MANGUM GRAND SLAM LEADS SHRIMP TO WIN

Jake Mangum clubbed a grand slam on Thursday to propel Jacksonville by Columbus 8-4. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed the lead in the third inning on a two-run shot from Charles Leblanc. In the fourth, Jordan Groshans lashed an RBI single and later in the inning, Mangum blasted his grand slam to make it 7-0. The Clippers plated four runs in the bottom of the fourth to get within three runs. Troy Johnston's sacrifice fly in the sixth set the final margin at 8-4. Josh Simpson fanned five batters in 2.0 innings out of the bullpen, as Jumbo Shrimp relievers worked 5.0 scoreless frames.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 25 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 37-for-102 (.363/.431/.618/1.049) with nine doubles, one triple, five home runs and 23 RBIs, Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, registering 13 multi-hit contests. His 25-game on-base streak is the longest by a Shrimp hitter since Justin Twine's 27-game run from July 19-August 19, 2018. Including Johnston's time with Pensacola in 2023, the Tacoma, Wash., native has driven in 106 runs, second-most of any MiLB player, in 108 games.

Over the last two-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 15 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 21 runs, 17 earned, on 43 hits (7.6 H/9) in 51.0 innings for a 3.00 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 70 batters (12.4 K/9) against 32 walks (5.6 BB/9).

HIGH FIVE!

Jacksonville posted eight runs offensively on Thursday at Columbus, marking the 14th time in the last 21 games that the club has tallied at least five runs scored. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp rank lead the IL in hits (212) and rank second in both batting average (.289) and OBP (.384), sixth in runs scored (125, 6.0 per game) and seventh in both doubles (39) and OPS (.826). Jacksonville was hitting just .256/.341/.417/.758 with 525 runs scored in 101 games (5.2 per game) as a team prior to this run.

JERARSSIC PARK

Jacksonville outfielder Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the season. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 23 games, however, the 26-year-old is 21-for-76 (.276/.411/.526/.937) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 18 walks (18.9 BB%). Encarnacion has trimmed his strikeout rate to 34.7 percent (33 in 95 PA) during this recent hot stretch.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In his 45 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 66-for-186, hitting .355/.398/.495/.893 with 13 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 22 RBIs and 32 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 14 multi-hit games in his last 33 games, batting 54-for-146 (.370/.411/.514/.925) with 10 doubles, one triple, three homers, 18 RBIs and 26 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 267 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (45.5 percent). His 29.3 percent line drive rate is 19th.

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 106, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.2 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks fifth in Triple-A. Over their last nine games dating back to August 14. Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 10 of 12 stolen base attempts (83.3 percent).

Jake Mangum's grand slam on Thursday was the first of his career. He matched his career-high with four RBIs... Devin Smeltzer is 0-4 with a 10.59 ERA in his last five starts (17.0 IP, 28 H, 29 R, 20 ER, 15 BB, 11 K, 384 BAA)... The Shrimp's 15 hits on Thursday were tied for third in a game in 2023.
