## AMAZIN' STARTS HERE

**BROOKLYN CYCLONES (19-19, 19-19)**

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones snapped their five-game losing streak with a 9-4 victory over Bowling Green...Brooklyn stole seven bases in the contest, including three apiece from LF **Omar De Los Santos** and RF **Nick Morabito**...3B **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** added back-to-back home runs in the sixth...Lugo, 1B **Nick Lorusso**, and 2B **Junior Tilién** each drove in a pair of runs...Lorusso reached base four times, earning three walks...As a team, Brooklyn worked a season-high 12 walks...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** tossed a season-high-tying five innings of one-run ball to earn his second win...The contest was the Cyclones' longest of the season at 3 hours and 10 minutes.

**MORABITO FUEL:** OF **Nick Morabito** has reached safely all 10 games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on May 7 at Rome and enters play on Sunday riding a 21-game on-base streak dating back to his time in the Florida State League...Since the streak began on April 20, the third-year pro is hitting .437/.545/.493/1.038 with 16 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 19 stolen bases...The now 21-year-old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.510)...He is also second in batting average (.383), fourth in stolen bases (23), fifth in wOBA (.483), and eighth in wRC+ (192)...Morabito has also collected a six-game hitting streak since last Sunday...He is 10-for-23 (.435) with five runs scored, two doubles, three walks, and 10 stolen bases...Morabito stole three bases on Wednesday and did it again on Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the last 23 years.

**GET THOSE STEPS IN:** The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 29 free passes are the fourth most in the league...Lugo's 20.7% walk rate is also fifth in the league and 13th in all of Minor League Baseball.

**RUNNING WILD AND FREE:** Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF **Omar De Los Santos** and RF **Nick Morabito** each stole three bases, while CF **Stanley Consuegra** added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH **Walter Rasquin** and RF **José Miguel Medina** each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B **Edgardo Fernán** and CF **Quinn Brodey** snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont...During this week's series against Bowling Green, the Cyclones have stolen 17 bases to the Hot Rods' 14.

**OMAR-I-GONE:** With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on May 2 vs. Aberdeen, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (59) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...Omar is 12 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 87 in 2024...De Los Santos is 25-for-27 stealing bases to start the season...The 25 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for second-most throughout the minors...Bowling Green's OF **Chandler Simpson** (31) leads the SAL and MiLB...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is third across the Minors in steals (132)...Simpson is second in MiLB (133).

**START ME UP:** The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.74...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.76 runs better than the next team (Jersey Shore; 3.50)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and seventh among full-season MiLB squads...Cleveland's Double-A Akron holds the best mark in the minors (2.31), while Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.50) possesses the best ERA at the level...The Cyclones' 11.25 strikeouts-per-nine-innings ratio is also eighth-best in MiLB and second-highest at the High-A level.

**ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START:** RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Orellana is tied for eighth among South Atlantic League pitchers with 41 strikeouts...Additionally, among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana is second in the league in ERA (1.23) and ranks third in opposing OPS (.475), fourth in batting average against (.165), and fifth in WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP) is the seventh-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caracás, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

**HOME COOKING:** The Cyclones enter play on Sunday with a 12-6 record at Maimonides Park, but a 7-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.32) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago-A's Double-A Birmingham (2.06) has the lowest mark in MiLB...Additionally, the Cyclones are fifth in opposing OPS (.570) and eighth in batting average against (.200) in home games...In visiting parks, the

**vs. BOWLING GREEN:** Brooklyn continues its only two-week road trip of the season against the Rays' High-A affiliate...The Hot Rods possess eight of Tampa Bay's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: 1B **Xavier Isaac** (3), INF **Brayden Taylor** (4), OF **Chandler Simpson** (10), INF **Tre' Morgan** (13), OF **Colton Ledbetter** (14), RHP **Yoniel Curet** (16), RHP **Trevor Martin** (19), and INF **Cooper Kinney** (22)...This marks the third-ever series between Bowling Green and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Brooklyn dropped 4-of-6 in their first visit to Bowling Green Ballpark in 2022...The Cyclones are 6-11 against Hot Rods in 17 all-time meetings.

Cyclones' ERA is 4.69...They also maintain a .689 opposing OPS and a .246 batting average against on the road.

**YIPPEE KI-YAY:** TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career...On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 15.1 innings in a no-decision on May 10 at Rome...Over his last five starts, McLean is 2-1 with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing just 15 hits and six walks (714 BB%), adding 30 strikeouts (35.71 K%)...On the year, among pitchers with 28.0+ innings, he is ninth in the South Atlantic League in fewest hits allowed (20)...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run last Wednesday...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 24 fewer plate appearances (65) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and seven fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 70+ plate appearances, McLean is 10th in the league in slugging (.516).

**LARRUPIN' LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine last Saturday and his team season-high-tying on-base streak was snapped at 12 in the opening game of Thursday's doubleheader...The 23-year-old is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for seventh in doubles (9), and tied for ninth in RBI (21)...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in doubles (9), tied for third in triples (2), tied for fourth in RBI (21) and extra-base hits (14), and 10th in total bases (52) and slugging (.473).

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 70 extra-base hits, 30 home runs, and 102 RBI...The 23-year-old is also five hits away (159) from matching OF **Alex Ramirez's** (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**A THOUSAND VICTORIES:** Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,001-847 (.542) in 1,848 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 203-216 (.484) in 419 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

**JONAH'S WHALE OF A START:** RHP **Jonah Tong's** stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In eight appearances (six starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.86 ERA (3 ER in 31.1 IP)...Tong is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.86)...The Markham, Ont. native is also fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (39.5%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.7%) is ninth...Tong's 51 strikeouts are tied for 16th-most in the minors.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 52 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.62 ERA (24 ER in 82.1 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Nolan McLean** (No. 11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: McLean (19), Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took his second-straight defeat in his 2024 Cyclones debut on Wednesday afternoon at Bowling Green... Entered in relief of RHP **Jonah Tong** with the bases loaded and two out in the bottom of the fourth inning and Brooklyn trailing 3-0...Registered a strike out to strand all three runners... Surrendered a season-high three runs on a season-high-tying three hits over 1.2 innings...Walked one and struck out two... Tossed 29 pitches and 20 strikes (68.97%)...Relieved by RHP **Justin Lawson** with runners at first and second and one out in the bottom of the sixth and the game tied at four...Both bequeathed runners scored...Bowling Green would score five in the inning and six more in the eighth to defeat the Cyclones, 14-5.

**2024:** Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...Posted a 1-1 record with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with 16.0+ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramirez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

**THE WHOLE NINE YARDS:** Ramirez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramirez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

**2023:** Ramirez split the season between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn...In 18 appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League, he registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in six starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramirez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts... Joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...Made six starts down the stretch, collecting a 1-1 record with a 5.52 ERA (18 ER in 29.1 IP).

**2022:** Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), one save, six walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (six starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made two relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on two hits over 3.1 innings, striking out three and walking four.
