CROOKS CARRIES CARDS TO COMEBACK WIN IN FRISCO: Jimmy

Crooks had 3 hits and drove in 3 runs, including a game-tying solo homer in the 8th inning, as the Cardinals secured a 6-3 win over the Frisco RoughRiders in the series opener on Tuesday night at Riders Field. Springfield scored twice in the 8th and 9th after trailing 3-2. Six different Birds hitters enjoyed multi-hit games and the Cardinals came within one of a season high with 15 knocks. Nathanael Heredia picked up his first Double-A win for the Cardinals and Matt Svanson breezed through a 1-2-3 9th for his 20th save.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Dane Acker** makes his 18th start of the season for the RoughRiders...Last pitched on Wednesday, August 7 at Midland and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings allowing just 4 H with 8 K...Over his last 3 starts is 1-0 with a 0.60 ERA over his last 3 starts coming out of the All-Star Break, although did surrender 5 unearned runs on July 31 at San Antonio...Finished the 2023 season with the RoughRiders going 1-1 with a 2.74 ERA in 12 starts...Made 6 starts with High-A Hickory pitching to a 2.11 ERA and no record...Missed the first six weeks of the 2023 season with a shoulder injury...Made 9 total starts between the ACL and Hickory in 2022 and threw just 25.2 total innings coming back from Tommy John surgery he underwent in May of 2021...Made just 2 starts with Low-A Down East in 2021 before injuring his elbow...Acquired by the Rangers from the A's along with Jonah Heim and Khris Davis in exchange for Elvis Andrus and Aramis Garcia in February 2021...Selected by Oakland in the 4th round of the 2020 draft out of Oklahoma...Transferred to Oklahoma from San Jacinto JC where he went 10-0 with a 2.34 ERA with 97 K in 76.1 IP...Spent his freshman season at Rice where he was named to the C-USA all Freshman team going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA...25 years old

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

RDAD WARRIDRS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Springfield is 32-19 (.627) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .627 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655). The Birds have a road ERA of 3.75 as opposed to a 5.18 mark at home.

This week represents a clash of strengths; the Riders own the best home winning percentage in Minor League baseball at .686 (35-16).

POWER SURGE: The 2024 season has been a tale of two halves when it comes to the Cardinals' power numbers. With 40 homers in 40 games in the 2nd half, Springfield has already eclipsed its 1st half total of 37. The Cards are on pace for 69 longballs in the 2nd half of Texas League play, a number that would have been good for 3rd in the 1st half.

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored in the 2nd half (207, 5.18/game) and are tied for 1st in OPS (.754) while sitting at 2nd in SLG (.410). In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

GRINDIN': The Cardinal lineup has been one of the hardest in the minor leagues to strike out all season long. With 784 K's in 109 games (18.8% K rate), Springfield has the 2nd-fewest whiffs in all of full-season ball, trailing only the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (MIL) of the Midwest League (749 K in 108 games; 18.5% K rate).

"DOG DAYS" OF AUGUST: After putting together their best month of the season with a 16-7 July, the Cardinals have gotten off the a good start in the month of August. Despite a 6-5 record in the month, the Cards lead the Texas League with a .272 batting average through its first 11 games of the month and have also scored a league-high 52 runs (5.3/game). The Birds have also put together a solid 3.41 ERA with an opponents' batting average of .212 which is the 4th best mark in the league.

FOR STARTERS: The Springfield rotation has been on a solid run since the last day of July. Over their last 11 starts since July 31, Cardinals starters are 4-2 with a 2.63 ERA, striking out 61 batters to just 17 BB in 54.2 IP. Over their last 6 games, Cards starters have a 2.06 ERA.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 34 games dating back to the final day of the first half on June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .355 average while adding 9 of his 10 HR this season and a league-high 30 RBIs, . **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging a league-high .645 and has a 1.054 OPS.

Among active qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks** leads the league in batting average (.315), OBP (.406), SLG (.500) and OPS (.906). **Crooks** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games.

DDN'T RUN ON CHURCH: Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** has proven to be one of the best defensive outfielders in the Texas League this season. Playing all 3 OF positions, **Church** has 9 outfield assists on the season, tied for the most in the Texas League.

KING OF THE "K": With 26 strikeouts over his last 3 starts, Cardinals starter Quinn Mathews reclaimed the minor league lead in whiffs. With 157 K's, Mathews leads Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson of the Cleveland organization by one strikeout (150). Among qualified pitchers in the minor leagues, Mathews is 7th in K/9 at 12.62.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 20-for-20 and his 20 saves and 42 appearances lead all of Double-A. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 18.0 IP (0.50 ERA) and is 10-for-10 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has been unscored upon in his last 15 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 13 K over his last 17.0 IP.

The Cardinals are 44-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


