Series: Game 5 of 6 (season series tied 5-5 of 24)

Last Time Out...Hudson Valley scored five times in the first inning, including a two-run double from Christopher Familia, and topped the BlueClaws 6-1 on Friday night at ShoreTown Ballipark...Cam Schlittler gave up one run over six innings, striking out eight, to earn the win while Estibenzon Jimenez took the loss, allowing five runs in 3.2 innings.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have won four out of five and six out of eight games...Had they won on Friday, they would have been back over .500 in the second half for the first time since they were 2-0... They enter the day in fourth place, five games behind first place Greensboro in the SAL North.

The Claws and the Gades...Jersey Shore and Hudson Valley will play 18 times (JS leads 3-1 this week) over the final 51 games of the season including six games at ShoreTown Ballpark this week...Hudson Valley took four of six from the BlueClaws in Wappingers Falls in May, their only meetings over the first three months of 2024.

Crawford to Reading...Justin Crawford, the Phillies #3 prospect per MLB Pipeline, has been promoted to Double-A Reading...The Phillies first-round pick in 2022 hit.301 with the BlueClaws, adding six home runs and 27 stolen bases this season...He is the first BlueClaw to hit over .300 in at least 200 ABs since Josh Tobias (.304 in 365) and Zach Coppola (.316 in 213) in 2016.

The Future... Aidan Miller, the Phillies first-round pick in 2023, joins Crawford today in Arlington, Texas to play in the MLB Futures Game... Miller joined the BlueClaws on June 11th and has two home runs so far... He had a pair of RBI singles on Thursday, driving in Crawford on both.

Hittin' Hendry...Hendry Mendez enters today on a nine-game hitting streak (15-34 since July 1st) and hit his first BlueClaws home run on Saturday...He had a four-hit game on July 4th, his first four-hit game of the year (and first since a rehab game on 6/27/23 with the AZL Brewers), while driving in four of the BlueClaws 15 runs...He has four multi-hit games since July 1st (he had one between May 30th and July 2th)...The 20 year old came to the Phillies with Reading IF Robert Moore for Brewers IF Oliver Dunn in November.

The Hittin' Hawkeye...Keaton Anthony, who signed out of the University of Iowa last year, had the game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the eighth inning on Thursday night...His nine-game hitting streak (14-31) was snapped on Friday but he is 16-41 (four doubles, nine RBIs) with the BlucClaws, with five mutil-hit games including a three-hit game on June 28th, since arriving on June 25th from Clearwater...He drove in four runs in the win on July 10th against Hudson Valley...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...At the time of his promotion, led the Florida State League in OBP (.446) and OPS (.916) while third in SLG (.470) and fourth in BA (.322)...He signed as an NDFA from the University of lows in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

The Vulture...Andrew Walling is 7-0 in relief this year after throwing two scoreless innings to earn the win on Thursday night...Walling tied Jack Dallas (2023) with seven relief wins for the most since the BlueClaws moved to High-A in 2021...Zack Sterner (2008) has the team win with 10...Nate Johnson (2005) won nine.

Super Mari...Emaarion Boyd has been at the forefront of both BlueClaws walk-off wins this year...On Tuesday, his two-run walk-off single won the game in the ninth...On Opening Night (April 5th) he tied the game with a triple in the ninth and scored the winner on a wild pitch...Boyd is now 9-26 so far in July and 27-89 (.303) since June 6th...He hit his second home run of the season on July 6th against Wilmington, a three run shot in the first inning...His other homer was a grand slam on June 9th at Greensboro.

ID....Iordan Dissin had an RBI double on Friday, driving in his 30th run of the season...He leads the BlueClaws with nine home runs, six of which have come since May 31st...His most recent home run was on June 25th in Lakewood against Greensboro...Dissin was a 12th round pick in 2022 from Saddleback College (CA) after spending one year at Richmond...He went to Malvern Preo outside of Philadelohia.

Welcome Back William...William Bergolla returned from the IL on Tuesday night, his first game action since June 22nd...he 19 year old was the Phillies Minor League Player of the Month for June...Bergolla hit. 419 in June, going 24-for-57 with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBI, 11 walks, and five stolen bases...Among all High-A batters with 70 or more plate appearances, the left-handed hitter ranked first in batting average, on-base percentage and strikeout rate, second in OPS and eighth in slugging percentage.

Going, Going, Gone...The four BlueClaws home runs hit on July 6th (Boyd, Crawford, Mendez, Pineda), were one off the BlueClaws record for most home runs in a game at ShoreTown Ballpark...They hit five home runs against Brooklyn on June 6, 2021 (one each by Logan O'Hoppe, Jhailyn Ortiz, Jose Tortolero, Nate Fassnacht, and Hunter Hearn)...The BlueClaws now have 29 home runs at ShoreTown Ballpark this season.

Zach Attack...Zach Arnold had two hits on July 3rd and three hits on July 4th and while driving in three runs, his first three hit game and first three RBI game of the season...He is 14-47 since June 26th and 10-33 in July...Arnold was a 14th round pick last year from Houston and the only 2023 draftee on the BlueClaws Opening Day roster (he has since been joined by first round pick Aidan Miller, sixth round pick George Klassen, and 19th round pick Seesy Steward).

Welcome to the BlueClaws, Paxton....RHP Paxton Thompson joined the BlueClaws on July 2rd and has thrown 3.1 scoreless innings with Jersey Shore so far, including 1.1 scoreless with two Strikeouts on Tuesday...He threw two scoreless innings on July 3rd in his BlueClaws from Clearwater where he 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA in 19 appearances...He struck out 30 and walked nine in 27.1 innings with the Threshers...Thompson signed with the Phillies last year from UNC-Charlotte where he helped them reach the NCAA Tournament last year and he threw three scoreless innings in the Regionals to eliminate #3 Clemson.

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (29 HRs in Lakewood and 30 on the road) hit four home runs on Saturday night against Wilmington - one each from Emagrion Boyd. Justin Crawford, Hendry Mendez, and Leandro Pineda... Aidan Miller hit a leadoff home run in the game on July 4th...Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda has eight...Felix Reves has five, four since June 16th...William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8th at Greensboro.

Hitting Triple Digits...A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season - all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling earned his fifth save of the year in the win on July 6th... Gunner Mayer has three...Andrew Walling and Charles King each have two.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have two walk-off wins this year – July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and pril 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva

The Comeback Claws...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30th - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws

have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team)...(his teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester
