ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians lost a back-and-forth battle with the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field as the Frogs outlasted the C's 6-5 in 11 innings.

With the game tied 5-5 after ten, Everett's Cody Grosse singled up the middle on the third pitch of the eleventh to score the placed runner from second and put the 'Sox ahead for good. Vancouver ran themselves out of a rally in the bottom of the inning when their placed runner was doubled off on a sinking liner to centerfield in the first at-bat of the frame before a fly out ended the game in Everett's favor.

The C's twice rallied to tie the game in the later innings. Trailing 3-2 in the eighth, DJ Neal worked a lead-off walk, went to second on a perfectly executed sacrifice bunt from Eric Rivera and scored on Tanner Morris' two-out RBI single to tie the game. It was Morris who came up clutch again in the tenth; with Everett up 5-3, two runners in scoring position and Vancouver down to their last strike, the Crozet, VA native slapped a double up the third base line to beat the shift, score a pair and tie the game at five.

The Canadians started the scoring with a lead-off home run from Luis De Los Santos, his team-best ninth home run of the year and the second time Vancouver had their first hitter of the game go deep (Tanner Kirwer, May 19 at Hillsboro).

Everett scored two in the fourth to take the lead before the C's tied it in the bottom of the stanza with a single, two walks and a passed ball to make it 2-2. The 'Sox went ahead with a run in the fifth and led until Morris' game-tying hit in the eighth.

FEELING FROGGY: Vancouver and Everett meet for their fourth of six scheduled series this week. The last time these two teams faced each other was June 29-July 4 in Everett when the 'Sox took five of six and dealt the Canadians their worst series of the season. Over the course of the week, the Frogs outscored the C's 42-28 at Funko Field. Everett has outscored Vancouver 119-85 through their first 18 meetings this year and are 11-7 in that span.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY: July 21, 2011 - Vancouver scored single runs in the third and fifth despite collecting just two hits to back a stellar start from Justin Nicolino in a 2-1 win over Eugene at PK Park. Nicolino went five hitless frames, walked one and struck out nine to improve to 5-1 on the year before a trio of relievers scattered five hits and limited the Emeralds to one run over four innings of work. At the plate, the C's scored a run in the third on a double steal before Jon Berti hit his first professional home run in the fifth inning in what proved to be the decisive blow. Berti had the only two hits in the game for the Canadians.

DID YOU KNOW?: Tonight's C's starter Nick Frazee and former 2021 AquaSox outfielder Zach DeLoach were teammates at Hebron High School in Carrollton, TX north of Dallas.

FEELING DEVILISH: Cobi Johnson's strike out of Victor Labrada in the eleventh inning last night was Vancouver's 666th punch out of the season.

EXTRA EXTRA: Yesterday's game was the fourth time the C's went to extras this season and just the second time they played eleven innings. They're now 1-3 in bonus baseball; their one win came on May 16 against Spokane when Cameron Eden singled home the winning run in the bottom of the eleventh to beat the Indians 7-6 and help Vancouver win its fifth of what would be eight in a row.

SECOND FRAME FRUSTRATIONS: The Canadians have been outscored 50-28 in the second inning this year, their worst run differential in any single stanza.

START HOT: Luis De Los Santos' lead-off home run in the series opener was the second such long ball of the year; Tanner Kirwer went deep to start the game on May 19 against Hillsboro.

ON THE HILL: Nick Frazee climbs the slope tonight for Vancouver. He returned from a month-long stint on the Injured List last week against Hillsboro, when he tossed two shutout innings, allowed one base hit, struck out three and didn't walk a batter. The Dallas, TX native blanked the Frogs over six innings in his only turn against Everett on May 28 when he earned the win, gave up two hits and K'd seven. Frazee, 23, played collegiately at Texas State then became a 22nd round pick in 2019.

Stephen Kolek gets the nod for Everett in what will be his third start of the year. The former Texas A&M standout last worked on July 14 against Tri-City, when he took the hill first and allowed season highs in runs (five) and hits (seven) over four innings but did not factor into the decision. He's 1-0 with a 2.89 ERA over 9.1 innings of work in three relief outings against the C's this season.
