**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Altoona Curve, 16-5. Altoona scored four runs in the first inning and added five in the second inning to open a 9-0 lead. Richmond cut into the lead in the third with an RBI double by **Simon Whiteman** and a two-run homer by **Diego Rincones**, bringing the score to 9-4. After a run in the bottom of the third for Altoona, **Andres Angulo** hit a solo homer to lead off the fourth. It was the 110th home run this season for Richmond, setting a new single-season franchise record. Altoona added three runs in the fourth and three in the sixth to push the lead to 16-5. **Luis Amaya** pitched three scoreless relief innings to finish the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Flying Squirrels are 24-31 against teams from the Southwest Division and 10-15 in road games against division opponents. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 1-6, with the Curve winning four games.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 11-18 since July 21 but have won five straight games and had their league-leading five-game win streak snapped on Tuesday. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 10.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 4.00 ERA for the season.

**THE CURVE** have lost back-to-back games after winning the previous three. They split last week's six-game series against the Patriots. The Altoona offense is ranked tied for fifth in the league with a .251 batting average and the pitching staff is tied for eighth with a 4.67 ERA. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including SS Oneil Cruz (No. 3), RHP Roansy Contreras (No. 6 - on IL), 1B Mason Martin (No. 17), OF Matt Frazier (No. 23), OF Canaan Smith-Njigba (No. 28 - on IL), RHP Cody Bolton (No. 29 - on IL) and OF Jack Suwinski (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Akeel Morris** makes his seventh start for Richmond and his fourth since returning to the roster from Triple-A. He last pitched last Thursday against Erie at The Diamond and allowed one run over six innings. In his three starts since returning to Double-A, Morris has gone 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP), working six innings in each start. He made his previous five appearances, including four starts, for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-3 with a 10.23 ERA. He was assigned back to Richmond on August 1. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). **For more on Morris, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Trey McGough makes his 14th Double-A start and his second against Richmond. He made his Double-A debut at The Diamond on June 4 and allowed four runs (three earned) over 3.2 innings in a loss. Last time out, he worked 7.0 scoreless innings against Somerset last Thursday to pick up a win. In that outing, he allowed four hits and issued one walk with three strikeouts. After allowing four runs in each of his first two Double-A starts, McGough has gone 4-1 with a 2.92 ERA (20 ER/61.2 IP) over his last 11 outings since June 18. McGough was drafted by the Pirates in the 24th round in 2019 out of Mount St. Mary's.

**BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 27 homers in the last 13 games since August 10, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. In that stretch, **David Villar** and **Diego Rincones** have hit five home runs, **Sandro Fabian** has four, **Branndon Martorano**, **Andres Angulo** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Frankie Tostado**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered in that span. The Flying Squirrels hit 15 homers during a six-game set at Bowie from August 10-15 and added 10 homers during last week's six-game series at The Diamond against the SeaWolves. They added two homers in Tuesday's series opener at Altoona.

**POWER SURGE:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth in the Double-A Northeast with 110 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 136 home runs this season in 120 games. On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .401 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 53 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

**LEAVING THE YARD:** The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

**BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS:** In his last 12 games since August 10, **David Villar** is batting .405 (17-for-42) with five homers, six doubles and seven RBIs. He now leads the team with 16 home runs this season, which is also tied for the fifth-most in a season in franchise history and is two homers shy of matching the single-season franchise record. On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. He finished that series with three home runs and homered in each of the last two games of last week's series against Erie at The Diamond.

**FABULOUS FABIAN:** Over the last 12 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with four homers and 16 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 12 RBIs over the last eight games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in four of those contests.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** Over his last 30 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .321 (35-for-109) with nine homers, six doubles, one triple and 25 RBIs. Over his last 19 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .351 (26-for-74) with five homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs. He added a walk-off single on Friday night to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. Rincones homered on Saturday night and hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh in the series finale against the SeaWolves on Sunday night. He went deep for the third straight game on Tuesday at Altoona.

**TAKE A WALK:** In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 28 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 108 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **David Villar** is tied for eighth with 16 homers, ninth with 88 hits, tied for ninth with 22 doubles, tied for fifth with 41 walks, and seventh with 38 extra-base hits, eighth with 158 total bases and eighth with 58 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is eighth with 15 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked ninth with a 5.20 ERA and tied for eighth with 81 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (33/T-3rd), **Joey Marciano** (33/T-3rd), **Matt Seelinger** (31/T-5th), **Frank Rubio** (31/T-5th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (30/T-8th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for third with nine saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for ninth with six.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (14 - on IL), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, **Wilson** (15) and **Beck** (29), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
