Today: It's the first of two straight Copa de la Diversión games this weekend, as the Lansing Locos, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth game of a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. Lansing is 4-6 against Fort Wayne this year, dropping the first two games of the current series before responding with wins in each of the last two games.

Last Night: Lugnuts 7, TinCaps 3. With a crowd of 6,875 in attendance, Lansing homered in each of the first three innings and waited out an 81-minute rain delay in the middle of the fifth inning to beat Fort Wayne.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa call the action on Bally Live, MiLB.TV and (audio only) StreamGuys, while John Nolan and Derek Decker have the call on the Fort Wayne side.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a special Copa edition of the Capital City Market Kids Day, with a pregame Sugar Skull Locos bobblehead, postgame Kids Run the Bases and an Extra Inning across the street at Capital City Market with free ice cream, music and Big Lug. The Lugnuts then welcome the Great Lakes Loons to town on Tuesday for the start of a six-game series.

Lug•Notes

Two to the Show: Last night saw the MLB debut of 1B/OF Lawrence Butler, who played for the Lugnuts in 2021-22, for the Oakland Athletics as well as the surprise debut of Hagen Danner, a 2019 Lugnuts catcher who converted to pitching in 2021 and was called up by Toronto. Unfortunately, Butler went 0-for-4 and Danner was pulled after only seven pitches for injury precaution.

Powering On: The Lugnuts' 11 home runs in the month of August, aided by three big flies yesterday, trails Fort Wayne and Beloit for the most home runs for a Midwest League team this month.

Second Half Surge: Lansing's .261 team batting average in the second half ranks .0003 behind Fort Wayne's league-leading second half average; meanwhile, the Nuts' 350 hits this half is tied for first with Beloit, and the Lugnuts' 77 doubles trails only South Bend (90) for first in the league.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Nuts lead the Midwest League with 95 doubles turned, seven more than second place Peoria and 38 more than last place Quad Cities.

Wait... No Save Necessary? After nine consecutive games opened August with a save recorded, last night did not feature a save for the Nuts. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and nine in ten games played in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .277 (74-for-267). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - 14-for-40, three doubles, one triple, two home runs, four walks, .350/.409/.625, 1.034 OPS. He has reached base 29 times in the last 14 games thanks to 21 hits and eight walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has the Oakland A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon Univeristy.

Wilson's Thousand Oaks High School teammate, 2021 A's first-round pick **Max Muncy**, played for the Lugnuts to start this season and is now with Double-A Midland.

Lansing Lugnuts ranked among MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects

No. 2 - SS Jacob Wilson No. 7 - C Daniel Susac No. 19 - OF Colby Thomas Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The South Bend Silver Hawks brought a 6-3 lead to the 8th, but three Silver Hawks errors (two by shortstop Reynaldo Navarro) led to three Lugnuts runs to tie the game. In the 10th inning, reliever Victor Capellan committed a run-scoring throwing error and Kenny Wilson had an RBI infield single, and the Lugnuts won, 8-6.

2011: For the second time in the season, Jake Marisnick led off the game with a home run, pounding a 2-0 pitch from South Bend's Jeffrey Shields to left. Marisnick finished 4-for-5 with two steals, catcher Jack Murphy went 3-for-3 with two doubles, 3 RBIs and a walk, and the Lugnuts won on the road, 6-2.

2018: Emotions were high in a playoff preview at Cooley Law School Stadium. The Bowling Green Hot Rods beat the Lugnuts, 8-6, ending the Nuts' six-game winning streak, in a game that saw Lugnuts manager Cesar Martin ejected in the top of the ninth (arguing that Hot Rods batter Alexander Alvarez interfered with first baseman Ryan Noda on a squeeze up the first-base line) and hitting coach Matt Young and batter Chavez Young ejected in the bottom of the ninth following a call of check-swing/strike-three.

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-el-vis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... nicknamed Elvis... two other Joelvises have played professional baseball, Joelvis González, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball, and Joelvis Pérez, who has an 8.02 ERA in nine relief appearances for the DSL Guardians and has allowed 35 hits in 22 innings... has been clocked as hot as 98 mph this year; says that he has hit 100 mph once in his life, the first time his mother came in from the DR to watch him pitch in a professional game, in 2022 in the Florida State League... was rated the No. 26 prospect in the Athletics' organization by MLB Pipeline before the recent reorganization, in which he fell entirely off the list; Fastball 55, Slider 50, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 40.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16 for \$33,000, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.

Lugnuts Lineage: Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings as the Opening Day starter, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Hueston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yennsy Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).


