RHP NoIan McLean struck out a career-high nine over four innings in the lid-lifter, allowing just one unearned run...SS Wilfredo Lara was robbed of a game-tying solo home run with two out in the top of the seventh on an incredible leaping in the nightcap on a pair of walks and a single...2B Junior Tilien tripled and scored on a 3B Jefrey De Los Santos RBl knock...RHP Jordany Ventura permitted one run on three hits over 3.2 innings in his first start of the year...The finale was tied at one into the fifth... Hot Rods scored four in the fifth and two in the sixth to close out the game.

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has reached safely all eight games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut last Tuesday night and enters play on Friday riding a 19-game on-base streak dating back to his time in the Florida State League...Since the streak began on April 20, the third-year pro is hitting $.453 / .545 / .516 / 1.061$ with 13 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 14 stolen bases...The now $21-\mathrm{ye}$. H -old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage
(.507)... is also third in batting average (.389), fourth in wOBA (483), and sixth in WRC+ (196)...Morabito is the only player at the full-season MiLB level with an OBP greater than .500 and holds a mark 10 points higher than anyone else The McLean, Va. native's three stolen bases on Wednesday tied nine others for the franchise mark in a single game...Morabito became the first Cyclone to collect three swipes in a single game since LF Alex Ramirez accomplished the feat on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley.
START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.80 ...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit...That ERA is also fourth at the High-A holds the best mark in the minors (236) while Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (238) possesses the best ERA at the level The Cyclones' 11.41 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio is also fifth-best in MiLB and second-highest at the High-A level.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts last Saturday afternoon at Rome...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out $10+$ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with $24.0+$ innings of work, Orellana ranks third in ERA (1.11) and fourth in WHIP (0.95).

DOOGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced - striking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold....Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit....RHP Benito García (8/12/23 vABD), RHP Daison Acosta (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted $5.0+$ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP Nelson Pereira (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.
2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager Gilbert Gómez and pitching coach Dan McKinney at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA ( 45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP Felipe De La Cruz (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and $16 \mathrm{K's}$.
