YESTERDAY: Jhonkensy Noel homered twice and drove in five runs in a 6-1 Captains win over Dayton. Noel hit a two-run homer in the first inning, another in the third and an RBI double in the fifth. Joe Donovan also hit a solo home run in the second. Kevin Coulter held Dayton to one unearned run over five innings for the win and Zach Draper spun four scoreless frames for the save.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Great Lakes Loons for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, the Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

TIEBREAKER WATCH: The following are the tiebreaker scenarios for the High-A Central League Postseason

- Head-to-head record
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Great Lakes Loons for the final playoff spot, Great Lakes clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (15-9 vs. Lake County)
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Dayton Dragons for the final playoff spot, Lake County clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (13-6 vs. Dayton)
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the final playoff spot, the playoff berth will be decided by the second or third tiebreaker rule.
- Best overall winning percentage over the final 20 games
  - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the team with the better winning percentage over the final 20 games of the regular season will win the playoff berth. The final 20-game stretch began August 28. The Captains are 5-4 since then. The Kernels are 3-6 since then.
- If teams have identical winning percentages over the final 20 games, playoff berth will be decided by best overall winning percentage over an additional game (i.e., the last 21 games, the last 22 games, etc.) until one emerges with a better winning percentage in that span.

#### WHO'S HOT?

José Tena: Since August 1, Tena has slashed .294/.353/.569 (.922 OPS). Tena is second in the league with eight homers and third in slugging percentage since the start of August.

Christian Cairo: 11-for-34 (.324) in 10 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24.

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .305/.369/.525 (.895 OPS) in his first 15 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in OPS (1.022), slugging percentage (621) and ISO (.263).

Tim Herrin: Herrin did not allow an earned run for 11 consecutive appearances from July 21 through August 29. Herrin's streak spanned 18.2 innings before it was snapped on Wednesday by a Yonathan Perlaza home run. Since July 21, Herrin has posted a 1.05 ERA and lowered his season ERA from 3.72 to 2.66.

Kevin Kelly: Kelly has not allowed a run in seven consecutive appearances, spanning 8.1 innings. Since August 13, the right-hander has a 0.63 WHIP and a .120 opponent's batting average

Xzavion Curry: Has a 1.44 ERA across his last five starts (4 ER, 25.0 IP) with 29 K against 4 BB.

TRAFFIC CHECK: Since August 1, the Captains' pitching staff owns the best WHIP (1.19) in the High-A Central League (secondbest in all of High-A)

BORN TO RUN: The Captains lead the High-A Central League in stolen bases (41) since August 1 (second in all of High-A)

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

LAST TIME OUT: Burns took the ball last Wednesday for his fifth start back from the Injured List (activated August 5) and allowed two runs over four innings at South Bend. The right-hander was dominant the first time through the Cubs' order, allowing just one hit and striking out three with no runs allowed. The second time through, however, South Bend got to Burns for two runs on two hits and two walks. The Captains were leading, 4-2, when Burns left the game, but the Cubs came back to tie the score against the Lake County bullpen. The Captains won, 6-5, thanks to a go-ahead homer by Julian Escobedo in the ninth.

INJURY LIST: Missed two starts between July 17 and August 4 with right elbow soreness.

SCORELESS DROUGHT: Burns has gone 10 starts since his last scoreless performance. In those 10 starts, Burns is 0-3 with a 4.97 ERA. In his six starts prior to the streak, Burns was 2-2 with a 2.51 ERA. His last scoreless start was on June 11 at Fort Wayne when he held the TinCaps scoreless on one hit over five innings.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

**TEAM USA:** In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS Carson Tucker (1<sup>st</sup> Round – 23<sup>rd</sup> overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

**RECRUITING BATTLE**: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

**FUTURE DEVELOPMENT:** Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication. makeup and desire to learn.
