I BECK YOUR PARDON? Fresh off winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Week, on Tuesday night Brendan Beck threw five more scoreless innings to reach 15 consecutive scoreless innings on the season. Beck is one of three qualified Eastern League pitchers with yet to allow a run this season and his 0.47 WHIP is the lowest of any qualified Eastern League pitcher. Somerset's starting staff enters Tuesday with a 2.58 ERA through 16 games, ranking 2nd in the Eastern League.

CAN'T STOP MR. JONES: Spencer Jones reached base in all four of his trips to the plate on Tuesday night, inflating his OBP to a team-best .391, while his 11 walks also lead the team. Jones continues to lead the Eastern League with 6 HR (1st), tie for the league lead with 13 R, while leading the team and ranking among the Eastern League leaders with 35 TB (2nd), 8 XBH (T-3rd), a .614 SLG (4th), 1.005 OPS (5th) and 11 RBI (T-8th). **RAFA RAKES:** Rafael Flores hit his third home run of the season on Sunday afternoon, which featured an exit velocity of 111.7 mph and an estimated distance of 439 feet, making it Somerset's longest home run of the season. On Friday, Flores also tied his career high of 4 RBIs for the sixth time in his career. With a two-run double on Tuesday, Flores' 15 RBIs now tie for 3rd in the Eastern League.

JAKE GREATWOOD: On Tuesday night, Jake Gatewood hit his Eastern League-leading 10th extra-base hit and eighth double of the season. Through 13 games this season, 10/13 hits for Gatewood have been extra-base hits. Gatewood ranks 2nd on the Patriots and ranks among the league leaders with a .563 SLG (8th) and .933 OPS (9th).

HIGH ON JASSO: After his leadoff double in the first inning on Tuesday, Dylan Jasso has now had a first inning leadoff hit in four of his last six games played. In nine games batting leadoff this season, Jasso is 7-for-20 (.350 BA).

COLE'S ON A ROLL: Cole Gabrielson enters today on a 10-game on-base streak, the longest by any Patriot this season. Over the 10 games Gabrielson is 9-for-30 (.300/.436/.500) with 5 RBI, 5 R, 4 XBH and 8 BB.

BULLISH ABOUT THE PEN: During the road trip in Altoona between Wednesday and Saturday, the Patriots' bullpen went a season-long 12.1-inning scoreless streak. Excluding the 7th inning on Sunday (9 ER allowed), Somerset's bullpen threw to a 2.49 ERA (6 ER over 21.2 IP) during the road trip in Altoona. Luis Pacheco and Kelly Austin ended Tuesday's game with three combined perfect innings of relief.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.
