FRISCO BESTED IN HOMERFEST WITH CORPUS CHRISTI, LOSE 7-1:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Corpus Christi Hooks 7-1 on Saturday evening from Riders Field. Corpus Christi (2-3, 28-46) opened the scoring in the top of the second against Frisco (3-2, 47-27) starter **Dane Acker** (3-3) with Zach Cole's second homer of the series, a two-run shot to right field. The RoughRiders cut into the 2-0 deficit with a solo homer by **Maximo Acosta** against Tyler Guilfoil (4-6) in the bottom of the second inning, his third long ball of the season. Leading 2-1 in the top of the fourth, Jacob Melton delivered a leadoff homer, marking his third homer in the last two games. Four batters later, Cole launched his second homer of the game, scoring Kenedy Corona. Jordan Brewer then turned on the next pitch, shooting one over the left field wall to give Corpus Christi a three-homer frame and a 6-1 lead. In the top of the fifth inning, Zach Denzenzo padded the Hooks lead with an RBI double, giving Corpus Christi a 7-1 advantage. Acker exited after five innings, surrendering a season-high seven runs, six earned, on nine hits (four homers) with no walks and three punchouts. **Seth Clark** entered in the sixth, spinning 2.0 scoreless and hitless innings with four strikeouts before handing the ball to **Andy Rodriguez**. Rodriguez did not allow a baserunner in the eighth or ninth, fanning one. Offensively, the Riders managed six hits with each coming from different players. **Cody Freeman** extended his hitting streak to eight games, the longest active streak in the Texas League.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh on Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he has slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .241/.289/.434/.723), he has clubbed three home runs in his last five games with two of them being game-winners. This season, he has a career highs in average (.273), slugging percentage (.463) and OPS (.791) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (64) and home runs (17). He is also riding an eight-game hitting streak, batting .323 (10-for-31)/.364/.710/1.074 with three doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the second-fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (46) while also ranking fourth in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 68 double plays are second in the Texas League. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (52), throwing out 28 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.81 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs last Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last five series, spanning 30 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.55 ERA (19ER/110.0IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his eight outings, throwing 16.1 innings.

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 20 games, the Riders have allowed just 53 earned runs over 184.0 IP (2.59 ERA). On Saturday, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 11 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 31 games (5/23 vs. MID). Frisco has the third-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.93 through the first 25 games. Having won 22 of their last 32 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.70) during that stretch while also being tied for third in saves (10) and tied for first in wins (22) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Lake County) has a 3.04 ERA. In those last 32 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 11 times and eight times in the last 20 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses last week marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 36 games, batting .328 (40-for-122)/.437/.459/.896 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 17 strikeouts and 23 runs. In his last 20 games, he is hitting .338 (24-for-71)/.448/.535/.983. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Jordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitter-like action to it.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com.

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and did not allow any extra-base hits after until 5/26, when he surrendered a solo home run.

-Tied career-high with 11 strikeouts on 6/16 vs. AMA.
