist in October of 2024). He proceeded to allow 1ER in his first 6GS (13.1IP, 38.2 pitches per start), while walking just a pair of 48BF (4%; also had 18K, 38%). Campbell was promoted to Triple-A on 7/1, but injured his oblique during warmups and left the game before it started (eventually placed on the DL).

Wilding Out:

In his final start with Lake County, Campbell issued 3BB (11BF) and then surrendered 22BB across 9GS with Akron (152BF, 15%), including a pair of outings with 5BB each. His strikeout rate dipped to 29% in that stretch (48K), but he snagged a career high with 8K on 6/6 at Chesapeake (0BB).

No Homers Club (You're Allowed to Have One):

Among all full season minor league pitchers with at least 220BF this season, Campbell is one of 15 that has allowed a single longball (one pitcher has 0HR). That shot came on 6/13 at Erie, snapping a streak of 158BF without a homer to start his career (71BF since).

Buckling Down:

Opposing hitters have had 90 chances with runners on base against Campbell this season, batting .123 (10x81) with only 3XBH (all doubles, .160SLG) and 9BB (.211OBP). Campbell has whiffed 38% of those hitters (34K), while inducing 4GIDP. With the bases empty, opponents have fared a little better, slashing .223/.329/.306 with a HR in 121AB (38K in 140BF, 27%).
