YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 6-4. Richmond took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI double by Marco Luciano and a sac fly by Andy Thomas. In the third, Hayden Cantrelle extended the lead to 3-0 with an RBI single. The Curve tied the score with three runs in the sixth, including a two-run triple by Matt Gorski. The Flying Squirrels moved back in front, 4-3, in the seventh with an RBI single by Thomas. Altoona tied the game when Gorski scored on a pick-off error in the top of the eighth. In the ninth, Dylan Shockley gave the Curve the lead with an RBI single and Liover Peguero extended the advantage to 6-4 with an RBI double. Landen Roupp started for the Flying Squirrels and struck out three over four scoreless innings, his longest outing of the year.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh. Today is the eighth of 18 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 against the Curve at The Diamond from May 2-7. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head to Altoona for six games from August 1-6.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a seven game-losing streak, their longest since 2018, with Friday's win but have lost 10-of-11 since May 25. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 22-of-their-last-30. Their 8-22 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 175.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 263.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.25 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are tied for first place place in the Southwest Division, even with Erie. The Curve have won six consecutive games, their longest winning streak of the season. The Altoona offense has struck out 393 times this year, the fewest in the Eastern League. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Liover Peguero (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 14) OF Matt Gorski (No. 16) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nicholas Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes Peguero (No. 6), Jones (No. 11), Gorski (No. 16), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19) and OF Matt Fraizer (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Carson Whisenhunt makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched last Wednesday for High-A Eugene and worked five scoreless, one-hit innings, striking out seven consecutive batters from the third through fifth innings. Last week, he was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for May after going 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA in five starts with the Emeralds. During his time in High-A, Whisenhunt led the Northwest League in ERA (1.42), strikeouts (36), BAA (.107) and WHIP (0.67). He allowed one-or-less hits in five-of-his-six starts for the Emeralds. Whisenhunt began the season with the Low-A San Jose Giants before being promoted to Eugene on April 26. A native of Winston-Salem, N.C., Whisenhunt pitched two seasons at East Carolina University in Greenville, N.C. He was selected by the Giants in the second round (66th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft. Whisenhunt is rated by Baseball America as the No. 8 Giants prospect and No. 8 by MLB.com.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Brad Case makes his first Double-A start of the season. He last pitched on Friday against Binghamton and worked two scoreless innings. His last start was on May 10 with High-A Greensboro and he pitched two hitless, scoreless innings against Jersey Shore. Case was selected by the Pirates in the 17th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Rollins College in Winter Park, Fla.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,850) and total attendance (184,956). The Flying Squirrels are ranked seventh of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond last week and made his Double-A debut last Wednesday against Erie. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut last Wednesday, he has hit safely in each of his last five games, batting .333 (6-for-18) with a double, one RBI and two runs scored.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last seven games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .370 (10-for-27) with two homers, a double, two RBIs and six runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

VALIN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his nine games with Richmond. Last Wednesday, he set a Double-A high with three hits, including a homer and a double. On Friday, he again picked up three hits and scored the walk-off winning run in the ninth.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Over his last 12 games since May 21, **Andy Thomas** is batting .277 (13-for-47) with three homers, three doubles, two walks and 12 RBIs. He has a four-game hit streak dating back to last Friday, during which he is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a homer, a double and five RBIs. Thomas hit a three-run, go-ahead homer on Friday night. On Tuesday, he drove in two runs and picked up the third stolen base of his professional career.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Ismael Munguia is ranked seventh in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for ninth in walks (32). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for eighth in strikeouts (55).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Mason Martin is tied for sixth in homers (10), sixth in RBIs (30), fourth in OBP (.409), 10th in SLG (.508), tied for fifth in OPS (.917) and tied for fourth in walks (37). Liover Peguero is tied for eighth in hits (50), tied for third in doubles (13), seventh in extra-base hits (19) and tied for ninth in runs scored (33). Connor Scott is first in triples (4). Cameron Junker and Juan Minaya are tied for first in games pitched (19). Oliver Garcia and Tyler Samaniego are tied for fifth in games pitched (18).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).


THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY
