Today's Game

The Fightin Phils stay on the road and continue a two-week road trip, and continue a six-game series at the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the eighth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and second-of-12 at Dunkin' Park in Hartford. The Yard Goats took four-of-six games from Reading from June 17-22 and lead the season-series 4-3. Reading returns to Hartford from Spet. 2-7 for the final road trip of the season.

Game 95 Recap

The Fightin Phils used three runs in the fourth and five more in the ninth to roll to a 10-2 win over Hartford on Tuesday night to open the series. Jean Cabrera started and allowed two runs on three hits over 5.2 innings, with a season-high nine strikeouts. The trio of Jack Dallas, Andrew Walling and Tommy McCollum kept the Yard Goats off the board over the games' final 3.1 innings. In the fourth inning, Aidan Miller reached on a single and scored when Carson DeMartini hit his second Double-A home run, a two-run shot. After scoring three runs in the fourth, the R-Phils tacked on a tally in the fifth and seventh frames. Up 5-2 in the ninth, Hendry Mendez launched a grand slam in the top of the ninth, then Felix Reyes followed with his 10th home run of the season to put the game out of reach at 10-2. Aidan Miller had two hits, three runs and a double. Carson DeMartini had two hits, two runs, a home run and three RBI. The top four hitters in Reading's lineup combined for six hits, eight runs, three home runs and 10 RBI in the series-opening victory.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller turned in one of his best games of the season on Tuesday night. The 21-year old had two hits, scored three runs and had a double in the win at Hartford. The 2023 first round pick is alone in first in both the Eastern League and Phillies minor leagues with 37 stolen bases on the season. After his 37th stolen base last Thursday against Binghamton, Miller has stolen the most bases in a season by a R-Phil since Quintin Berry stole 48 in 2009. The last Fightin Phil to steal 30+ in a season was Johan Rojas in 2023 and the last to swipe 31 or more in a year was Roman Quinn in 2016.

Hendry Keeps Hitting

Hendry Menez launched his eighth home run of the season on Tuesday night, a grand slam in the top of the ninth inning. It was the second grand slam of Mendez' career, with the last coming on May 20, 2022, with Carolina (A) in the Brewers' system. The 21-year old's grand slam was the third hit by a Fightin Phil this season, with the other two coming from Trent Farquhar on May 10 at Binghamton and Cade Fergus on July 10 at Chesapeake. Mendez is currently on a 10-game on-base streak (dating back to July 12) and is slashing .406/.525/.594 (1.119 OPS), with eight runs, two home runs and eight RBI over the streak. Mendez also has walked seven times and struck out just three times over the streak. Mendez collected his eighth game of the season on Sunday with three-or-more hits. In total, Mendez has 22 multi-hit games out of 84 total games played in (26%). Mendez enters play tonight holding the following Eastern League rankings: 3rd AVG (.294), T-7th RBI (46), 5th OBP (.378), 8th OPS (.818) and 7th hits (86).

Mashing McIntosh

Paul McIntosh's 11-game hitting streak (July 3-26) came to an end on Sunday after going 0-4. The catcher slashed .462/.523/.692 (1.215 OPS), with six doubles, one home run and six RBI over the streak. His 11-game hitting streak was the second longest by a Fightin Phil this season, only trailing a 12-game one from Keaton Anthony. He is still currently riding a 16-game on-base streak, dating back to June 21, and has a .500 on-base percentage over that stretch. His 16-game on-base streak is currently the second longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League.

Cabrera in Control

Jean Cabrera turned in another strong start on Tuesday night at Hartford, allowing two runs over 5.2 IP, with a season-high nine strikeouts. Since June 24, Cabrera is 4-1, with a 2.86 ERA (11 ER, 34.2 IP). Cabrera has tossed six-or-more innings in seven of his 19 starts this season and has five quality starts in total, with four of them coming since the start of June. Following his start last night, Cabrera is eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.61), 3rd in strikeouts (99), T-1st in games started (19), 1st in innings pitched (102.1), third in average against (.203), eighth in WHIP (1.20) and tied for ninth in winning percentage (.500).

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 30, 2004: Gavin Floyd and Ryan Howard are both promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Floyd is sent up before that night's game at Harrisburg and Howard is promoted after he goes 1-for-4 with a run scored in an 8-1 loss to the Senators.

Hev Hartford

Hartford enters play today with a 50-46 overall record and 14-13 mark in the second half, sitting at third place in the Northeast Division. The Yard Goats took two-of-five games at New Hampshire (Reading's next opponent) last week, with the Sunday finale cancelled due to rain. After this week, Hartford is back on the road and travels to Altoona. The Yard Goats' roster features eight of the Colorado Rockies top-30 prospects: Charlie Condon (1), Cole Carrigg (2), Jared Thomas (7), Sean Sullivan (11), Welinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Michael Prosecky (26) and Benny Montgomery (28).

Goats Pitche

Lefty, and Rockies' No. 11 prospect, Sean Sullivan makes the start tonight for Hartford. Over 12 starts this season, Sullivan is 8-4, with a 2.78 ERA (21 ER, 68.0 IP). Sullivan last pitched on July 22 at New Hampshire, earning the win as he allowed one run on five hits over 6.2 innings, with nine strikeouts. At Reading on June 19, Sullivan earned the win, allowing four runs on seven hits over seven innings, with eight strikeouts. Sullivan split 2024 between Spokane (A+) and Hartford, combining to go 9-2, with a 2.11 ERA over 21 starts. He began his pro career in 2023 between the ACL-Rockies (ROK) and Fresno (A). The 23-year old was a second round pick by Colorado in the 2023 draft out of Wake Forest. Sullivan pitched at Northwestern in 2022 and for Wake Forest in 2023.
