LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans scored eight runs in the sixth inning and won their fourth game in a row 8-4 over the Charleston RiverDogs. **2B Christian Olivo** hit a two-run homer to kick off the scoring and tie the game. **C Miguel Pabon** and **1B Fabian Pertuz** each hit two-run doubles in the inning. **RHP Vince Reilly** took the win with two earned runs in his 2.2 innings with two strikeouts. Myrtle Beach enters Friday with a chance to win their first series of the season.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present).

PITCHING PROGRESS

The Pelicans struggled coming out of the gate as a pitching staff in the first month of the season. Through the first 21 games, the pitching staff held an ERA of 5.91, the highest in the Carolina League and sixth-highest in Minor League Baseball. The Birds also walked 148 batters (7.0/game), the third-highest in MiLB. Since the start of May, the staff has posted an ERA of 4.19 through 26 games while striking out 243 batters, the sixth-most in the league. The starting pitching has led the charge, with **RHP Juan Bello**, **RHP Nick Dean**, and **RHP Ty Johnson** all holding ERAs under 3.00. The walks remain an issue, as Myrtle Beach has given 120 free passes in May (4.6/game). For the season, the Pelicans have thrown 89 wild pitches to lead all of Minor League Baseball.

TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features two of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. Interestingly, both prospects are brothers as **INF Cristian Hernandez** and his younger brother **INF Alexis Hernandez** enter the season as the No. 17 and No. 18 Cubs prospects, respectively. 20-year-old Cristian led the Pelicans in games played last year with 106, hitting .223 with four home runs while splitting time between shortstop and second base. 19-year-old Alexis hit .315 across 37 games in the Arizona Complex League last season while playing second, third, and shortstop. No. 28 Cubs prospect **RHP Nazier Mule** was added to the Pelicans' roster in late May after

missing all of 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He was the Cubs' fourth-round pick in 2022 out of high school.

BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 450 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,377. Bailey currently trails Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) by 13 for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans return to Myrtle Beach for a six-game set against the Charleston RiverDogs. This is a rematch of the 2022 and 2023 Carolina League South Division championship, with the RiverDogs taking both series over the Pelicans. Charleston has won the last three Carolina League championships.

Through the first 47 games, the Pelicans lead all of Minor League Baseball with 89 wild pitches

Pelicans' **INF Cristian Hernandez** ranks 10th in the Carolina League with a .293 batting average. **INF/OF Reggie Preciado** ranks 10th with 45 hits.

Pelicans' **OF Andy Garriola** is currently second in the Carolina League with 8 HR and fifth with 33 RBI. He is currently second with 19 extra-base hits.

OF Jacob Wetzell is one RBI away from tying the Pelicans' career franchise record set by Preston Beck (2013-14) and Eric Campbell (2007-08) at 116. He is two walks away from tying Beck's franchise record of 127, and five runs scored away from tying Gregor Blanco (2003-04) for the franchise record at 139.

The Pelicans have won four Carolina League championships in team history, with the last one coming in 2016. The Birds have also won in 1999, 2000, and 2015.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- The Pelicans made back-to-back playoff appearances after winning the Carolina League South First-Half Championships in 2022 and 2023.
- This year's opening day roster features two of the Cubs top 30 prospects (Cristian and Alexis Hernandez)
- After leading the league in home runs last year, the Pelicans lead the league with 34 in 2024
- The 23 strikeouts by the Pelicans pitching staff in the 12-inning game against Augusta on May 9th were the most strikeouts by a team in all of MiLB this season, the most by a Carolina League team since 2017, and the most for the Birds since they struck out 32 batters in a 23-inning game against Kinston in 2011
- Through the first 47 games, the Pelicans pitching staff leads all of MiLB with 89 wild pitches
- The Pelicans turned a triple play on May 7 against the Augusta GreenJackets
- Andy Garriola is currently second in the Carolina League with 8 HR and fifth with 33 RBI
- The Pelicans walked 17 batters on 4/17 setting a new single-game franchise high
- After collecting 8 walk-off wins in 2023, the Pelicans already have 3 in 2024
