AMAZIN' STARTS HERE BROOKLYN CYCLONES (9-9, 9-9)

VS. WILMINGTON BLUE ROCKS (12-6, 12-6)

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn suffered its third shutout defeat of the season, falling to Wilmington, 1-0, on Thursday afternoon...The loss snaps what was a season-long four-game winning streak for the 'Clones...The lone run of the contest came on an RBI ground ball through the infield by CF Daylen Lile... That was the only blemish on LHP Felipe De La Cruz's day, who hurled 4.2 innings, allowing four hits while picking up six strikeouts and three walks... RHPs Victor Castaneda and Jordany Ventura combined for 4.1 scoreless one-hit innings of relief.

**NOT ON OUR WATCH!:** The Cyclones bullpen has been particularly efficient as of late...Brooklyn relievers kept Wilmington at bay again on Thursday and entering play on Friday, the unit has not allowed a run during the home stand...The last time anyone scratched a run off a 'Clones reliever was in the sixth inning of Sunday's series finale in Jersey Shore...Brooklyn comes into Friday with a 2.90 bullpen ERA, good for the second-lowest mark in the SAL, trailing only Hudson Valley (2.02)...It is also fifth-best at the High-A level...The 'Clones 'pen has also registered a league-best 113 strikeouts, while issuing the second-fewest walks (29).

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP Nolan McLean has been a revelation for the Cyclones so far in 2024...The 22-year-old has reached base safely in all six games he has appeared as a position player and became the first Brooklyn starter to earn a victory in 2024 on Tuesday...At the dish, McLean is 7-for-23 (304) with six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...Last Saturday, the Willow Springs, N.C. native registered a career-high three hits — including a pair of doubles — and an RBI...On the mound, Nolan is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP) with 12 strikeouts in three starts.

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP Douglas Orellana was untouchable on Wednesday night vs. Wilmington...The 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced—striking out six—in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García (8/12/23 vABD), RHP Daison Acosta (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit... Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP Nelson Pereira (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Thursday, the 25-year-old notched his fifth straight multi-hit game...Osborn has reached base safely in all nine games he's played, hitting an eye-popping .464 (13-28) with a 1.262 OPS and adding three doubles, a home run, and four RBI....Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 35 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in batting average (.464), on-base percentage (.583), slugging percentage (.679), and OPS (1.262).

**GLORIOUS LORUSSO:** INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The former Maryland Terrapin tied a career-best with three hits in Tuesday's victory, adding a triple and a career-high three RBI...Entering play on Thursday, Lorusso is tied for fifth in the SAL in extra-base hits (7) and tied for sixth in total bases (26).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs Nolan McLean, Dakota Hawkins, and Joey Lancellotti combined on Brooklyn's second shutout of the season, a 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday... RHPs Brandon Sproat, Jordany Ventura, and Justin Lawson united on a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...Both of the Cyclones' blankings have been in the first game of their two home series...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shut-outs in 2023.

RUN FOR YOUR LIFE: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frame was the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, also against Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn also set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

**CANARSIE'S OWN:** IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** returns to his native Brooklyn to start a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday, recovering ...The 23-year-old grew up in the Canarsie neighborhood, roughly 10 miles northeast of Maimonides Park...Palmer also attended Holy Cross High School in Flushing, Queens, approximately five miles east of Citi Field...The right-hand-

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn opens their first two-week homestand of the season against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess three of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Daylen Lile (11), INF Kevin Made (24), and INF T.J. White (28)...Wilmington swept a three-game season-opening set against Brooklyn, winning the last two games on walk-offs from OF Jared McKenzie...In 30 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 16-14 record against Wilmington, but just a 9-9 record at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones were 7-5 last year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...Including 2024, the 'Clones are 44-42 (.512) all-time against the 'Rocks.

ed swinger has appeared in at least one game with Brooklyn each season since 2021 and enters the day as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (201), runs scored (100), walks (108), stolen bases (49), and hit-bypitches (17).

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Wednesday's contest 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is four steals shy of matching IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer's** (49) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is eighth across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Jordany Ventura, Sean Reid-Foley, Justin Lawson, and Ben Simon united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in April 14's walk-off victory...RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Josh Hejka, Dakota Hawkins, and Joshua Corneilly also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over nine innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 44 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 98 RB...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, Dariel, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, José, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogldo...Older brother, Héctor, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

**GENIUNE DRAFT:** Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...**FIP Noah Hali** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (1ith), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

**GOING TO GLENDALE:** Following the 2023 regular season, Geber was chosen to represent the New York Mets as a member of the Glendale Desert Dogs in the prestigious Arizona Fall League...In five starts, the 24-year-old compiled a 1-2 record with a 6.00 ERA (12 ER in 18.0 IP), walking only three and striking out 15...Geber played alongside former Cyclones RHP **Nolan Clenney**, RHP **Brendan Hardy**, INF **Rowdey Jordan**, RHP **Trey McLoughlin**, C **Kevin Parada**, INF **JT Schwartz**, and INF **D'Andre Smith**.

**2023:** Started the season with the Brooklyn Cyclones before landing on the 7-day injured list on May 14...Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on July 19...Made three appearances (two starts), allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings...Rehab transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 6...Went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (8 ER in 5.1 IP) in two outings (one start)...Reinstated from the IL on August 14...In seven appearances (three starts), Geber collected a 3-1 mark with a 4.59 ERA (17 ER in 33.1 IP) with Brooklyn...Transferred to Double-A Binghamton for the remainder of the season August 31...Did not allow a run on 14 hits over 18.0 innings in three games (one start) with the Rumble Ponies.

MOUNT HOKIE: Geber split his college career between Mount St. Mary's University (Emmitsburg, Md.)...Spent four seasons with the Mountaineers...Named to the All-Northeast Conference First Team as a reliever in 2021...Tallied a 2-3 clip with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER in 60.1 IP) with 68 K's in 11 outings (10 starts)...Transferred to Virginia Tech for his graduate season in 2022...Accrued a 1-2 record with a 5.40 ERA (21 ER in 35.0 IP) and 40 whiffs in 16 appearances (seven starts) for the Hokies.

**FIRST DRAFT:** Geber became one of the first two players to sign with a Major League franchise straightout of the brand new MLB Draft League in 2022...The 23-year-old was the first member of the Keys to sign with a parent club since the league formed prior to the 2021 season...Former Cyclones' RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** was the first MLB Draft Leaguer to sign.
