'CAPS FALL IN WILD WALK-OFF, 3-2: The West Michigan Whitecaps enjoyed some clutch moments late, but their efforts fell just short as a wild pitch scored the winning run as part of a 3-2, 10-inning loss to the Great Lakes Loons on Thursday night at Dow Diamond. The Whitecaps, who snapped their 14-game losing streak with a win on Tuesday, have dropped each of their last two games since the victory. They now sit 10 games under .500 at 13-23 on the season.

THE STREAK: On April 24, the Whitecaps rallied to beat the Lake County Captains at LMCU Ballpark with a late-inning comeback when Garrett Pennington helped the 'Caps erase blowing a late lead with an eighth-inning two run homer before a walk-off two-run double sent the Whitecaps to 12-7. From then until May 10, the Whitecaps lost a franchise record 14 consecutive games. On May 9, a 5-3 loss to the Dayton Dragons at LMCU Ballpark put the losing skid at a franchise-record 13 games, breaking the previous record of 12 set back in 2011, a season that saw the Whitecaps still manage to finish with a winning record of 70-69. Ironically, the next-longest losing skid in baseball belongs to the Florida Complex League Tigers, managed by former 'Caps skipper Brayan Pena, currently sitting at six games.

IT'S RAINING IN WEST MICHIGAN: Infielder Bryce Rainer (No. 2, MLB Pipeline) was added to the Whitecaps roster on April 21 after a strong showing during spring training. The 20-year old is fully recovered from a shoulder injury that limited him to just 35 games last season after becoming the #1 overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft -- taken just two spots behind Pirates SS and MLB's No. 1 Prospect, Konnor Griffin. The California native currently sits as the No. 30 MLB Prospect. The left-handed hitting shortstop that's drawn comparisons to Corey Seager joins left-handed pitcher Ben Jacobs (No. 16), righty Lucas Elissalt (No. 17) and OF Jackson Strong (No. 27) as the other MiLB Prospects listed inside the Detroit Tigers Pipeline Top-30.

WINNING IN ALL PHASES: The Whitecaps finished the 2025 season with the best numbers in the three major categories in 2025. West Michigan led all Midwest League teams in hitting (.264), pitching (3.17), and fielding (.978) to become the first Midwest League team to accomplish the feat since stats began being officially recorded by MiLB in 2005.

RUNNING AWAY WITH RUNS RECORD: With their 16-0 win on August 24, 2025 over Lansing at LMCU Ballpark, not only did the Whitecaps collect their most lopsided shutout in team history, breaking the previous mark of 14-0 in a win over the Burlington Bees on June 5, 2000, but also broke the franchise record for runs scored in a season, and finished with 756 on the year. The previous high was 1997 when the team scored 698 times.

ALONE AT THE TOP: A number of current Whitecaps players set franchise records last season. Infielder Izaak Pacheco is the franchise's all-time home run record holder (39) and RBI-Leader (166). Another player who sits in the Top-5 is IF/OF Austin Murr (137). Murr currently holds the franchise all-time mark for doubles (64) with Pacheco sitting four behind at 60.

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: **RH Carlos Marcano** makes his seventh appearance of the season after being skipped in the rotation his last time through. His last start came on May 3 in a loss at Cedar Rapids allowing one run on just two hits over four innings while striking out four batters. Marcano is now pitching his third season as a member of the Whitecaps and hold a career ERA of 3.63 during his 41 games in West Michigan. (MORE ON PAGE 2).

FOR GREAT LAKES: **LH Jakob Wright** also makes his seventh appearance of the season after going just two innings and giving up one run in a no-decision to the Lake County Captains on May 10 at Classic Park. Wright is spending his second pro season in Midland after spending the entire 2025 campaign in Low-A where he was great for the Quakes - posting a 3.20 ERA while registering 24 strikeouts in 19.2 innings of work. Selected by the Dodgers in the fourth-round of the 2024 MLB Draft, Wright throws a fastball, slider, curve, and change - with his fastball and slider being his best pitch - and has shown plus command in just over one season of pro baseball.

In the 2020 shortened season, went 1-4, with a 2.64 ERA, 43 K's, 19 BB in 30 innings on the mound... Coached by John Chalmers... suffered an arm injury in 2022 that sidelined him with Kentucky but was signed as a free agent by the Rays in 2023 - had a great two seasons in 2024 and 2025 posting sub 3.50 ERA but struggled with injury issues and was released in April of this year before being picked up by the Tigers... Transfer from Eastern Arizona College where he held a 3.38 ERA in 21.1 innings of work in 2019... had 13 strikeouts

Evans professional journey started in 2023 where he pitched in just nine games for the Billings Mustangs. Evans graduated from Texas Wesleyan (NAIA) where he went 4-1 with a 3.12 ERA including 58 strikeouts in 49 innings of work. Although Evans' Independent League stats may not jump off the page, he did enough to catch the attention of the Tigers front office. In 55 games, he posted a 6.08 ERA but struck out 141 batters...
