DAILY SPECIALS

STREAKING: Three Hub City players (Casey Cook, 20; Dylan Dreiling, 17; Ben Hartl; 14) have put together double-digit on base streaks. Only two other 'Burgers (Arturo Disla, Malcolm Moore) have compiled on-base streaks of 14 games through the first four months.

DREILING DRIVES THE BUS: Dylan Dreiling has been on base in 17 games, has hits in 14 of his last 15 games, and 12 RBIs in that span. In August, Dreiling is batting .272 with 20 RBIs, 10 2B and 3 HR.

ADJUSTING WELL: 18 runs are the most Hub City's scored over the first two games of a series since April 8 and 9 @ WIL (20). 22 hits are the most for HC in the first two games of a series (55 is the most in a series - 7/1-6 v. WS). The 'Burgers offense is a combined 12-21 w/ RISP through the first 18 innings.

SLINGING STARTERS: Against Greenville last series at Fifth Third Park, Hub City's starters combined for 27 innings pitched, 37 strikeouts and 3 earned runs. Two wins had been earned by starters; all of them have gone 5 or more innings... Except for Sunday, when Kolton Curtis walked five and didn't make it out of the first inning.

SCAR RISING: Rangers No. 8 prospect Caden Scarborough, now the top Rangers' prospect on the Spartanburgers, has thrown 9 innings, allowed 0 runs, and struck out 15 hitters in two High-A starts. Scarborough led High-A in his first start with 18 swings and misses. The Floridian had been lights out in Low-A Hickory, holding opponents to 3 ER over his last 34.1 IP.

RACE TO THE FINISH: With six games to go, Hub City has a two-game lead on Greenville and a three-and-a-half game lead on Winston-Salem. The Drive and Dash play each other at Truist Stadium. The Spartanburgers' magic number is four.

THE 'BURG'S WINNERS: Spartanburg hasn't had a minor league champion since 1988, when the Spartanburg Phillies won the South Atlantic League. Prior to joining the SAL, the Phillies won Western Carolina League titles in 1966, '67, '72, '73 and '75.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.

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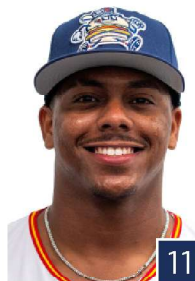
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
