BIGGERS HAS HUGE DAY IN SERIES FINALE WIN OVER WICHITA:

Jax Biggers launched two home runs on Sunday for his first career multi-home run game and the Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 8-5 at Riverfront Stadium. Frisco (15-12, 46-49) won the series against Wichita (11-16, 39-55), four games to two, to win back-to-back series for the first time this season. Biggers went 3-for-5 with four RBIs on Sunday. First home run gave Frisco a 2-1 lead in the fifth inning. Three innings later, Biggers mashed his seventh long ball of the season and second of the day for two runs. He went back-to-back in the sixth with **Trevor Hauver**, who followed with a solo blast to right center. Those runs were helpful insurance in the eighth, making a 5-2 lead extend to 8-2, since Wichita scored three runs later in the same inning. **Antoine Kelly** held off Wichita in a perfect ninth inning for the save. **Keyber Rodriguez** made his Double-A debut for Frisco, earning his promotion from High-A and taking the start at shortstop. He tripled in the third inning to score the go-ahead run and came home on **Chris Seise**'s double. Rodriguez went 1-for-4 and reached in the fourth inning when he was hit by a pitch and later stole second base. He was 20-for-24 in steals with the Hickory Crawdads this season. Seise went 3-for-6 with two doubles and three runs. He totaled seven hits in the final two games in Wichita, the only two games in which Seise has batted leadoff in 2023. **Aidan Anderson** started for the RoughRiders and worked out of trouble in three innings, stranding five runners without a score. He did not walk a batter in his start and struck out three. **Nick Starr** (5-3) took the win in relief with two runs allowed in two innings, followed by two scoreless frames from **Matt Bush**. Chad Donato was charged with the loss, allowing three runs in 1.2 innings. The Riders took an RBI walk for the third-straight game, this time coming from **Kellen Strahm** in the third to break the scoreless tie. The RoughRiders took another lead in the fifth on Biggers' first home run, gave up that lead but took it back in the sixth with three runs. Strahm also robbed a home run in the sixth, leaping at the right field wall to steal Brooks Lee of his 12th homer of the year. It ended the inning, stranded a runner and kept the three-run lead intact.

TRADE SEASON:

The Rangers and the Mets made a major trade on Saturday evening, being reported as completed during the sixth inning of that evening's Riders game, when the Mets sent three-time Cy Young winner and eight-time All-Star **Max Scherzer** to Texas in exchange for RoughRiders shortstop **Luisangel Acuña**. Acuña exits the Rangers franchise hitting .315/.377/.453/.830 with a team-high 25 doubles, 114 hits, 68 runs scored and 42 stolen bases. On Sunday, a second trade for the Rangers impacted Frisco with **Thomas Saggese** and **Tekoah Roby** going to the St. Louis Cardinals organization in exchange for LHP Jordan Montgomery and RHP Chris Stratton. Saggese was one of the best bats for Frisco, hitting .313/.379/.512/.891 with 22 doubles, 15 home runs, 78 RBIs and 67 runs scored over 93 games while Roby, who has been out with injury since early June, went 2-3 with a 5.05 ERA in 10 starts.

BIG(GERS) DAY IN WICHITA:

Riders infielder **Jax Biggers** had a monster day on Sunday after entering into the game in the second inning for **Thomas Saggese**. He whacked two home runs in a three-hit day for his first multi-home run game of his MiLB career and is now hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.417/.581/.998 over his last eight games.

OFFENSE, OFFENSE AND SOME MORE OFFENSE:

The RoughRiders set multiple season highs in their 19-10 win over the Wind Surge on Wednesday. Their 19 runs, 19 hits and six home runs were all season bests while it was also the longest game of the season at three hours and 31 minutes. In the ninth inning, Frisco went back-to-back-to-back for the first time this season (**Trevor Hauver**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Scott Kapers**). Over their last six games, Frisco has hit .318/.402/.562/.964 with 18 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs, 13 steals and 27 walks while averaging 9.0 runs per game.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.18 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 40 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.42 (116ER/140.2IP) while the bullpen has a 4.70 ERA (108ER/206.2IP). Over the 40 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.797), second-best in runs per game (6.1) and have hit 42 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 23 games, he has driven in 27 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .318/.360/.545/.905 with five homers and 23 RBIs in 17 games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 32 games since his return, he has 10 multi-hit games, batting .294 (37-for-126)/.400/.532/.932 with five doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 25 RBIs and 26 runs scored.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
