NATURALS ERASE THREE-RUN DEFICIT IN WIN OVER FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders held an early 3-0, but fell 7-3 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals on Wednesday afternoon from Arvest Ballpark. The RoughRiders (26-32) took a 2-0 lead in the first inning on an RBI groundout from Aaron Zavala and an RBI single from Kellen Strahm before adding another run in the second on a Naturals (22-37) error to make it 3-0. Northwest Arkansas then scored five runs in the third and two more in the fifth to take their 7-3 lead and never looked back. Luisangel Acuña, Thomas Saggese and Jax Biggers all collected two hits for the Riders. On the mound, Nick Krauth (1-4) took the loss for Frisco in his start, ceding five runs over his four innings while Yefri Del Rosario (4-2) earned the win with two shutout innings from the bullpen for the Naturals. Kyle Funkhouser and Theo McDowell both threw scoreless innings for the Riders in the defeat.

OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:

Pitcher Owen White was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, 9-0. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. White also won Texas League Pitcher of the Week honors last year after a start against Corpus Christi on July 1, 2022, when he logged 5.1 scoreless innings. This is the second season in a row White was the first RoughRiders pitcher to earn Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A. White made his MLB debut on Tuesday, allowing three runs over two innings with two strikeouts.

THOMAS IS BACK IN NWA

Thomas Saggese returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by batting .381 (8-for-21)/.409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a walk. In the first two games of the series this year, he is hitting .444 (4-for-9)/.545/.778/1.323 with a home run, two runs, two RBIs, two walks.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever Alex Speas now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.82 over 19 appearances. In 22.0 innings, he has struck out 36 to 11 walks. Opponents are hitting just .143 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 10 outings. During that span, he has struck out 21 to four walks over 11.2 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .123 (7-for-57) against him on the season with a .383 OPS.

POWER SURGE

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 10 long balls over their last eight games. In the eight games, Frisco is hitting 255/.353/.438/.791 with 19 doubles, 10 home runs and averaging 6.3 runs per game. Luisangel Acuña has led the way, hitting .344 (11-for-32)/.400/.531/.931 in the span while Thomas Saggese hit four home runs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .486 (18-for-37) on the initial offering while his 18 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 23 bags in 56 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 45 steals, which would by far be a career high. Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 27 and if he plays 110 games, he is on pace for a career-best 59 swipes. The RoughRiders are third in Texas League steals with 86 bases in 100 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)). Frisco also has a 1.119 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.321 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.199)

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (65-for-215)/.371/.433/.804 through the first 50 games. Over his last 46 games, he is batting .315/.387/.457/.844. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (116).

WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 290 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is first in the league with 41 walks

-Seth went to Mountain View High School in Arizona, which has produced four MLB players. Scott Lydy (MLB in 1993), Brian Banks (1996-2003), Shea Hillenbrand (2001-2007) and Brad Mills (2009-2015) all were Mountain View Toros.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 85.0 innings for Geckos.

2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with Tai Tiedemann at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing Avery Weems (85.1).

2019-2020 SEASON

-Missed entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Was one of team's most-used relievers in Arizona Fall League in 2020, (16.0 IP, 14 H, 9 R, 5 BB, 20 K).

2018 SEASON

-Playing with Short-Season Low-A Spokane, he led the Northwest League in strikeouts with 79 while being fourth in innings (68.1) and tied for fifth in ERA (3.82).
