**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener in a six-game series in Eastlake against the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The Nuts are coming off a three-game sweep at Great Lakes and a six-game split at home against West Michigan. Lake County opened the season by taking two of three at home against Dayton before splitting six on the road at Fort Wayne.

**Starting Matchup:** Right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, acquired via trade last season from Tampa Bay for Christian Bethancourt, takes on Lake County right-hander **Aaron Davenport**. Fernandez is coming off 4 2/3 scoreless innings last Tuesday in his season debut.

**Last Night:** The Lugnuts and Captains were rained out, with a doubleheader scheduled tomorrow beginning at 4:30 p.m. to make up the game.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday before returning home for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Quad Cities River Bandits and the Dayton Dragons, ending April and starting May.

### LUG•NOTES

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

**Three's a Charm:** RF **Jonny Butler** tied a single game franchise record Saturday with two triples, which also tied him for first in triples in the Midwest League. The Major League record for triples in a game is three, last achieved by **Yasiel Puig** in 2014.

**Streaking:** **Jack Winkler** and **Caeden Trenkle** have each reached base in all eight Lugnuts games they have played this year. After going 0-for-4 in the opener, Winkler has hit safely in the last seven games, while Trenkle went 8-for-16 with five walks against West Michigan and ranks third in the league with a .385 batting average and a .500 on-base percentage.

**Going Deep:** After not homering in their first six games of the year, the Nuts have hit four roundtrippers in the last three games. **Jonny Butler** flipped the power switch with a two-run homer on Friday before **Daniel Susac** and **Max Muncy** each connected Saturday and **Lazaro Armenteros** blasted off to center field on Sunday.

**Doubling Their Pleasure:** Lansing (20) is third in the league in doubles, with the Lugnuts adding three more two-baggers in their last game on Sunday.

**Transaction:** On Friday, the Nuts added pitchers **Grant Holman** and **John Beller** to the active roster. Holman, the 2022 Opening Day starter, was reinstated from the Injured List and tossed a perfect first inning last night. Beller, a member of the Peoria Chiefs last season, was signed as a Minor League free agent and promoted to Lansing from the Arizona Complex League; he joined the bullpen and has yet to see action.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

**Welcome to the Show:** 2022 Lugnuts right-hander **Mason Miller** fired 4 1/3 innings earlier today as the Oakland Athletics' starting pitcher against the Chicago Cubs in his Major League debut, becoming the 176th Nuts alumnus to reach the Major Leagues and the third this year.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Catcher A.J. Jimenez went 4-for-5 with three doubles, two runs scored and two RBIs, and the Lugnuts battered Bowling Green with 18 hits in a 9-3 victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, finishing a three-game sweep. This was the Hot Rods' first ever visit to Lansing, in their first season in the Midwest League since moving up from the South Atlantic League with Lake County before the year.

**2015:** In an unusual shutout – and a brilliant relief appearance – Justin Shafer relieved Sean Reid-Foley (2 2/3 innings) and blanked the Dayton Dragons for the final 6 1/3 innings in a 4-0 win at Cooley Law School Stadium. Shafer struck out Gavin LaValley to escape a bases-loaded jam in the third inning and was never seriously threatened afterward, allowing four singles and whiffing five.

**Life as a Lugnut in 2022:** Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

**Path Through the Pros:** Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

**2022 Dominance in the Rays' System:** Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
