**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Harrisburg Senators, 8-6, to close the series. **Victor Bericoto** homered twice in the game, including a three-run homer in the top of the first inning to open an early Richmond lead. Phillip Glasser hit an RBI single in the bottom of the first and Daylen Lile singled in two runs in the second to tie the score. In the third, **Justin Wishkoski** hit an RBI single and later scored on a single by **Matt Higgins** to give the Flying Squirrels a 5-3 lead. Carlos De La Cruz belted a two-run homer to tie the game in the bottom of the third. Yohandy Morales hit his second homer in two games, blasting a solo shot in the fifth to give the Senators a 6-5 advantage before Bericoto hit his second homer in the seventh to tie the game, 6-6. The Senators took the lead for good in the seventh and Cayden Wallace added a run in the eighth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Oriole

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** went 2-4 in last week's road trip to Harrisburg, dropping four-of-five after winning the opener. Despite being in last place in the six-team EL Southwest, the Flying Squirrels' -11 run differential is third-best in the division. The Flying Squirrels have hit six homers this season, which is fourth-most in the Eastern League.

**THE BAYSOX** split last week's series against the SeaWolves at home after taking two-of-three at Altoona the previous weekend to begin the season. Bowie's roster includes five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 6), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 16), RHP Trace Bright (No. 17), RHP Alex Pham (No. 26) and RHP Zach Fruit (No. 30). XX players are ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including Bradfield (No. 3), Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), Bright (No. 25) and Pham (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Seth Lonsway makes his second start of the season and the second of his career against the Baysox. In his season debut last Tuesday, Lonsway threw five scoreless innings and struck out seven, holding the Senators to two hits at FNB Field. Including his close to last season, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run in his last five outings, spanning 26.2 innings. During his time with Richmond, Lonsway has only allowed earned runs in one of his 37 innings pitched, with all five earned runs against him scoring in the third inning on July 3, 2024 at Bowie. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. For more on Lonsway, see page two.

**FOR CHESAPEAKE:** Right-hander Ryan Long makes his second start of the season. He last pitched on Wednesday against Erie and allowed three runs (two earned) over 3.2 innings in a no-decision. Long is in his third season with the Baysox and has gone 3-9 with a 5.51 ERA in 37 outings, including 21 starts. Long has pitched against the Flying Squirrels five times in his career, going 0-1 with a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP). Long was selected by the Orioles in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of a California

**HOWELL AT THE MOON:** Carter Howell was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year in his first Double-A season. He spent all of last year in Richmond. For the season, he led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7). He also led the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), on-base percentage (.347), slugging percentage (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), walks (47), extra-base hits (40), total bases (174), runs (64) and stolen bases (15). Through his first nine games of 2025, Howell has

**BERI BOMBS:** Victor Bericoto hit two homers on Sunday afternoon at Harrisburg, belting a three-run homer in the first and a solo home run in the seventh. It was the first two-homer game of his Double-A career and the second of his professional career. He also had a two-homer game in 2023 with High-A Eugene. The two homers on Sunday moved Bericoto into ninth place on the Flying Squirrels' career home run list with 24. His next homer will tie him with **Frankie Tostado** for eighth with 25.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The Flying Squirrels have collected 69 hits through their first nine games this season, which is the third-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .241 (69-for-286), which is third-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .182 (14-for-77) with runners in scoring position, which is eighth in the league.

**PINCH ME!:** In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** hit a single while pinch-hitting in the top of the seventh inning. It was the Flying Squirrels' first pinch hit since 2023. During the 2024 season, Richmond pinch-hitters went 0-for-36 on the year with three walks and 18 strikeouts. The 36 pinch-hit at-bats ranked third in the minors on the season, trailing only Buffalo (10-for-40) and Las Vegas (13-for-38). No MiLB team in the digitized-stats era, which dates back to 2005, has more pinch-hit at-bats without a hit than last year's Richmond team.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's season-opening Flying Squirrels roster includes 22 players who have previously played for the Flying Squirrels. There are six players who have made their team debuts, including Aeverson Arteaga, Sabin Ceballos, Manuel Mercedes, Rodolfo Nolasco, Braxton Roxby and Joe Whitman. Roxby, acquired from the Reds in a trade earlier this year, is the only newcomer with previous Double-A experience.

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster, including the United States (20 players), Venezuela (3), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 20 American-born players, 11 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1) and Texas (1). There are 11 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, six as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** Last season, 14 former Flying Squirrels players reached the majors for the first time. That was the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and** Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors last season were Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024), Sandro Fabian (2021) and Trevor McDonald (2024). Christian Koss (2024) made his debut for the Giants earlier this week as the first new former Flying Squirrel in the majors this year. Dating back to 2022, 23-of-the-last-26 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. The 2023 season saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Victor Bericoto is tied for third in homers (2) and tied for seventh in walks (7). Carter Howell is sixth in OBP (.463) and eighth in walks (8). Jairo Pomares is tied for third in homers (2), sixth in total bases (17), and 10th in SLG (.531). Nick Garcia is tied for first in games pitched (4). Jack Choate is second in strikeouts (14).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also six players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

**BASEBALL HISTORY 1986:** The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 3-2, at The Diamond. Trailing, 2-1, in the bottom of the eighth, Gerald Perry hit a two-out, two-run homer to give the R-Braves a one-run lead. Ed Olwine threw a 1-2-3 ninth to end the game. Andre Treadway made his first Triple-A start and allowed two runs over six innings. **2010:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels played their first home game at The Diamond, beating Reading, 3-0. Daryl Maday started on the mound and pitched 5-2 scoreless innings. Ronnie Ray, Jake Stevens and Rafael Cova covered the final 3.1 innings to finish the shutout. Nick Noonan brought in the first run with an RBI double in the second. Jackson Williams and Conor Gillaspie added solo homers in the fifth and with an RBI double in the second.
