INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Indianapolis sent 11 batters to the plate during a five-run eighth inning — highlighted by a two-run, bases-loaded double off the bat of Nick Yorke — and Luis Cessa delivered a quality start as the Indians topped the Toledo Mud Hens for their ninth straight win, 7-3, on Thursday night at Victory Field. Down 3-2 midway through the eighth, the Indians rallied for five runs against southpaw Gabriel Sequeira. Sequeira beamed Seth Beer to start the frame and after a strikeout of Matt Gorski, hit Edward Olivares to put the tying run in scoring position. Jack Suwinski followed with a game-tying double to right. Henry Davis was then intentionally walked to load the bases for Yorke, who plated Olivares and Suwinski with a double into the right-field corner. Malcom Nuñez added a run-scoring single two batters later, and a wild pitch with Andrés Alvarez at the dish brought home Yorke for Indy's final run. Toledo grabbed the lead in the third inning on a Stephen Scott solo home run. Later in the frame, a throwing error by Beer on a force attempt at second base led to the Mud Hens' second tally. The Indians responded in the fourth, scoring two runs on a sacrifice fly by Nuñez. Davis and Yorke scored on the play, with the latter racing home on an errant throw home by Unroe from the left-field corner. Spencer Torkelson launched his ninth home run in Triple-A this season with two down in the fifth to put the visitors back in front.

GONE STREAKIN': The Indians' victory yesterday extended their win streak to nine games, overcoming a pair of eight-game streaks for their longest since winning a Victory Field era-record 14 consecutive games from July 28-Aug. 9, 1997.

CESSA'S QUALITY START: Luis Cessa made his eighth appearance (seventh start) with the Indians last night and allowed three runs (two earned) across 6.0 innings for his first quality start since June 13, 2023, with Triple-A Albuquerque at Tacoma. After fanning five over his outing, he exited in a one-run deficit before the Indians offense mounted a comeback in the eighth inning. The outing came after earning Cessa earned his second win with Indianapolis and fourth of the season while finishing one earned run shy of a quality start with six strikeouts over 6.0 innings on July 27 at Iowa.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: Playing in just his second game with Indianapolis after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester, Nick Yorke roped a go-ahead, two-run double in the eighth inning to trade places with Jack Suwinski and give Indianapolis a 5-3 lead. Yorke, who is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect by MLB Pipeline, has hit safely and driven in at least one run in each of his first two games with Indy. He is working a six-game hit streak since July 25 with Triple-A Worcester.

HANK ON BASE: Henry Davis had his career-high 11-game hitting streak since July 13 vs. Columbus snapped last night while going 0-for-2 with a pair of runs last night. The streak bested his previous career-high nine-game streak set from April 23-May 9, 2023, with Double-A Altoona. During his 11-gamer, he hit .391 (18-for-46) with eight runs, six extra-base hits, 12 RBI, a .440 on-base percentage and 1.082 OPS.

JACK'S BACK: Jack Suwinski continued an impressive Triple-A stretch with a game-tying double last night to kick off the Indians' five-run eighth inning. He went 1-for-3 with a run, double, RBI and walk en route to the victory. The double comes one game after he roped a triple on July 31, his first game with the Indians after being optioned by Pittsburgh. He has hit safely in eight of nine game with Indianapolis this season with a .265 batting average (9-for-34) with five runs, four extra-base hits and three RBI.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH: The Indianapolis Indians today named third baseman Malcom Nuñez as their July Player of the Month after he hit safely in 15 of 18 games while leading the team in doubles. The 23-year-old hit .329 (23-for-70) with seven doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .377 OBP and .891 OPS in July. In addition to roping two more doubles than any teammate, he ranked among team leaders in extra-base hits (T-1st), slugging percentage (2nd, .514), OPS (2nd), hits (T-2nd), on-base percentage (3rd), batting average (3rd), total bases (3rd, 36), stolen bases (T-3rd, 3), home runs (T-4th), walks (4th, 6) and runs (T-5th, 11). Nuñez's torrid month was highlighted by a trio of season-high three-hit games and a seven-game hitting streak from July 23-31 that carried into August with a two-hit performance last night. During the seven-game stretch, Nuñez hit .379 (11-for-29) with three extra-base hits, six RBI, a .438 OBP and .990 OPS.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their six-game homestand vs. the Toledo Mud Hens, Triple-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, at Victory Field tonight at 7:05 PM. Indianapolis snapped Toledo's six-game winning streak on Tuesday night and last night extended its own winning streak to nine games since July 23. With three victories already, the Indians have clinched at least a series split this week. Continuing the series tonight for Indy is RHP Mike Burrows (0-0, 2.25), who tossed 4.0 shutout frames in his lone career start vs. the Mud Hens on July 30, 2022. Countering for Toledo is RHP Ty Madden (2-4, 9.00), who faced Indianapolis on May 18 and allowed four runs in 1.2 innings.

BE LIKE MIKE: Mike Burrows returned to the Indians starting rotation last week for the first time since April 8, 2023, and tossed 4.0 one-run innings with no walks and five strikeouts. He fired in 42 of his 60 pitches for strikes, with his four-seam fastball topping out at 95.0 MPH. Burrows made six starts between FCL Pirates and Single-A Bradenton this season while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, going 0-2 with an 8.56 ERA (13er/13.2ip) and 14 strikeouts. In 15 career Triple-A outings (13 starts) since 2022, he is 1-4 with a 4.75 ERA (28er/53.0ip) and 50 strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 1979: Arturo DeFreites hit a two-run, game-winning home run in the bottom of the 16th inning to complete a cycle and lift the Indians to a 7-5 win over Wichita. DeFreites went 4-for-8 with two runs scored and three RBI in the 4-hour, 21-minute contest. After Indy surrendered a 2-0 lead and mounted a late-inning comeback with two runs in the eighth and one in the ninth to force extra innings, the two teams did not score a run for six consecutive frames before DeFreites' walk-off blast.
